Demonstrators from Valikaman North, South and West started in proc ssion from the Kokkuvil Hindu College jurction, demonstrators from Vadamaradchy and Kopay areas started the procession from Kalviyankadu junction, people from the islands division who are now refugees started the procession from Saththiram junction in the Grand Bazzar area, the Thenmaradchy people took out the procession from Arivalai junction and the Gurunagar peop'e took out the procession from the Carhedral closed throughout the day. Church junction. The processionists after wending their way through many of the important streets of latina reached the Jaffna Secretariat about 9 00 a. m. It was a Sea of heads opposite the Jaf na Secretariat,

The demonstrators remained at the secretariat premises shouting demands and waving placards till noon when at 12.30 p. m. the President of the ad hoc body formed for staging the demonstration, Mr. Cyril, handed over a memorandum to the Government Agent, Jaf na, who received it and promised to transmit it to the President promptly.

The memorandum contained the following demands;

- · Withdrawal of ar ned forces from all Tanil vill-
- \* Rehabilitation and resettlement of the villagers in their homes after the withdrawa of the armed forces.
- \* Immediate withfrawal of of all armed forces personnel from occupied school buildings.
- Removal of embargo on petrol and other fuel to enable restoration of transport services.
- \* Regular supply of medicines to hospitals in Jafina.

\* Removal of all economic \* Removal of prohibition to transport in doine, chemical erifizers and insecticide to the North.

Observers commented that the mass d monstration stag d by the people of Jama on W di diy was the biggest ever public demonstration with people of various walks of ife and age irrespective sex participating in thousands to give vent to their feelings of d'sgust and anger towards the oppressive Sri Lankan Government.

# AN EELAM CITIZEN WRITES TO Rev. SOMI PERERI

We are deeply moved by your earnest and deligent efforts to bring the cognition of the Sinhalese Community and the International Community, of the barbarous attacks let loose on the Tamil Community in Sri Lanka. You have further seen the callous destruction of thousands of houses, schools, business establishments, Govt. buildings and temples. You would have realised how amidst such state terrorist activities the non comba'ants have to live out their lives in the North and East. Besides, are the members of the L. T. T. E. really terrorists? No less a person than the erst - while Indian Major General Sardesh Pande has applauded them as noble - fighters for the liberation of the Tamils in Sti Lanka. It is plain even to the least experienced political observer that the Government policy with regard to the Tamils is shaped largely by the Reactionary retrogressive and stup d Buddhist High Priests and the war-mongers in the top - positions in the Armed Forces.

While India advocates vigorously the continuation of the Unitary set-up in Sri Lanka, it continues also to harbour the E. P. R. L. F. which during the I. P K. F. occupation had declared that the North and East in Sri Lanka had seceded from the Sri Lankan set-up and ushered in the Tamil Eelam self - rule motion. How did the Indian Government view this development? It has always been untrue to its professions of neighbourly good - will. The P.L.O.T.E., a discarded Tamil Militant Organisation had staged a coup on the unsuspecting Maldivean Govt. This was foiled by the intervention of the Indian Govt. But the Sri Lankan Government has extended to them a warm welcome to our Island Home, despite the grave international crime they had committed on a peaceful neighbourly nation. Either i' is with this objective, or marking time till they receive the new consignment of 75 powerful tankers, a number of Gun Boats and fighter planes from China and from 3rd World Nations at low rates. or M/s. Walkers (Ceylon Ltd.) & Co. Colombo to locally manufacture and supply the Bombs (45 Glns. capacity steel drums filled with explosives at a cost of 2½ lakhs each) and artillary

shells, or till the Government's proposed increase of another 25 000 personnel youth armed forces are completed It is with this objective that Mr Premadasa and his Cabinet colleagues are attempting a hypocritical move to reach an understanding with the LITE. Meanwhile Mr. Premadasa has appointed two committees to work out a solntion to the Ethnic strife only to camouflage his military moves to disable the LTTE. His valued Cabinet colleague Mr Thondaman's efforts to bring the warring parties to the conference table does not promise to bear fruits.

That Mr. Thondaman's intended visit to the North has been postponed a number of times high-lights the fact that the Govt is not seriously concerned about the necessity of arriving at a peaceful settlement.

We would earnestly urge upon your honour to intimate to all the aid - giving countries, and the World Bank how their financial aids are channelled for specifically military objectives in the North and East of Sri Lanka. It is sad to reflect how the Christian countries in the West could knowingly contribute to the slow and steady

the Tamils. The North and East of Sri Lanka is on the brink of a vast destruction to be wrought by the Fascist Government of Sri Lanka, What a vast tragedy is to be staged after the Paris Meeting Mr. Premadasa has adopted the delaying tactics to execute his nefarious plans. He is a past master at this game. If the International Community does not stir itself to put an end to the war plans of Mr. Premadasa it will very soon find in the North and East a colossal desert bereft of every - living thing. It is the bounden duty of every newspaper in the world to draw the earnest attention of all the peace - loving people in the world to the tragic plight of the Sri Lankan Tamils. Can you afford to see the North and East of Sri Lanka go the way that Biafra had to take? Please act now tomorrow would certainly be too late. Besides, we feel that International Organisation like (1) Amnesty International, (2) International Commission of Jurists, (3) International Alert, (4) British and Dutch Refugee Councils, (5) The Jesuit and Catholic Refugee Services. (6) The World Council of Churches, (7) European Economic Community Countries, (8) Commonwealth Countries, (9) U. N. O., (10) Development Aid Committee - America, Japan and European Community Countries, (11) U.S.A. Refugees Committee should be appealed to, to bring immediate pressure on the Sri Lankan Government to stop forthwith its Genocidal war and initiate peace talks with the LTTE the only legitimate Organisation of the Sri Lankan Tamils.

It has been announced by the L. T. T. E. high Command that all the Police and Army personnel now in the custody of the L. T. T. E. would be permitted to be taken to their homes down South of Sri Lanka by their parents or closest relatives. Earlier the L. T. T. E. had requested the nearest relatives of the detainees to come and see them personally. But

now as a measure of true humanity they have gone one step further and are prepared to release them. This noble gesture on the part of the L. T. T. E. Leader Mr. V. Pirabakaran should be vie ved against the back ground of the numerous atrocities the detainees had committed on the innocent Tamils.

There was a complete stoppage of work and even dogs were not found on the roads. People in their homes undertook a one-day fast. This was the situation which prevailed throughout the length and breadth o Tamil Eelam.

Following the Kelaniya Sessions of the UNP, Parliament was dissolved on the recommendation of the Prime Minister, Sir John Kotelawala who sought to obtain a mandate from the voters to give effect to the Sinhala Only resolution through an Act of Parliament. But the party in power was routed at the hustings and it was able to retain only eight seats in Parliament whereas the Lanka Sama Samaja Party which stood for parity of status for both languages, Sinbala and Tamil, had won nearly fifteen seats and it became the Official Opposition again in 1956. The Ilankai Tamil Arasu Kadchi won ten seats and became the accredited leaders of the Tamil speaking people of the North and East.

The Mahajana Eksath Peramuna, an electoral front of which the Sri Lanka Freedom Party was the major partner. came to power in the elections and proceeded to bring legislation to make Sinhala as the only official language of the whole Island inspite of the fact that it had an electoral understanding with the LSSP and CP and also the backing of the entire Tamil speaking voters residing outside the North Eastern Pro-

On June 5th, 1956 when Parliament debated the Sinhala Only Bill, the Ilankai Tamil Arasu kadchi performed a satyagraha in front of the very Parliament at the Galle Face Green, headed by its leader, Thanthai S. J. V. Chelvanayakam. The satyagrahis were subjected to assaults and

stones and missiles were thrown at them. The Sityagraha was called off at noon and Members of Parliament of this Ilankai Tamil Arasu Kadchi went to the House of Representatives and participated in the proceedings which were in progress. "What an aw ful and bloody sight in Parliament", somebody from the Opposition remarked, as these members walked into Parliament.

The riots which started did not stop with the maltreatment of the group of satyagrahis Even a monmuent at Kolonnawa junction erected in memory of a trade union martyr named Kandasamy who was shot and killed by the Police during the srike by public servants in 1947, was brought down because Kandasamy happened to be a Tamil. But the irony of it was that even the leftist leaders who had instigated the strike never cared for Kandasamy, when they later held ministerial posts under the LEP

Government in 1970. The monument was re-erected at Kolonnawa but the General Clerical Service Union in which he was member, quietly shifted the venue of the annual commemmoration to the martyr's own residence at Vaddukoddai.

Ilankai Tamil Arasu kadchi (ITAK) convened a Special Convention of its membership at Trincomalee in August to decide its strategy to fight the imposition of the Sinhala Only Act of 1956. To attend this Conference, its memberahi, marched to Trincomalee on foot from every part of Eelam. In connection with the big event, an open public competition was held to select a National Antham for the Tamil people. A song entitled 'Valha Eela Thamilakam, Valha inithu Valkave' composed by poct Paranahamsadasan was selected.

The Special National Convention of the ITAK gave the Government of Sri Lanka an year's ultimatum to find a political solution to the Tamil question, failing which it resolved to start a mass civil disobedience campaign to win back the rights of the Tamils. At the tail end of the period of the one year granted to the Government by the ultimatum to resolve the Tamils question, the Government invited The Tamil Arasu Kadchi for talks which culminated in the Bandaranayake-Chelvanayakam Agreement of 1957.

The Pact, however, was unilaterally abrogated by Prime Minister Bandaranayke on April Fool's Day following a tar brush campaign led by the Buddhist Clergy and Sinhala chauvinists. Prime Minister Bandaranayake himself was la er assassinated

#### Indian Democracy Exposed

The elections to the remaining north and east provincial council were held after the President had, by a proclamation, merged the north and east into one province Quite clearly, security wise, there was no means of ho'ding a free and fair elections. The LTTE had called for a boycott of the elections and there was no administration worth its name functioning. In such a situation what happened was that the Indians stage managed an election which was far from free and fair The canard that the Tamils voied overwhelmingly in favour of the Accord and against the war is absurd. There was no election in the North province because the candidates were declared uncontested. In the Eastern Province all the Tamils did not vote.

The Indians got the former militant groups under the leadership of the EPRLF and formed them into a front and distributed all the seats among them. These candidates were taken to the respective kachcheries by Indian helicopters. While these candidates were brought to the Jaffna Kachcheri by an Indian helicopter, the Indians had declared a local curfew to prevent anyone entering the Kachcheri. They also searched all people in the vicinity to check whether they had high denomination notes. The IPKF not only provided security but also worked inside the election booths. This was Indian bourgeois democracy

An example of IPKF democracy at work was told me by a cousin who lives in Valaichenai in the Eastern Province. He, his wife and two others had gone to vote. The polling station was manned by policemen. There was none from the election department. A policeman asked him how many votes they wanted. He was given 4 ballot papers, without any reference to electoral registers. He was immediately surrounded by armed EPRLF cadres who relieved him of his ballot papers and told him that they would put the ballot papers.

This is obvious from her various communications and public ut rances In fact, Cabinet Minister Baghat once mentioned that there were "elements of genocid;" in the attacks of the Sinhala Government of Sri Lanka against the Tamils". But she never made up any plan to deil with the thnic problem. he never uttered a word about Sri Lankan soverignty of territorial integrity. But Rajiv Gandhi began to b'est and i Sri Lanka's sovereignty and teritorial integrity He neves realized that once he conceded this any attemp' at settlement of the ethnic problem would be concerned with the mere mechanism of Government and that would be an internal affair and India would have no locus standi to intervene in shaping the mechanism of Government, already conceded by him to be an internal matter.

a right about 'urn in India's Sri Lankan policy after Prime Minister Indra Gandhi. How it happened is very simple. Indra Gindhi had confidence in herself and India. She knew very well that the inherited values of several millennia derived from Hinduism held together India.
