Bishop Kulendiran Passes Away

We regret to record the death of Rt Rev. Dr. S. Kulendiran He passed away at Vadd k dai on 14 02-92. It may b recalled that he was the First Bishop of the Church of South India in Jaifna tollowing its Union with South India. He was earlier Bishop of the American Mission in Ceylon.

Bishop Kulendiran was one of the three memb rs of the Public Commission appointed by the Jufna Public Affairs Committee in 974 to inquire into the nine d aths at the Fourth International Tamil Research Con erence held at the Voerasi igam Hill, Jaffna.

He was an active member of the Youth Congress and was the author of many books on religion, social affairs and biographies.

His funeral will take place at Vaddukoddai on the moraing of 17-2 92.

TAMIL VILLAGES BEING CHANGED INTO SINHALA VILLAGES

Reports from Batticaloa state that Tamil villages on the borders of the Batticaloa and Polonnaruwa District are being fast changed into Sinhala villages. Tamils have left their villages as refugees.

According to the same reports within the last three weeks three Tamil villages have been entirely colonised with Sinhalese people. During the last year in all 15 Tamil villages on the borders of the Polonnaruwa District have thus been changed to

Sinhala villages. The Sinhala settlement of what were once Tamil villages is being done with the protection and assistance of the Sinhala Army. reports further state that six Tamil villages which were under the administrative control of the Government Agent of Batticaloa have now been transferred to the administration of the Government Agent of Polonnaruwa after Sinhalese persons have been settl d in these former Tamil villages. Moves are afoot

Tamil villages also out of the Batticaloa administrative district and attach them to to the Polonnaruwa District.

MUSLIMS ROB REFUGEE FOOD

According to reports a gang of Muslim hood ums have attacked Tamil refugees at Vakarai and robbed relief provisions given to them.

The report adds that Tamil refugees in the area are provided relief food only once in two months by the Government whereas Sinhalese are given equal qu n'ity of provisions thrice a month.

All Young men Arrested Shot Dead

News reports from Trincoma'ee state that the Sri Lankan Army surrounded the villages of Killiveddi, and Seethanaveli from the 21st of last month and arrested all the young

men in the villages. The fate of the arrested persons is not known. The same report adds that during the round up five Tamils were shot dead by the Sinhala soldiers. The report also says that a number of Hindu templ s the areas surrounded have been damaged and efforts are being undertaken to construct a new Budd ist temple at Kiliveddi.

Four Tamils Shot Dead

Four Tamils were shot dead at Panchenai in the Batticaloa District when on Sunday, February 9. the Sinhala Army surrounded the village and arrested many persons in the village.

The four persons shot dead have been identifiep as Palipodi Ratnam, Gnanasuntharam, Gopalapillai Velapody, and Vellayar.

Canadian Government's Gift to Rafugea Children

The Canadian High Commissioner in Colomb has gifted a sum of Rs. 735,030/to the Refugees' Rehabilitation Fund 1983. The Aid has been given in the form of school uniform material and stationery for the use of children living as refugees in Vadamaradchy from Palaly and Trincomalee.

The Refugee Rehabilitation Fund has in a Press Note acknowledged receipt of the goods and has stated that it would shortly discribute the materials to the refugees concerned. It has also expressed its heartfelt thanks to the Canadian Government and the Canadian High Commission in Colombo.

7 SHOT DEAD IN TRINCO Sinhala Army continues Terrorisation

The Sinhala Army's terror campaign in the Trincomalee District continues According to reports seven Tamils have been shot dead; two have lost their legs and many have sustained injuries.

According to the reports in an indiscriminate firing indulged in by the Sinhala Army at Paattalipuram in the Trincomalee District four Tamils ded on the spot. They are Pattekutti Siva-

kumar, Packian Yogan, Arul and Chelliah Chitravel.

Pattakutti Sivakumar's mother Packiam and sister Jeyamalar (aged 9) lost their legs. Also many others were injured.

At Mutur Sinnathamby Sivapal of Koonitivu, a pedestrian was shot and killed by the Sinhala Army.

Also the same report adds that two lamils were shot dead by the Sinhala Army at a place called Mahinthapura.

I.P.K.F. Killings of Eelam Civilians

The Editor, Hot Spring.

President Premadasa appointed a commission to inqui e into the excesses committed by the Sri Lankan Forces at Kokkatticholai primarily at the instance of Joseph Pararajasingam the

TULF Member of Parliament for Batticaloa.

This commission had found the army personnel guilty of 67 innocent Tamil civilians including women and children. President Premadasa has promised that action will be taken against the guilty army personnel.

A very similar incident took place at Valvettiturai, when six IPKF soldiers were killed in an ambush by our freedom fighters. The IPKF then ran amok and killed 71 innocent civilians Including women and children. In addition they also set ablaze hundreds of shops and houses.

No one has yet raised objecrions in Paraliament to this wanton killing by the Indians. Is there one law for the Shri Lankan forces and another law for the Indian forces? Or is anyone in Parliament going to take up this matter and bring the Indian miscreants to book?

There have been several other such wanton killings by the IPKF, e g. storming into the Jaffna Hospital and

killing doctors, nurses and patients in all about 80 or the dropping of bombs at Chavakachcher market square which killed 17 civilians, If some M P, brings this matter up, the President will have to appoint a Commission to inquire into these wanton killings by the IPKF. If none of the members of Parliament wishes to raise his voice either perhaps through fear of India or his antipathy towards the Tamils, I am sure the International Community as represented by Amnesty International or like Organisation has a moral obligation in the name of humanity to force the President to appoint

It would have caused a great amount of grief to many an old stud nt of her and her as i tant teachers of Vada Hindu Girls' College.

She cannot go unremembered by many a parent and student of Vada Hindu Cirls'

After Graduating in Science at the University of Madras she d dicated herself to the teaching world.

I came to know her for the first time at Sri Somaskanda College Puttur when she visited the College as a memb r of the team that came to inspect under the leadership of Mr. S. P Satkunem who retired as an Assistant Director of Education and now resting with good health in his very old age in Australia.

After her inspection of the members of the team she addressed the Teachers. Her tirmness in in her address to the taff revealed her sincerity to

the task she underfook. She emphasised to the Teachers that the three Ds - Duty, Dedi cation, and D scioline are the hallmarks of a Teacher.

While serving as Inspectress of schools, she acceded to the request of many a leading citizen of Vadamaradchy to take up the Principalship of Vada Hindu Girls' College.

Her longer period of service in the Teaching field with pulse of the parents of Vadamaradchy who could ill afford a Private Free Education school with limited income derived from the facilities fees of the child-ren.

At the very commencement of the Satyagra'a Campaign late Mr Chelvanayakam, then the leader of the Ilankai Tamil Arsu Kadchi (ITAK) issued the following statement;—

".....We have no alternative. To desist from action would be to betray the trust that our people have placed in us."

"The necessary elements for the success of a campaign like ours are;—

- (1) That it is used in support of a just cause;
- (2) That it is by the desire and aspiration of the people;
- (3) The moral strength and discipline of those who carry on the campaign and those on whose behalf the campaign is carried on, must be above board.

Ideal Democracy

"Democracy is not merely the rule by a majority. It is based on certain ideals and principles which any majority must not infringe. To give a simple illustration, the majority in Parliament should not pass a law that all the people belonging to a minority group should have one of their arms amputated.

No civilised being would defend such a measure on the ground that it represents the view or opinion of the majority of the legisla ure.

Something very similar to this illustration is what is happening in Ceylon to the language of the Tamil-speaking people. A non-Tamil speaking majority in Parliement has decreed against the status of the language inspite of the determined and almost unanimous opposition of the Tamil-speaking people.

Struggle of Tamil speaking people

The Tamil - speaking people have put up a strenuous struggle for the adoption of Tamil as a language of administration and of the Courts in the Northern and Eastern Provinces and for the use of Tamil in the rest of the country. But the Government is proceeding to impose Sinhala in these Tamil-speaking areas as well. This is a most wicked policy of the Government.

It cannot be explained away by falling back on the plea

that it is sanctioned by the majority in Parliament. The whole Tamil-speaking nation revolts against these measures and the question is what we should do now!

Should we stand by and witness the liquidation of our race or should we act in circums ances similar to what Gaudhi and the Indian National Congress resorted to against the law of the country which was characterised as moral and patriotic conduct. Our party has decided to do likewise.

We are prepared

"We are prepared to face the consequences of our actions which consequences may be serious. We have no alternative. To desist from action would be to betray the trust our people have placed in us.

We have no misgivings about the strength or the capacity of the Government to resort to repressive measures and oppress our people. One thing is certain! Our campaign cannot result in danger, unless our actions are disowned by our people. The measure of its success depends on the extent to which our people get trained to resist the unjust measures of the Government that rules them without their consent", the statement concluded.

Campaign starts in earnest

February 20th was the day of the opening of the Assize sessions at Jatina. The opening was to be at 1 a. m. The Government Agent, Mr. M. Sri Kantha would have to leave his Kachcheri residence for the opening of the Assize session in his capacity Deputy Fiscal to present the mandate. It was 10-30 a.m., when Mr. Sri Kantha came out of his residence in a police jeep, accompanied by Mr. C. R. Arndt, Superintendent of Police and a constable. When the Satyagrahis at the Old Park entrance saw the Government Agent drive close to it, they in all about 20 to 25 lay prostrate on the ground, blocking the path of of the jeep and denying exit through that entrance. Nevertheless, the driver drove in and the front wheel tyres nearly got on to the necks of certain satyagrahis but they would not budge. A youth of 20, named Palani nearly went under the wheel. The Superintendent of Police,

unhesitatingly ordered the Police force to "hammer them out and clear the way". They baton - charged the satyagrahis, as the they lay prostrate on the ground.

At the Old Park entrance there were more constables than satyagrahis indicating that the Police had known that the Government Agent would leave for the Courts by that entrance and expected trouble as a result. In fact there were two to three constables to every satyagrahi. Dr. E.M.V Naganathan blocked the passage of the jeep in which the Government Agent was seated. Messrs. V.A. Kandiah, V. Tharmalingam, A. Amirthalingam and K. Thurairatnam joined Dr. Naganathan and prostrated themselves in fornt of the jeep. The Police attacked the five members with their batons but the baton blow on the Doctor was so severe that the baton broke into two, and one of the broken pieces got into the Doctor's hands which he tossed aloft much to the amusement of the spectatorsinspite of the seriousness of the occasion. The Doctor thus earned the approbation as the 'Iron Man' of the party. Although the satyagrahis were seated with folded arms and did not stretch a limb against the Police, the Police for their part trampled the peaceful satyagrahis and their conduct in this fashion savoured of irresponsibility, indiscipline and indecency. Their hooligan - like manner on the unarmed and defenceless sataygrahis incensed the feelings of those who had gathered around so that they themselves became participants in the satyagraha.

The Satyagrahis Act With Restraint

Meanwhile reserve volunteers who had stood by, rushed to the entrance and occupied it. Even members of the public crowded this entrance which was packed to more than its capacity. Thus from a handful of 20 - 25 satyagrahis, the number rose to nearly 500. Inspite of this increase in number, the satyagrahis conducted themsleves with the utmost restraint and sufferance which came up to Gandhian standards.

Calm Restored

Reacting to Police behaviour, the crowds became excited and angry. Of course hey had been sufficiently

provoked by the Police. As the City was alerted to the situation, more and more people surged. The Police Force found the situation alarming. They used tear gas and fired warning shots in the air Neither the crowd nor the Satyagrahis moved away. The Federal leaders appealed for calm and reminded the crowd that satyagraha was just the opposite of violence. The crowds then obeyed and left the entrance, while the volunteers including the reserves remained.

Student participation in satyagaraha

On 22nd February, 1961, the 'Times of Ceylon' and 'Virakesari' carried banner headlines of reports on the Satyagraha. St John's College, Advanced Level students met after the Police attack on satyagrahis and decided to join the satyagraha campaign if further attacks were made on the unarmed peaceful sataygrahis. This resolution paved for the way for student participation in the satyagraha campaign

CWC Support for Satyagrahis

On 26th February, 1961, at a meeting of Up-country Tamil workers in the Valukkapparai Estate, President

VENTHAN

S. Thondaman stated "Suppression of the Federal Party Satyagraha would mean a suppression of Tamil language and culture. The Ceylon Workers' Congress which has been striving for years for the workers, would not hesitiate to play its part for the restoration of the rights of the Tamil -speaking people Now let us all get ready even if it means a fight! If such a situation should arise. we must have food and clothing to last for three months" he concluded his speech metwith thundrous applause. What followed has become history.

SJV replies to PM's speech.

On 26th March, Mr.Chelvanayakam replied to the Prime Minister's broadcast of 25th which may be appropriate in the present situation:-

"At no time did we underrate the might of the Prime Minister's Government. We are quite aware that she has powers enough to turn the armed forces against us. We were and are aware that when the Prime Minister's forces turn their guns against us, we would be as helpless against her armed killers as her late husband was powerless, when he faced the gunshots of his assassin on that fateful day in 1959."

The Prime Minister has made a radio speech touching on the satyagraha. That speech is more fitting an imperial dictator speaking to his people than a speech made by a democratic leader to her people.

In fact the manner and contents of her speech correctly depicts the true stat us of the Tamil - speaking people in Ceylon. The rule over them is indeed colonial imperialism.

No attempt to solve problem

It is noteworthy that the Prime Minister's speeches touching on the struggle for freedom of the Tamil-speaking people adopt the political technique of imperialism. In her radio speech just before her departure to Great Britain, she made an appeal to those whom she called 'reasonable Tamils' to disown the actions of the mischief makers, viz. the Federalists. The Bristish imperilalists reacted similarly to the struggle for freedom of the Indian patriots. In this connection it could be pertinently stated that there was no section of the Tamil-speaking people, certainly not in the Northern and Eastern Provinces which did not fervently support the satyagraha campaign.

The analysis of the contents of the Prime Minister's speech revealed that she was prepared to examine the difficulties caused by the implementation of the Sinhala Only Act, when satyaraha was called off. She must certainly know that the essence of the claim of Tamil-Speaking people on the language issue is weightier than the difficulties caused by the implementation of the Sinhala Only Act.

Positive demands of the Tamil people

"The demand of the Tamilspeaking people is a positive
rather than a negetive one.
What they want is the granting of a certain status to
Tamil in the Administration
and in Courts of this Island.
The particulars of that status
and use had been given by
the Federal Party to the
Prime Minister.

The dispute between us and the Government covers more ground than the Language issue but for the purpose of this statement, I shall limit myself to the Language issue only. On that issue, our dispute is around the status and use of the Tamil Language.

SRI LANKA - THE SECOND BIAF

Mr. K. Thiruchittampalam of Chavakachcheri recently sent a memorandum to the E.E.C. countries through the French Prime Minister.

Mr. Thiruchittampalam in his letter said that donors of foreign aid to Sri Lanka should with hold the grant of aid to Sri Lanka in view of its history of violations of human rights and other crimes against the Eelam Tamils.

We publish the letter here to indicate how Eelam Tamils feel on the aid foreign donors give to perpetuate crime by the Sri Lankan Government-

We are definite that Your Excellency would received several appeals on behalf of the Sri - Lankan Tamils from Public, Human Rights Societies, Amnesty International, Christian Missionaries & Etc.

It is pointless to write theses of the various types of sufferings we, Sri-Lankan Tamils are undergoing under the Baudha Sinhala Imperialist Autocratic Barbarious rule of earlier Mr. J. R. Jayawardena and now of Mr. Ranasinghe Premadasa's Govt. To testify the facts some of the paper cuttings from news papers are enclosed and sent under seperate cover for perusal.

The Civilised world knows that ever since the British Colonizers left the shores of SRI LANKA, then known as CEYLON, the Sri-Lankan Tamil Community has been at the receiving ends under every regime of the Sinhalese rulers. The rights of the Tamils continued to be trampled upon systematically and callously. Their lands were and are still being grasped under the pretext of National Development projects and given over to the Sinhalese Hoodlums for perpetuation of continued commual troubles. Amparai in Eastern Province formerly known as Paddipalai was prior to independance, a predominantly Tamil region. Now only a negligible percent of the population of that region are Tamils. Even those that were allowed to remain are being driven to seek shelter in the nearby jungles by the STATE-TER-RORISTS- the SECURITY FORCES. Are they safe at least in the jungles? No. Not at all. The beasts of the jungles and the Sinhala beasts in the security - force, are taking heavy toll of their lives. This is happening in the final decade of the 20th. Century in SRI LANKA. Why was the U.N.O. formed? What purpose has it served? What has one of it's most essential organs the W.H.O. done to relieve the sufferings

of the Sri - Lankan Tamils. Hundreds of Women, Children and Men are dieing daily in the North & East of SRI-LANKA for want of Medical care. Most of the important drugs nearly 50 in number used only for critical medical situation are absolutely not available anywhere in the North & East. These drugs are not used to treat the wounded by the Noncombatants or Militants. What justification is there for banning the entry of such drugs into the North & East. Now a Sinster move, is afoot to close down the Medical Faculty of the Jaffna University, thus depriving the Northern Tamils of the services of eminant specialists in various fields. The main agreements now reached are as follows:-

The ad p ion of a single Economic Community denomination by 1999 in the Foreign and security policy it envisages a European Defence Pillar to serve as support between NATO and the Economic Community, along with new me-susres to enhance foreign policy

co-ordination. As to the aspect of social affairs, the aim is for a protocol allowing member countries to establish common labour policies. The other and most important matter is a statement on eventual European Citizenship to permit every economic community national the right to vote, no matter where he or she lives in the Community.

The weaker members like Britain, Denmark etc are looking up wondering what becomes of their economics. But it looks as if they too have to toe the line. This European Union also expects the newly 'free' Eastern European states to join this set-up

One wonders whether the imperialists after having engi-

neered systematic capitalist inroads into the Socialist. Countries to degenerate through Agents like Kruschev and Gorbachev, they themselves are concentrating and consolidating their positions for the exploitation of the world market.

We have earlier heard from Lenin that i prialism is the highest stage of capitalism. Now this European Consolidation of power or Confederation like the Habsburg Empire is it a further higher stage of something which we yet do not know?

Last week two important states men in the international erena reportedly made statements touching the conflict in the island of Sri Lanka.

Iron cally the statements have come from British Prime Minister, Mr. John Major, whose country has been the direct cause of conflict in the island and the German Chancellor whose country is sharing the major burden of the Eelam Tamil Refugee problem.

These two leaders have said that the conflict in Sri Lanka is an internal problem.

It looks as if the whole world is still not very clear about the exact meaning of the terminology in use-

When war broke out between the Croats and the Serbs in Yugoslavia, Western leaders did not presume that it was an internal matter Germany was one of the first countries to recognise the independence of Croatia Britain and her E. E. C partners played an active part in ending the war in Yugoslavia.

Thanks to the swift action taken by the Western leaders, the blood bath in Yugoslavia also came to an end. Whether Yugoslavia exists today or not is ano her matter. A number of European states have recognised an independent Croatia though an official obituary notice of Yugoslavia has not yet been published. In any event it is a matter of satisfaction for everyone that human blood has ceased to flow.

The war in Yugo lavia was not even a few months old before the Western world thought it fit to intervene reg rding the conflic as of international concern and not one that should be side-tracked as an internal matter.

The war in Sri Lanka has been going on for decades.

Several thousands have died Hundre's of thousands have been rendered refugees.

What is worse is that Britain too regards the conflict as an internal matter,

Indian forces were hired by J. R, Jayeward ene of enter not Sinhala soil but to lay waste famil Eclam territory. And they did the job well but had to give up the imperialist aspirations they entertained.

The Indian intervention not only laid waste Tamil Eelam but it created so much hostility amongst the Sinbalese that Mr. Jayewardhene had to finally abandon all lurking ambitions to continue in power.

When an Army claimed to be the fourth largest in the world entered the conflict on behalf of the Sinhala government, did not that act alone internation lize the the war between Tamils and the Sinhala Government?

There is the recent case of the Sri Lankan Government naming the former British High Commissioner, Mr. Gladstone as a persona not grata but the British Government rightly denied the Sri Lankan charge that the British diplomat intervened in the internal affairs of Sri Lanka.

Is it an internal matter when a government controlled by one people beloning to a particular race, speaking a different language and following a different faith imposes its rule at the point of the gun on a people belonging to a different race, speaking a different language and following a different faith. And wen the reign of terror of the former is taken to the very home of the latter, isn't it aggresion requiring concerted preventive action by the international community, as it sought to do in Kuwait recently?

Sinhalese Colonists Returning to their Homes M. P. Complains to President

A report from Colombo says that Mr. M. K. D. S. Gunawardhene, the SLIPmember of parliament representing the Trincomalee District has sent a telegram to President Premadası stating that Sinbalese persons from Kalutura, Horana Anuradaapura a d Tambutegama settled in Trincomalee ud r the Government's rehabilitation scheme in the Trincomalee District and r turning to their homes in their villages.

It is common knowledge that the Government, Baudha Sinhala Organisations and Sarvoda a are settling Sinhalese from outside in he Trincomalee District under pretext of relief and rehabilitation and carrying out Sinhala colonisation with the intention of changing the demographic pattern of the District.

Large sums of aid and subsidies are paid to the

Sinhalese to carry through this colonisation n ogramme. Yet most Sinhalese preferto obtain the relief payments and get back to their homes in their villages. This tendency among the Sinhalese has perturbed the Baudha Sinhala chauvnists.

So this M P. has sent a telegram to the President complaining that S nhalese colonists are getting back to their own villages. The M P it is learnt has further said that the Sinhalese are leaving for their villages because they fear the Liberation Tigers of Tam I Eelam.
