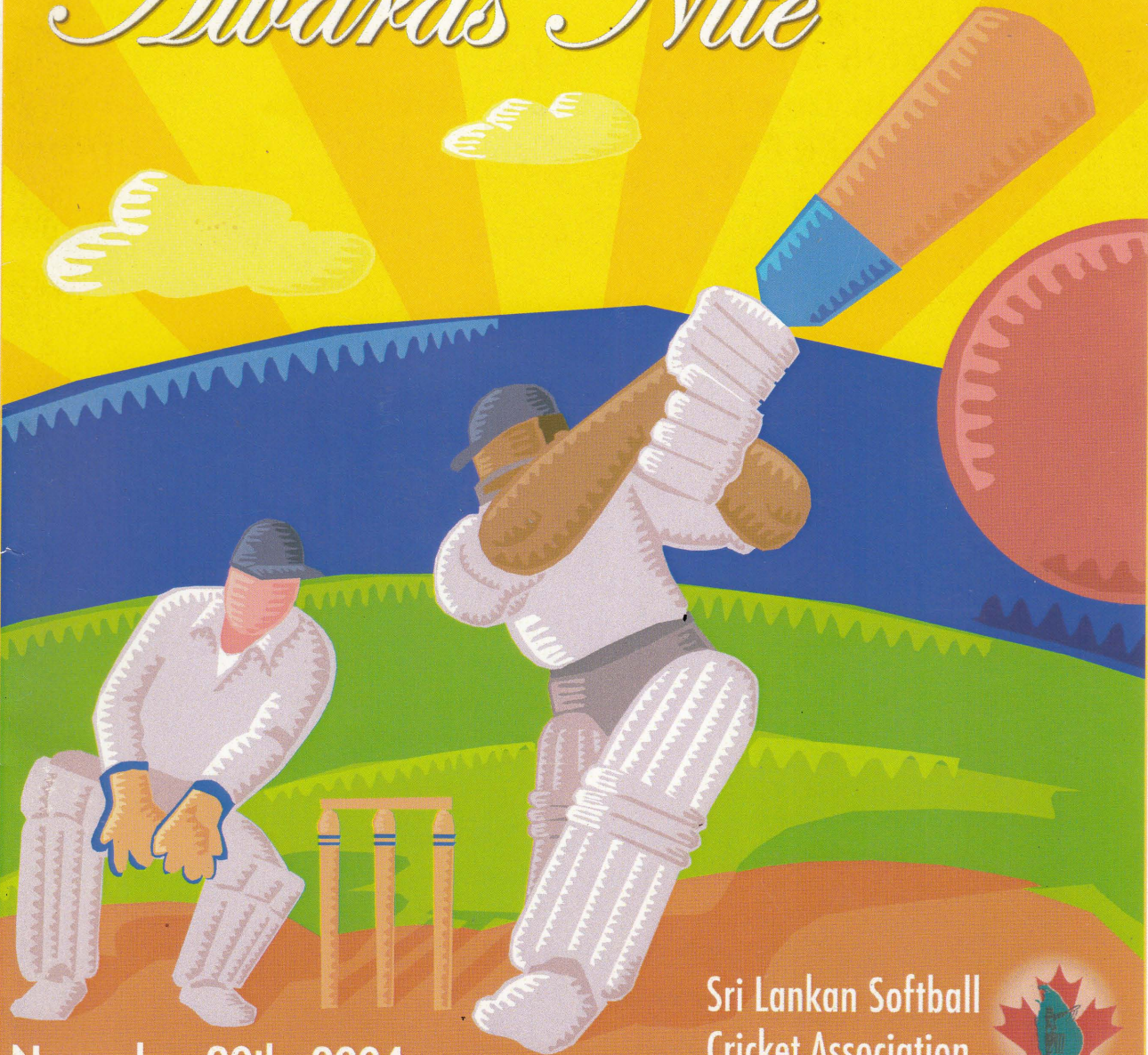

Dear Friends,

We will put a complete stop to this next year and I want all teams to support the Association to achieve this goal so that we all can play good quality cricket. The first step is, all Captains, Managers & Players must not use those throw bowlers for bowling. You all very well know and recognize who throws and who doesn't. Just because he plays for your team does not change anything. We intend to bring professional umpires from other communities if necessary regardless of the cost to put a complete stop to this issue in the near future.
