"The value of salt is realised only when the stock is exhausted", says the Tamil proverb. Since Mr. A. Cumarasamy's death I have heard many important men in Jaffoa talk at length on a number of his good qualities of which they did not appear to be aware while he lived.

Mr. Cumaraswamy, Princi. pal of Jaffua Hindu College since 1933, was a man who read widely and thought deeply. His convictions had all the quietness of the strength of his character.
