Navalar at Madurai

Navalar was welcomed at Madurai, with great rejoicings, by the learned Pundits, Othuvans and Tambirans. They took him to the Thirugnana-sambantha Math, where he was received by the Pandara Sannathikal (the Head of this Math) Navalar sojourned here for some days and worshipped at the temple of Meenadchi Sundaresar. The Pandara Sannathikal induced Navalar, to lecture on the History of the Madurai Shrine, the greatness of Lord Sockalingam, and his divine activities, the greatness of Saiva Siddhanta etc. in the inner hall of the Meenadchi Amman Temple.

Navalar's lectures were enjoyed by a large concourse of devotees. At the end of the lecture, the authorities of the temple and the High Priests, decking themselves with head attire, and taking the garland of flowers which adorned the Goddess, presented it to Navalar along with sacred ashes and blessed him. Later Navalar was taken to the Math, to the accompaniment of musical instruments. Every one at Madurai, praised Navalar's speeches and acclaimed with one voice that they never had heard such speeches before. They said that these speeches were outpourings of nectar! It was the stream of Siva's Eternal bliss! For some years Navalar's eloquence was not forgotten at Madurai.

Navalar delivered some more speeches at Thirugnana-sambandar Math, at the request of Pandara Sannathikal. The devotees were spell-bound with joy: The Head of this Math was so deeply impressed by Navalar's speech, that he took off his valuable ear-rings and fixed them on Navalar's

ears. The immediate assistant chief of the Math, presented Navalar with his valuable "Rudraksha" beads and honoured him. They had now an opportunity of getting all their doubts—knotty points in grammar and literature—cleared by him.

Navalar visited the shrines of Thiruvadakam and Thirup-pooanam. He also went to Thirupparankunram, where he prayed at the Shrine of Lord Muruga. After a sojourn with Pandara Sannathikal and after worshipping the Lord at Thiruppattur, he came to Kunrakkudi.

That was the place of the Thiruvannamalai Atheenam. Here he was welcomed by the Head of this Math. Here he gave several discourses on Saiva Siddhanta, and on the gains attained by those who follow the path of Siva Dharma. These lectures conquered the heart of the Head of these Atheenam, who overwhelmed Navalar with such honours as never bestowed to any before him. He was taken in procession on a palanquin accompanied by musicians. This triumphant procession was in typical Saiva tradition. Everywhere the words "Hara Hara Mahatheva" and "Navalar Vaiba" rent the air. It signified that the age of Gnana Sambandar had dawned and that the Tamils had come to know their "Nith Kuravar!"

An Analysis of the TIRUMANTIRAM

488 The cuckoo lays its egg in a crow's nest and the unsuspecting crow broods over and hatches it into a young bird. Similarly, people mistakenly believe (God's creation) to be their children and nurture them.

492 Though possessed of infinite greatness not equalled by any one however great, our Lord mingles in the bodies of even the smallest of His creatures and dwells in them. He the Great God Mahadevan, unknowable even to the Devas but realizable with His Grace by His devotees.

Section XV speaks of the classification of souls into three main classes and their sub-divisions:

There are four sub-divisions of Vignanakalar, three of Pralayakalar and three of Sakalar, total ten.

'Kalar' means those who are subject to Kalai and its progeny of Asuddha Maya tatwas. 'Akalar' means those who are not so subject. The word Sakalar signifies those possessed of Kalai, &c. This class of souls is subject to all three kinds of bondage, Anavam, Karmam and Maya. When after undergoing repeated births they become fit to attain salvation, the Lord appears in human garb as Gnana Guru and initiates them into the truth. Of the two classes of Akalar not subject to Kalai, &c, Pralayakalar are possessed of the two bondages of Anavam and Karmam. They attain beatitude at the time of Pralayam, when God gives them vision in His Divine Form. Vignanakalar are subject to Anava Malam only and they attain salvation without much ado through Vignanam or PatiGnanam, Godly knowledge, Divine Grace being vouchsafed to them intuitively. We refrain from entering here into details regarding the further sub-divisions and taxing the patience of our readers.

We have so far dealt with creation, &c, and created beings. The rest of the chapter (second Tanritam) speaks of certain virtuous duties prescribed for man and vices to be avoided. Sections XVI and XVII speak of charity and other offerings and the fitness பரத்திரம் and unfitness அபரத்திரம் of the recipients thereof. We read:
