Various abuses connected with temples such as the uprooting of consecrated images, destruction of temple buildings, employment of unbrahmin brahmins to officiate therein &c, were mentioned in the previous section, and the blame therefor placed in every case on the king's shoulders for his failure to perform his kingly function of preventing the perpetration of such evil deeds by his timely intervention. The new-section opens by making reference to an instance of the heavenly King's intervention to destroy evil. We read:

When the Devas with sweet-smelling garlands complained to the Lord regarding the atrocities committed by the Asura king Sooran and prayed for redress), the Supreme Lord told the Landsome 3 Pavalanathan son of Sinnared-complaxioned Arumukha Swamy to go and destroy their (the Devas') enemies.

The Sruti then proceeds to speak of Adho-Mukham, the esoteric significance of the jet-black throat, &c, and concludes as follows: We reproduce the last two verses of the section.
