Establishment Of Educational Institutions

Similar To Consecration Of Shrines

Tribute To Founder Of Mahajana College

Earlier Mr. T. T. Jayaram, B. A. Principal

presenting his annual assessment of the activities of the college commented in general on the problem of Education and said;—

Almost one hundred percent of the students in the Secondary Schools today have one primary objective in view, and that is to secure jobs on a monthly salary at the end of their careers at school, and what better instrument could they procure at school for this fascinating purpose than a knowledge of science and mathematics. They clamour for science and nothing but science. Our attempts to select students for the science stream at the end of the eighth standard stage have almost always been thwarted by parental pressure. This hunger for science is by no means a foolish craving of the mind; for we find in actual experience that even in the lower levels, students who, for one reason or another, fall by the wayside after a year or two of science education, are in a much better position to secure jobs as fitters and mechanics, foremen and workshop assistants than Arts students with full G. C. E. Certificates. Higher up the scale, students who have passed the G. C. E. examination with science subjects are able to obtain employment as technologists, engineering apprentices and technical assistants, while highly qualified Arts students, even graduates are not so fortunate. Besides, science has its own intrinsic value to its student. It brings him face to face with the forces of nature and with the triumphs man has scored over them. To it is due the vast expansion which civilisation has attained in

Tribute To Kalaipulavar Navaratnam

Kalaipulavar Navaratnam, wrote a book on "Studies in Hinduism" just before his death and it was later published by the Elakesari Press Chunnakam. Mrs. Maheswari Navaratnam invited Dr. T. M. P. Mahadevan, Professor Madras University to release the book and honour the author.

A public meeting was held for this purpose at the Vyadeshwara Vidyalayam on Saturday the 22nd instant at 6-30 p. m. presided over by Mr. P. R. S. Mani Deputy High Commissioner for the Government of India in Ceylon. The audience consisted of the elite of learned men professing several religions in Jaffna.

The president paid a high tribute to the scholarship of the late Kalaipulavar and unveiled his life-size portrait painted by Mr. Sivaprakasam of the tutorial staff of the Jaffna Central College and student of the late Mr. Navaratnam. Mr. M. Sri Kantha, Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Food and Agriculture and Rev. S. Kulendran spoke about his noble qualities, his scholarship, his love of art and his noble service to Hindu Art, religion and culture.

Then Dr. T. M. P. Mahadevan addressed the audience praising the noble life of the Kalaipulavar richness of his erudition and love of wisdom. He said that the book which he was releasing that day constituted a series of lectures which the Kalaipulavar delivered at the Christian Seva Sangam Chunnakam on Hinduism.

Dr. Mahadevan after paying his tribute to the Kalaipulavar, delivered a learned and instructive talk on Hinduism. He said that Hinduism was eternal and comprised the truths embodied in

THIRD TANTIRAM

The third chapter speaks of Ashtanga Yogam அட்டாங்கயோகம், the eight-stepped practice of Yogam and other forms of Yoga Sadanai, the results thereof and allied matters. There are 335 verses (Nos. 549 to 883) in this chapter divided into 13 sections, some of which are further sub-divided into a number of sub sections. The first is a long section of 83 verses, which describes Ashtanga Yogam and is sub-divided into eight sub sections, which deal respectively with; 1. Iyamam இயமம், which consists mainly of negative virtues, refraining from the performance of prohibited acts like killing &c; 2. Niyamam, நியமம், the performance of prescribed duties; 3. Asanam ஆசனம் different modes of sitting or postures; 4. Pranayamam பிராணாயாமம் or control of the breath; 5. Pratyakaram பிரத்தியாகாரம், abstention or restraining of the senses from roaming about at random; 6. Thaxanai தாணை, training the mind to concentrate on a fixed focus; 7. Dhiyanam தியானம், concentration and meditation on the Lord, and 8. Samadhi சமாதி, attainment of complete mental calmness.
