SUGGESTIONS BY SPONSOR OF VILLAGE RECONSTRUCTION SERVICE BUREAU

Mr. V. Kandiah, organiser of the Village Reconstruction Service Bureau, in a memorandum addressed to the Premier and other Parliamentarians makes, among others, the following suggestions.

I suggest, a "VOTERS" (ELECTORS') ASSOCIATION in every constituency with a view to make the elected member to be an instrument between the said Association and the Parliament. The elected member should tour his constituency once a month and have contact with the said Association office-bearers and leading men. Then only he will do his duty as a Representative of the Electors. He should tour in his area with the President and Secretary and any other leading member of the said Association once a month. He should submit his proposals to the Parliament in April each year and get approval for insertion in the next Budget for next year services.

The Parliament Members should serve their constituencies only with "half the amount of their present Allowances". That is real SACRIFICE or let them quit and there will be rush to apply for the post and serve at half allowance.

It is anticipated that many of the PART-TIME serving Parliament Members may "not like" the idea of combining present two constituencies into one and making one representative to serve both regions, owing to "their selfishness and unwillingness to spend more time in making monthly tours in their regions."

Let all those "unwilling members resign" their Parliament membership and go away, if they can't serve the country so, then there is no use of talking SACRIFICE, and adumbrating in platforms and newspapers.

All those who cannot serve the country so, are not fit for serving the country. Let them not obstruct.

Let them resign and make room for those who are willing to serve the country at such "sacrifice".

In Colonial Rule period, I understand, Members of Legislative Council served the country with much pleasure only with "Travelling Allowances."

The country can't afford to pay pensions for the PART-TIME serving Parliament Members.

The claim for pension by PART-TIME serving members reveals clearly how selfish they are; how unfit they are. They do not care for the bankruptcy condition of Ceylon.

It is imperative that a change in mind and in the present system of Ceylon Government is indispensable.

Even the Prime Minister, Ministers and other senior officers on the top ladders of Government should refund a part of their pay monthly.

I am also submitting separately a second suggestion re imparting FREE EDUCATION above H. S. C. and consequent acute unskilled labour shortage which will prevent Ceylon becoming (i) an INDUSTRIAL COUNTRY (ii) and SELF-SUPPORTING AGRICULTURAL and FOOD-PRODUCT PRODUCING COUNTRY. That suggestion consists valuable points.

Meeting In Memory Of Swami Sivananda

At a meeting of the Singapore Hindu Sabai held at Sri Ramakrishna Mission Hall, 9 Norris Road, Singapore, on Sunday 28th July, 1963, the members of the Singapore Hindu Sabai paid glowing tributes and respectful homage to the late Swami Sivananda Maharaj, who passed away recently, for his immeasurable service to the Hindu religion and the world of humanity.

Mr. P. Veluppillai, presiding at the meeting, said that although the transition of the great Swamiji has brought great grief and sorrow to the millions of Hindus in India and the rest of the world they should console themselves and feel happy in the thought that his immortal and noble soul has attained "Moksha" (Perfect Bliss) and his great divine and spiritual soul remains with them all pervading and as a true guiding light to their life. He then briefly touched on the various works of the great Swamiji—Saint—and recalled how the Swamiji had renounced his medical practice in Malaya and went to the Himalayas and founded the Divine Life Society at Rishikesh in 1938 for the purpose of dissemination of great religious knowledge and health science not only in India but also throughout the world and alleviation of sufferings. He founded hospitals, schools, feeding centres and printing press and wrote no less than three hundred books on religion in addition to the magazines known as "Forest Weekly" and "Divine Life". One of the principal teachings of this great saint was Love to all which contained in his epitome "LOVE ALL, HATE NONE!" Mr. Veluppillai said that he had no doubt that the hundreds of disciples at Rishikesh would continue

An Analysis of the TIRUMANTIRAM

(By A Science Graduate)

719 The self-existent Lady of Truth, She purifies and dwells in our hearts. She, the Mother of the heavenly world, churns and gives us ambrosial food, which we drink and transform the body into the Temple of God.

721 சோதனை தன்னில் தரிசு அறக்காணலாம்,
நாதனும் நாயகி தன்னிற் பிரியும் நான்
சாதகம் ஆகும் குரு வழிப்பட்டு,
மாதனம் ஆக மதித்துக் கொள்ளீரே.

As a result of sifting (and purification by the Guru), we find that bondage is destroyed. When the Lord parts from (Tirohana) Sakti (and imparts Grace as Gnana Guru), one should practise Yoga Sadana following the Guru's instructions. This will result in the acquisition of immence (spiritual) wealth. Pray note and take this to heart.

We have taken the word நாயகி as referring to Tirohana Sakti as it is the hiding Power that disappears and turns into the Arul Sakti that imparts Grace, and சாதகம் as referring to the practice of Yoga Sadana to suit the context. மாதனம் clearly indicates spiritual wealth or Bliss, and not ordinary material worldly riches.

If you succeed in controlling the twelve-footed horse (life-breath) and drink the resulting nectar, your body will not perish even if it is immersed in water or buried in the earth for two thousand years. We say this in the name of the Blessed Lord.

The twelve feet refer to the twelve inches or it may be to the twelve Matras (measures) of the exhaled breath referred to earlier. The words two thousand years' should not be taken too literally. What is intended to be impressed in the mind of the reader is that the body does not decay or die for considerably long periods of time.

The averment in the last quoted verse above regarding long life in this body is a sort of prelude that leads to what follows in the next section regarding சரிசுத்தி உபாயம், the secret of bodily vigour or longevity. The body is often represented as being of the nature of a drag, a source of pain and misery, and birth in bodhis as a deep sea, escape from which is a herculean task impossible of attainment. This is no doubt true when the body is improperly used for the attainment of worldly pleasures. But it forms a sort of talisman when properly utilized and a sine qua non for the soul to work out its salvation. We read :

CHINA-CHALLENGE TO CONCORD

Fretting and fuming with consuming anger, the irrepressible leaders of Communist China stand frustrated at the signing of the Nuclear Test Ban Treaty by Communist Russia along with the Western Powers. The axis of the Communist Powers has been rent asunder and the Cold War has changed its course. Ironically enough the Marxist Summit Powers have been forced by reaction of events to swing apart and become enveloped in a nerve-war. And China has chosen to bestride the Communist world like a colossus threatening to extend its sphere of influence elsewhere. That China having itself experienced the impact of imperialistic powers should now appear as the champion of imperialism is really a grim reminder to humanity that all is not well with the modern world.

The threat to peace and harmony is directed from Communist China with a vengeance. Russia started the revolutionary path only to find that there are others but too quick to assume leadership and elbow it out of the track. And now Red China in its impetuosity has arrogated to itself the responsibility of leading the world to destruction.

The willingness of the Russian leader to ban not merely nuclear tests but war itself, whatever the cause may be, must be accepted by the Western Powers lest Red China wantonly started a conflagration in its mad ambition for mastery. The massing of troops in the Sino-Indian border is a threat to the peace of the

world. No peace loving nation can ignore this haughty challenge of the Chinese to break the concord that is sought after by nations which have signed the Nuclear Test Ban Treaty. Malaysia, India and the United Arab Republic must get closer in good faith to check the Chinese wherever they dare rear their ugly head of aggression. Lanka has no choice in this affair but to pull her weight with the powers that strive for freedom.

the great truth therein. I saw the excellent Lord dwelling therein making it His temple.

I now cherish and preserve it.

There is a three-folded serpent of the shape of உ and அ, a contacting mechanism of twelve inches, and a two-pronged organ opening downwards. If one sits firm controlling the two openings, the body will not perish.

The serpent here is the Kundalini Sakti presiding in the fundament, the machine is the life-breath including the inhaled, retained and exhaled airs, the organ is the nose and the openings the left and right nostrils through which the breath passes. If one performs Yoga Sadana controlling the breath and meditating on the Lord, the body will last long.

It is the duty of the Yogi to contemplate on the Asa (Asabhai) Mantiram and never forgot it.

This injunction is practically identical with the third proposition of the ninth Sutram of the Siva Gnana Bodham, விதி எண்ணும் அஞ்செழுத்தே, contemplate with the Sri Panchaksharam as prescribed. Asabhai அசபை is a modified form of the Sri Panchaksharam, generally identified with the first of the five letters called பேசாஎழுத்து or mute letter, which is indicative of the Lord, as distinguished from the second letter which is called பேசும் எழுத்து or spoken letter indicative of Siva Sakti. It is said to be of the form of Kundalini Sakthi like a coiled up serpent, what we call Pillayar Suli, உ.

739. If you practise love, thus causing the Tirohana Sakti to become Arul Sakti, there will be an end to (the root cause of) repeated births, which multiply like paddy sown in a paddy field. Be calm yourself repeating the Asabhai Mantiram.

Section VI, which starts continuing the theme of longevity dealt with in the previous section, is entitled காலசக்கரம், literally the wheel of time. Time is an incorporeal entity, not cognizable by itself, but measured by the motion of the sun, moon and other planets, stars, &c. Reference is made in this section among much else to astrological calculations and we are told that dangerous periods in a man's life are the ages of 28, 33, 62 and 100. The section commences—

Departing from (the junction of) the five nerves and the region of the forehead and taking my stand at the twelfth centre the region of the moon, I proceed to investigate as to how the soul prospers there where the Lord resides and how it departs therefrom.

The twelfth centre is identified by some scholars with the pituitary gland in the head, a small body attached to the brain, and producing an internal secretion. It is called துவாகசாந்தம் or twelfth centre as, in addition to the six Adharas beginning from the fundament and ending with the forehead, there are said to be six centres in and about the brain and this is the last and highest of them.
