An Analysis of the RUMANTIRAM

Some misguided people speak glibly of the topmost step of Gnanam and aspire to become Gnanies like presumptuous high-jump athletes meeting with ignominious disaster by attempting to perform the impossible feat of jumping upstairs in one bound without using the staircase provided for the purpose. They speak disparingly of the earlier steps of Sariyai, &c, as paths prescribed not for "learned" people like themselves but for the ignorant masses. For instance, we may here mention that it pained us immensely when a responsible officer of the Saiva Paripalana Sabhai told us some years back that a prominent member and office-bearer of a longstanding Saiva organization in Madras spoke contemptuously of votaries of Kiriya Margam as gooti Qui q sago (literally carriers of worship boxes) votaries, be it noted, like the highly revered saintly Saiva Scholar Srimat C: K. Subramania Mudaliar, later known as Sambanda Saranalaya Swamigal when he donned the robes of a Sanniyasi in the closing years of his life. Such arrogant wiseacres would do well to note what Tiru Moolar says of the basic step of Sariyai (Section V):
