They seem to prosper for a time, but their ultimate lot is hell They ruin the country. They should be shunned by the virtuous. The king should disrobe them.

1659 False ascetics go to hell. They are not virtuous people. They resemble real ascetics (in outward appearance only) and enjoy worldly pleasures. Lasting good results only from (genuine asceticism coupled with) true Gnanam.

The forms of ascetics, Gnanies and Godly men are to be venerated. Asceticism leads to Gnanam and Gnanam to Sivam. The appearance of Siva Yogies is described as follows:

1662 The distinguishing features of a faultless Siva-Yogi are: firstly the wearing of holy ashes, then there are the golden ear-rings and garlands of Rudraksha beads Reciters (of Veda Mantiras) should chant the Sri Rudram.
