2335 The Lord .- He is everything, the existing (permanent) and the non-existing (impermanent). He is both these and not these. If we are to define Him in words. He is far, very far away (-so far away that we cannot dis-cover His nature-). Those who are able to realize this properly, to them indeed He is their very life.
