Moonlight indicates enlightenment, and darkness Anava Malam. The rest-house again is the heavenly abode. The idea is that the nature of the Bliss enjoyed in Heaven eannot be realized by or explained to worldly minded people. When one becomes enlightened he ceases to be subject to the limitations of Pasam or bondage Ascetics attain Heaven. Cf, the Siddhiyar words பாத்தைக் கரிசித்தோர் பரமே பார்த்திருப்பர் பதார்த்தங்கள் பாரார் those who realize God will remain serene seeing God only, they will not see any thing worldly-(bondage). Also Cf. Tiru Undiyar:
