8. A Mootootambipillai (1858 - 1917)

A. Mootootambipillai of Manipay was 21 when Navalar died. When Mostootambipillai returned from India in 1893, he wanted to settle down in the town of Jaffna. When he was informed that the house where Navalar lived at Vanuarpannai was to be sold; he seized this opportunity and bought it.
