this increasing demand for at each Campus. for higher education we must necessarily bear in mind the lessons to be learnt from our analysis of the defects patent in the (a) The Gangodawilla Camhastily established Pirivena Universities. Before attempting to set up new Universities it is necessary that the authorities concerned should satisfy themselves that adequate provision can be made not only for the accommodation of students, and for the necessary equipment but also for suitably qualified academic personnel in the various fields of study. It is recognised that there is a dearth of trained personnel in the Island, especially in Science and Engineering If we can recruit qualified personnel from abroad, we should take suitable steps to do so We are confident that if suitable steps are taken without delay the University of Ceylon can, within a decade or two, train the minimum personnel quired for the three lay Universities, which hope to see well established during that period.
