According to Shaiva Siddhanta, it is said that the atman associates itself with 36 tatvas some of which are asuddha by nature while some others are suddha by nature. Tatvas are supports for the atman to e press itself. But the atman is so pathetically merged in ignorance, that it always mistakes the support for its own self. Karmendriyas are organs of action and Juanendriyas are organs of knowledge. The Juanendriyas are the only channels by which objective knowledge is obtained. They themselves will not function unless they are helped by Sakshuma Bhutas or tanmatras which are located in the respective Juanendriya organs. A Juanendriya 2 Packialedchumy both of organ without the corresponding tanmatra is a lifeless organ or a defunct limb. For example the ear without the necessary sabda Sukshuma Bhuta-that issay the vibrating ear membrane is not a channel for obtaining objective knowledge. WHAT IS A TATVA-ATMAN

etesham eva samyogat tatva - atma purushah smritah | Tatvam etaih jagat krutenam pasah cha ete malatmakah []

Since the atman always aeeks to express itself by being in conjunction with the tatvas enumerated above, the atman is called tatva-atman, Tatvas are pasas or malas enveloping the entire universe,

Notes & Comments

Tatvas are called 'wa Cumis' in Tamil Shaiva Siddhanta literature. The above verse states that the entire universe of 'கிக்பிரபஞ்சம்' and 'அகித் பிரபஞ்சம்' is a huge mansion constructed on tatvas In the matter of the intestate and tatvas only. Sakalar & & wir.

Although there are 36 tatvas, most beings live in conjunction with the lower 24 tatvas only. In Shaiva Siddhanta, such beings are called # swi. Their associations, their acts and their tatva environment always keep them down in the lowest strata of living, of course in a religious sense. Of the 24 1 tatvas with which only they are familiar, the Boutas are their objects of knowledge. The intellect is their subject. Our Thamil Juana Shastras say that these beings called ##wir are kept down in bondage by all forms of folly and ignorance knowu to man. 'திரிமலத்தவர் சகலர்' says Umapati Sivacharya Swamigal.
