#### Spiritual Teachings

His spiritual teachings are the most important part of his mission as an Avatar. His consciousness is continuous and unbroken. Not only is the stream of consciousness unbroken from life to life but it is unbroken at nights also i. e. he remembers his past lives and he is conscious throughout the nights when we normally are unconscious in deep slumber. In other words he does not sleep as we do. It is at such times viz. during so called sleep he does most of his work. He leaves the physical body and travels in his Sukshma Sarira (Subtle Body) In a jiffy he reaches distant places and if necessary materialises himself i. e. takes on a physical body.
