Here we have only two seasons, the wet or rainy and the dry or hot seasons with their two monsoons the North East and South West The two solstices mark the beginn ing of winter and summer mark the beginning of winter and autumn seasons. As seasona occur in regular rhythm they are called Ruthus of which vasantha or spring following in the wake of winter is the most popular.
