Business Turn Over Tax In Another Bite

The Announcement by the Minister of Finance of the extension of the application of the Business Turn over Tax to various items including rice flour and sugar, coming as it does, on the eve of the presentation of the Annual Appropriation Bill, the National State Assembly has tended to more misgivings in the mind of the consumer.

The Commissioner of Inland Revenue has explained the implications of the Minister's Announcement at a Press Conference. We would wish that such proceedings are published for the benefit of the public as communiques.
