Justice Sarvananda's Dictum on Just Education

Appropriately Applauds Alma Mater's Achievements

Delivering the Prizeday address at his Alma Mater's annual function, Mr. Justice S. Sarvananda paid a gracious tribute to all those who had contributed to a national cause namely the founding of the Jaffna Hindu College and maintaining its cultural and academic status at high level and specifically referred to the significance of the signal services of the Jaffna Saiva Paripalana Sabha.

The Chief Guest in his characteristic way of clarifying view points placed stress on the need for disciplined life, devotion to duty and loyalty to causes. Continuing his speech the Chief Guest welcomed the establishment of the Jaffna Campus and hoped that everyone interested in higher education would do so. He was confident that a full fledged Campus would be developed early.

Mr. E. Sabalingam, the Principal, in his annual report referred in fitting terms to the eminence of the Chief Guest Mr. Justice Sarvananda and observed that the distinction the Chief Guest had achieved in his brilliant career as a leading counsel and later by being selected on merit for appointment as a judge of the highest Court of this Island also reflected the eminence of his Alma Mater.

In the course of his interesting report, the Principal, inter-alia referred to the problem of the day, the position of pupils in the context of the new scheme of education. Posing the question what would be the opening for those who unfortunately do not succeed in two successive examinations of the N. O. G. E., the Principal very cogently suggested that more Commerce Schools, Agriculture Schools, Technical Schools should be established by the State to enable these unfortunates develop their knowledge of practical education and obtain the requisite practice and experience for undertaking technical works.

An Appeal

Sir,
The Prime Minister of our country, Mrs. Sirimavo Bandaranaike, has returned after a very successful trip to distant countries on behalf of the nation. No representative of Sri Lanka has created such favourable impressions in foreign countries as the first lady Prime Minister.

From a perusal of the reports in the Press, substantial good will ensue as a result of Mrs. Bandaranaike's mission to foreign countries. Further, the place of Sri Lanka in the comity of nations and the prestige of our country, have been elevated and enhanced very considerably through the efforts and personality of our Prime Minister, well aided by her staff of officials who accompanied her. Everything redounds ultimately to the country's benefit.

This visit of Mrs. Bandaranaike has been an epoch making event in the annals of our ancient and historic land already distinguished in civilization and for its greatness, though small in territory and population.

While we congratulate heartily the Prime Minister and ourselves on the success of her trips to foreign countries, we would at the same time naturally wish for equally beneficial achievements in our internal affairs. Our Sabhai and the Opening of the Jaffna Campus

Without attempting to discuss the pros and cons of the political implications of the establishment of the Jaffna Campus of the University of Sri Lanka, we confine ourselves to the interest the Jaffna Saiva Paripalana Sabhai has in this question of national importance. The circumstances in which the Sabhai came to be formed by leading Saiva devotees could be summed up concisely as the inspiration of the Great Navalar and his ideals. Since that significant day on which the Sabhai was established eighty five enduring years ago, the propagation and promotion of the practice of Saiva Religion became the main plank of the programme of the Sabhai. That Saiva students should receive instruction in the context of the tenets of their Faith has been the objective of the Sabhai. And the Sabhai has been enthusiastically carrying out the programme under the inspiring guidance of eminent leaders such as Shri T. Chellappah Pillai, Retired Chief Justice of Travancore, Sir Ponnambalam Ramanathan, the distinguished scholar and statesman of that time, Shri P. Comarasamy, Member of the Legislative Council, Sir W. Duraisamy, Speaker of the State Council, Sir A. Kanagasabai, Member of the Executive Council, Shri S. Shivapadasundarampillai, the well known Saiva Siddantha Scholar, and many others of recent memory.

The remarkable result of the pioneer work of the Sabhai was the establishment of the Jaffna Hindu College, an institution that has earned the encomium of educationists as a leading centre of education and several affiliated colleges which are all steadily climbing up the ladder of fame. It will be enough if with this preamble we define the role the Sabhai has been playing in the affairs of the country, particularly in the sphere of higher education including the establishment of a University in the North. During the immediate past, the Sabhai has been ardently advocating the founding of a Hindu Cultural University and steadfastly supporting the movement for the establishment of the Ramanathan University utilizing the rich endowments of the great patriot and philanthropist, Sir P. Ramanathan.

Hence the Sabhai's interest in the opening of a Campus in the spacious precincts of Parameshwara College which was established by Sir Ramanathan with the definite purpose of developing it as a University. Steering clear of political policies and keeping a full eye on the need for preservation of Saiva Culture of pristine glory, the Sabhai has in strict observance of its special responsibilities welcomed the establishment of the Jaffna Campus at Parameshwara Puram and the ceremonial opening on October 6 by the Premier.

The public, particularly the religious minded public, enjoy the great tradition of playing host to those who perform a duty.
