### Ramanathan Name Rang All The Way

#### Campus Ceremony Conducted in Significant Saiva Tradition

#### Huge Gathering Applauded Homage after Homage to Sir P. Ramanathan

It was all a very impressive ceremony beginning from the Staff procession followed by the Pro Chancellor's procession right up to the auspicious moment, the traditional Lamp was lit by Premier Srimavo S. D. Bandaranaike.

The chiming of the Temple Bell, the chanting of mantras in clear resonant voice, the solemn notes of the conch, the rapturous music of Nanthaswaram, all reminded the eagerly awaiting audience of the Ramanathan rule in the conduct of such ceremonies in the Parameshwara College on ceremonial occasions.

The Campus having been formally declared open by the Premier whose purpose of the Jaffna visit was to honour the word given by the Minister of Education regarding the establishment of the Campus, and the welcome address by the Vice-Chancellor having been delivered, the Minister of Education, as Pro-Chancellor of the University of Sri Lanka, addressing the representative gathering outlined the history of the movement for the establishment of a University in the North and paid handsome tributes to the illustrious patriot, Sir P. Ramanathan and to his distinguished son-in-law, Shri S. Nathan, for the abiding interest they had taken in this matter, the former by establishing a first rate educational institution that could easily develop into a University and endowing richly for that purpose and the latter by his incessant agitation for a cultural

University in the North. The Prime Minister in her Campus Address explained at length how her revered husband, Premier S. W. R. D. Bandaranaike, had offered to open a Cultural University of the Vidyodaya Vidyalanakara type and how he was able to honour her husband's promise first by providing a token vote in the Annual Estimates and then by having the Campus established. The Premier referred to the great statesmanship of Sir P. Ramanathan as one who had strived for a united progressive Sri Lanka and had been honoured by everyone as a national hero of the foremost rank.

Mr. C. Arulampalam M.P. for Nallur in proposing a vote of thanks exclaimed that Sir Ramanathan was the greatest political leader the country had seen.

Dr K. Kailasapathy, the President of the Jaffna Campus in seconding the vote of Thanks mentioned in detail all the help and assistance he had been favoured with by benefactors and well-wishers.

The funeral took place yesterday, in the presence of a very large gathering.

### Stadium Speech Suggests Call for Unity

#### Premier Wants Positive Program For Progress

Speaking at the Thuraiappah Stadium Premier Srimavo Bandaranaike reviewed the impressions she had gained during her two day visit to the Northern City and summarised her inferences as indication for greater things to come in the future and that the economic situation should improve if the people paid undivided attention to the need for more and better cultivation. Touching on the subject of her visit the Prime Minister said:

"It gives me great pleasure to be here on my first visit to Jaffna. It was my intention to have come here earlier but various circumstances such as pressure of work as

well as the outbreak of cholera at the time when I was due to come here on food production activities forced me to postpone this visit.

"However, I am very happy to be here today because my first visit to Jaffna has coincided with the fulfilment of a promise. I do not have to go into the historical background to the setting up of a University Campus in Jaffna. You are aware that as far back to 1958 my late husband had the intention of setting up a Cultural University in this area. After his untimely death various proposals were put up and studied but due to changing

## From Campus Now to First Needs

What nature has gifted to the arid North, and how that blessing has not been made use of formed the main theme of Dr. Colvin R de Silva's address recently in Jaffna. That the all-giving Palmyrah Palm has potentialities which are good enough to maintain a fair economy in this country has been advocated time and again by the Gandhi Seva Sangam and the Society for the Promotion of Palmyrah produce. The renowned poet Somasundarar had in his inimitable style sung in praise of the scope of this 'Katpaka Tharu'. Tracts on the uses of this products of this precious palm are being distributed free by that prominent social worker, Shri S. Kanagarajah, almost daily. Yet it was left to Dr. Silva to remind the people of the North how they are searching for sugar, whilst having the source of that commodity in their own area.

Even at this late hour, it will be in the fitness of social work that immediate attention is drawn to the need for tapping the endless resources of that precious palm—the Palmyrah. If individuals find it difficult to have their palms put to the best use, they would do well to form co-operative groups to achieve the purpose of obtaining the maximum produce.

The present season when fruits fall from the palmyrah trees must not be allowed to be neglected. Every single fruit must be gathered and conserved for the nursery to be laid for collecting roots eventually. These roots serve to produce articles of food of different categories. There is the important by-product—fuel. The season that usually follows in January is the harbinger of all activities; such as harvesting, tapping palms for juice. It is during this important season next year that the people of the North must make determined efforts to collect all available juice of the all-giving palm and convert it into jaggery.
