They should state categorically whether they wish to register themselves as Indian Citizens under Article 8 of the Constitution of India, or not; if the choice is in favour of Indian nationality, the people concerned must also state their professions or trades. Meanwhile, it is not necessary for such persons personally to present the Passss or Passports in Colombo at the office of the Indian High Commission.
