An Introduction

We propose to stop here for the present. We have studied threee Sutras only, but we believe we have given a fairly clear indication of the ideas and trend of thought permeating these Sutras as a whole. The reader may now proceed to study them and form his own conclusions regarding them. But the one essential point that should not be lost sight of is the similarity of the relationships between man and wife in the temporal plane in its highest aspect and between God and man in the spiritual plane. We conclude with a quotation from St. Thayumanavar, which will help to make the position clear.
