A good Fate will make one work and enjoy the fruits of such work and a bad fate will make one slothful and not earn anything. Naturally such a view of Fate presupposes previous existence leading to rebirth according to one's own Karma and the Astrologer steps in and says that at conception and at birth the stars occupy suitable position according to one's Karma. Does such an idea preclude the functioning of an ordinary Fate, Ishwara, not necessarily so, because Ishwara has His own laws with which He himself is one and we humans with our limited understanding are able to get only a mere insight into the working of His Laws of which Karma is one.
