It is with pleasure we extend to you all a warm and cordial welcome. We appreciate your presence here this morning, which assures us of your abiding interest in the school.

Sr. Chairperson, We are delighted to welcome you and have you preside at this function today. We welcome you as a loyal past pupil and the Provincial Superior of the Holy Family Association - Jaffna Province. The Lord called you to religious life at a mature age, while studying for the CIMA, Part III. Because of your expertise and efficiency you were chosen to the offices of Secretary in Provincial Administration, Assistant Bursar, Bursar and Councillor. You were selected to SAIDI Formators' Course in the Philippines and a leadership programme at Martilac. The School is very proud of you.

We extend a special welcome to His Lordship Bishop Rayappu Joseph, Bishop of Mannar. You are no stranger to us for it was from Jaffna that you were raised to the hierarchy. You hail from the Island of Delft, the home of many scholars. While residing at Chettikulam you received the call to serve the Lord.

Having completed your scholastic studies at the National Seminary, Ampitiya and St. Paul's, Trichy, you were ordained to the Priesthood in 1967. You were a zealous pastor and worked in a number of mission stations before you proceeded to Rome where you successfully completed your doctorate in Canon Law.

On your return you were appointed Pastor of St. John's Parish, Chundikuli and also worked at the Matrimonial Tribunal as defender of the bond of marriage. On 6th July 1992 you received your appointment as the second, Bishop of Mannar and your consecration took place at the shrine of Our Lady of Madhu.

The young diocese of Mannar was part of the war-torn North East and you committed yourself fully to the suffering people and shepherded them wisely and with courage. You were outspoken on human rights and strenuously fought for the rights of the Tamils. Your voice was heard loud and clear in the country as well as in the world media. You worked tirelessly for peace with justice and spared no pains to take the cause of your people to the National and International forums thus making valuable contribution towards peace for all. We are glad to have your Lordship grace our function today.

CURRICULAM

Religion

Besides the teaching of religion we try to create an environment conducive to spiritual development. Modern communication media and fast changing life styles tend to erode the spiritual life of our children and lead them to neglect their religious duties. Hence religion and religious practices in school become doubly important. Spontaneous prayers are encouraged at morning assemblies. Every Tuesday we have meditation seated on the ground, according to Eastern tradition which trains them to recollect. Many of the school events are celebrated with Holy Mass. Mass is also offered to call for blessings on the students who are about to sit an examination.

Tamil

Tamil holds pride of place in the school curriculum. Tamil Day contests were duly held at school level and the winners sent for inter-school contests. Our senior drama “விடியலின் பிரகாசம்” was placed second at district level. In the competitions held in connection with Children’s Day Shyamala Anthonypillai and Chrispini Michael won first places in the senior and junior divisions respectively. Panoja Rajadurai won the first place for poetry in the competition organized by the Peradeniya University. Nitharsana Paramsothy was placed first at divisional level in the Tamil Eelam Students’ Day. Tamil Day was celebrated with the well-known writer, Mrs. Kokila Mahendran A.D.E Valigamam as Chief Guest. The senior drama “காப்பியக் கண்கள்” and the dance drama “அகல்யா” were greatly appreciated.

English

Greater attention is paid to the teaching of English and we encourage the students to take more interest in gaining proficiency in the language. An English medium class for grade 6 has been started and due to the shortage of teachers we have sought the assistance of past pupils who readily obliged us. Our school level competitions were held in June and English Day was celebrated on September 12th with Mr.S.Pathemanathan, retired principal of Palaly Government Teachers Training College as Chief Guest. The highlight of the day was “Excerpts from Shakespeare’s “Romeo and

Juliet", which won the first place at district level. Our students did well in the English contests conducted by the Department. At divisional level we got 7 first-places, 9 second places and 5 third places, at zonal level 6 first places, 6 second places and 3 third places and at District level 4 first places 1 second place and 2 third places.

Science and Mathematics

The Science Union organized an astronomy camp for students of Grades 7 and 9 on March 6th. The A/L Science students participated in the essay, speech and quiz competitions organized by the Jaffna Science Association and also displayed some exhibits at the exhibition conducted by them. The A.L. Bio students were taken on an excursion to observe plant and animal life and collect specimens for their study.

Aesthetics

The fine arts of music, dance and art attract many followers. Considerable talent is unearthed at competitions held by the Department and associated bodies. Noteworthy achievements were as follows:

Art

In the art competition held annually at divisional level Maureen Concepta Jesuratnam won the first place and Sulojana Seevaratnam the 2nd place in the intermediate and senior divisions respectively. In the art competition organized by the Hatton National Bank Maureen Concepta Jesurat nam won the first prize of Rs.2500/=. She also captured the 1st place in the art competition conducted by the National College of Education. Carmel Joseph won the first place and the Championship Cup in the art contest organised by Manipay; Leo

Club. Narmada Gunaratnam came second. Carmel Jasmine Wilfred was placed first and Sulojana Seevaratnam second in the competition conducted by the Jaffna Co-operative Union at District Level.

Music

Three of our Music students have gained admission to the Faculty of Fine Arts. Our group song was placed 1st at divisional level and 2nd at Zonal level. Renuka Satkunpalan of the Primary Section won the 1st place at divisional level and 2nd place at Zonal level for her performance in "Music and Rhythm"

Dance

At the Tamil Day competitions 5 of our students got places at divisional level. At zonal level Julainta Joseph was placed 3rd, Spelmala Kumar, second and Lumenda Anton Kulasekaram, second, in the 1st, 2nd and 5th divisions respectively.

Sports And Games

Our Annual Inter-House Athletic Meet was held on March 4th at St. Patrick's College ground with Mr. A.A. Milton Amarasingahe, Director General, Department of Sports Development Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, as Chief Guest. Rev. Fr. Paul Natchathiram O.M.I Superior, De Mazened Scholasticate, Columbuthurai was the Guest of Honour. Visitation House were champions for the fifth year in succession. Six new records were set up.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Guides and Little Friends

This year 10 Little Friends have joined the Guides and are preparing for their second Class test. Three of our guides Maureen Concepta Jesuratnam, Erica Cecil and Vergin Thanuja have passed their First class Training and have applied for the President's Award. Our guides rendered their assistance in conducting the Provincial Tamil Day Competitions. They were also on duty at St.Martin's Seminary during the Pentecostal Vigil.

For the first time a Seminar on "Child Abuse " was held at our school under the auspices of UNICEF. Our guides and guiders participated in this programme and also helped in organizing it. Two teachers, Mrs.Y. Premkumar and Mrs.Walter Iruthayarajan have been assigned to guide our Little Friends.

St. John's Ambulance Brigade

The cadets of St.John's Ambulance Brigade are doing active service both in and outside the school. They were on duty at our Annual sports meet and other events. On St. John's Ambulance day the cadets participated in the March past and other events and were given certificates. Our school received a shield for sending the greatest number of participants to the National Camp. 10 Cadets who were chosen as Active members and those who were raised to a higher rank were given certificates.

Interact Club

Our Interact Club has been active as usual. The membership stands at 71. Meetings are held every month to plan out the work of the club. Our interactors are on duty at the school entrance to regulate traffic during peak hours. The members participated in a leadership camp at Vembadi Girls' High school. Name boards for classrooms and botanical name boards for plants were prepared by our members.

A.L. Union

The Advanced Level Union contributes towards the solidarity and leadership of its members, and also builds up friendly relations with other schools. Representatives of the Union honour invitations to social functions

from other A/L Unions. The A/L Union of 2003 hosted their own get-together and lunch on October 5th. Prof.K.Kandasamy, Head of the Department of Physics, University of Jaffna, was the Chief Guest. The Guest of Honour was Rev. Fr. A. Jeyasekaram, Parish Priest of St.James' Church Jaffna.

Catholic Union

The Catholic Union helps to conduct prayers at the morning assembly. First Friday masses and Lenten devotions were arranged. A leadership seminar was conducted by Rev.Fr.Charles Collins, youth Animator. Talks were also arranged for groups of A.L. Students on contemporary issues and how to face them. It was a four day programme. The resource person was Rev.Fr.Joel S.J.Christmas Oli Vila was celebrated meaningfully.

Hindu Society

The Hindu Union organized Sarasvathi Pooja at Thurkai Amman Temple in which all the Hindu students took part. A sum of Rs. 5000 was donated to the society by Sivathamil chelvi Thangamma Appakutty.

Commerce Union

The moderator, Mrs.R.Atchuthmpillai and the President Miss. Karthiga together with the other office bears have helped the commerce students to engage in various activities. They have not only participated in essay and quiz competitions but also in field work in order to gain practical experience. A notable event was the publication of the 7th issue of "வணிகத் தளர்" the Unions magazine. The chief guest at this function was

Mr.M.V.Gnanakumaran, Prof, of Philosophy Jaffna University. Lectures by guest speakers from the University were also arranged to keep the students well informed of the latest developments in their subjects.

Prefect Body

The present Prefect Body was elected on Feb.18th, and it comprises of 33 senior Prefects, 10 Junior Prefects and 05 Primary Prefects, who meet every Wednesday to plan out their work. On Feb 8th and 9th our prefects participated in a student leadership training programme conducted by the national Integration Programme Unit, Ministry of Justice, Law Reform and National Integration. In June they attended a 4 day Student Leaders' Residential workshop at Kopay Govt. Teachers' College, conducted by Religious and Value Education Unit, Ministry of Education. They also attended leadership training for prefects organized by the Tamil Eelam students' movement. We commend the good work done by the prefects under the able guidance of Mrs.C.Rajaratnam & Miss.P.Benedict.

Computer Studies

Computer studies have been included in the school curriculum for A/L 2004 and 2005. In order to make full use of the unit classes are conducted daily in the evening and full day on Saturdays and Sundays for students from grade 6 up to grade 13. The six-month course started in June with 170 students. There will be an examination at the end of the course. Six teachers followed the Teachers' Training Programme conducted by NIE and ten teachers are following a training programme at our unit.

The S.D.S

We appreciate the services of the S.D.S, which has always co-operated with us and helped us in our needs. Renovations were carried out in various sections of the school with funds allocated by the Government. The computer unit was enlarged to accommodate 23 computers. The audio-visual unit was remodeled with an overhead projector and slide projector. A 1000 litre water tank and 100 chairs were purchased with the funds granted by the Ministry of Rehabilitation. The Primary section was redecorated by the parents doing shramadana work. Members of the S.D.S also helped to conduct English medium classes for grade 6 they also assisted at school events like sports meet and competitions.

The Past Pupils' Association

The Past Pupils' Association continues to give us loyal support. The A.G.M. of the Association was held on Feb. 12th, followed by lunch. Rev. Frs. M.R.P. Savundranayagam and A. Lawrence, both past pupils, graced the occasion. The constitution was revised to make it appropriate to the amalgamated association. As usual the P.P.A. made its contributions towards the school functions and committee members represent the Association at these functions. Our branch associations continue to give us financial support, for which we are very grateful. Dr. Sybilla Kumar from U.K., Mrs. Moira Philip from Australia and Mrs. Carmelita Patrick from Canada visited us and acquainted themselves with the needs of the school. Many past pupils coming to Jaffna from abroad don't fail to visit their old school. Particular mention must be made of Dr. Shanthi Thomas who undertook to finance the

extension of the public address system to the whole school. We express deep sorrow at the passing away of Mrs. Juliet Jesudasan our former secretary and an active member of the association.

Conclusion

As we are now in the 140th year of the school's history, let us pause for a moment to look back at the traditions it has handed down to us. The early European sisters were brought here at its inception with the aim of imparting learning and inculcating good moral values. The foundation that they laid in the formation of thousands of students regardless of caste or creed. In other words we can say that the school brought about a social transformation. It formed girls with sterling qualities who were known for their honesty, simplicity, respect to authority, charity towards others, spirit of service and spiritual involvement. Formerly students accepted their faults when they were pointed out and tried to correct them. This attitude is not found now. Students try to justify their faults. In Jaffna people tend to think that admission to the University is the objective to be attained in education. Ideals of building a holistic personality with proper values seem to have been given up. Studies have become examination oriented and a girl who doesn't pass her exam is regarded as a failure. The idea that their child should grow into a woman of strength, who can face any challenge and who upholds good human qualities is fast disappearing. Instead of forming good citizens this attitude tends to lead to aberrations. Many social evils like child abuse, use of drugs and alcohol, violence and disappearances, which were unheard of before have now become a threat to our children.

Though it was hoped that such abuses could be overcome through educational

இப்பாடசாலையானது 140 வது அகவையிலே கால்பதித்துள்ள இவ் ஆண்டிலே அதன் தாற்பரியங்களைச் சற்றுப் பின்னோக்கிக் பார்க்கலாமென எண்ணுகிறேன். அறிவுடன் நற்பண்புகளையும் வளர்த்தெடுக்க வேண்டும் என்ற நோக்கில் இப்பாடசாலையின் ஆரம்ப காலத்தில் ஐரோப்பிய அருட்சகோதரிகள் அழைக்கப்பட்டனர். அவர்களினால் நற்பண்புகளுக்கு அடித்தளமிடப்பட்ட இப்பாடசாலை இன மத வேறுபாடுகளுக்கு அப்பால் முழு மனித மாண்புகளையும் கொண்ட பல்லாயிரக்கணக்கான மாணவர்களை உருவாக்கியது. பொதுவாகக் கூறினால் இப்பாடசாலை ஒரு சமூக மாற்றத்தையே உருவாக்கியதெனலாம். ஒழுக்கம், கருணை, அடக்கம், கீழ்ப்படிவு எளிமை நடுநிலமை பிறருக்கு உதவும் பணி தன்னலமற்ற சேவை ஆன்மீக ஈடுபாடு ஆகிய குணப்பண்புகள் நிறைந்த மாணவர்களை உருவாக்கிச் சமூகத்திற்கு அளித்தது இப்பாடசாலை. அக்கால மாணவ சமுதாயத்தினர் தாம் விடுகின்ற தவறுகளையும் குறைகளையும் கூட்டிக் காட்டும்பொழுது அதை ஏற்றுத் திருத்திக்கொள்கின்ற மனப்பாங்கைக் கொண்டவர்களாக இருந்தார்கள். ஆனால் தற்போதைய இளைஞர் சமுதாயம் தாம் செய்கின்ற தவறுகளையும் குற்றங்களையும் சரியென நியாயப்படுத்த முயல்கின்றது. கல்வியின் இலக்கு பல்கலைக்கழக அனுமதி தான் என்று சுருக்கிக்கொண்ட யாழ் சமூகம் முழு ஆளுமை அடைவுகள் பற்றிய மதிப்பீடுகளைப் புறக்கணித்து விட்டது. பிள்ளைகள் பரீட்சையில் சித்தி பெற்றால் தான் வாழ்க்கை சிறப்பாக அமையும் அன்றேல் வாழ்க்கை வீண் என்ற நோக்கு பெற்றோர் மனதில் ஆழப்பதிந்துவிட்டது. இதனால் தமது

பிள்ளைகள் சக்தி மிக்கதான, எதையும் எதிர்கொள்ளத் தக்க சிறந்த மனிதப் பண்புகளை மதிக்க கூடிய பூரணமான ஒரு மனிதர்களாக உருவாக வேண்டும் என்ற இலட்சியம் மறைந்து விடுகின்றது. இதன் வெளிப்பாடாக சமூகத்தில் இன்று நற்பிரசை உருவாக்கத்திற்குப் பதிலாக குற்றச் செயல் புரிவோர் அதிகரித்துக் காணப்படுகின்றனர். இன்று சமூகத்தில் காணப்படுகின்ற சிறுவர் துஷ்பிரயோகம் பாலியல் வல்லுறவு, போதைவஸ்து பாவனை, களவு, கொலை, காணாமல் போதல், மதுபாவனை போன்ற சவால்களுக்குப் பாடசாலை முகம் கொடுத்து கல்விச் செயற்பாட்டை முன்னெடுத்துச் செல்ல வேண்டி உள்ளது.

சமுதாயம் உகந்த ஒரு மனிதனை உருவாக்குவதற்குப் பதிலாக இயந்திரத் தன்மை கொண்ட பண்பாடற்ற ஒருவர் உருவாகுவது அர்த்தமுள்ளதா? கல்விச் சீரமைப்பின் மூலம் இத்தகைய சீரழிவுகள் குறையலாமென எண்ணிய போதும் இந்நிலை மேலும் உக்கிரமடைந்துள்ளது.
