## **Welcome**

I am happy to welcome you all once more to our Annual Prize-giving. We greatly appreciate your presence here with us this morning. It assures us of your abiding interest in the school.

Madame Chair - Person, We are delighted to welcome you and have you preside at this function. Your association with the school is very close. Your mother of revered memory was a stalwart teacher in this school and the first President of the O.G.A. You too had your entire education at this institution and held the coveted position of Head Girl in your time. Being a person of varied experience which you gained from your work at the Bank, N.G.O's and also from your own enterprise we are happy to see you at present as advisor at the G.T.Z.

Following in your mother's footsteps you are also involved in social work, especially helping out young girls in difficult circumstances. Your extreme simplicity and genuine character have won you the respect of all. We thank you, madam, for chairing our function today.

We extend a very special welcome to our Chief Guest, Prof Nithiyanantham, Professor of Economics, Jaffna University. We are grateful to you, Sir, for accepting our invitation in spite of your busy schedule. Your ready acceptance is ample proof of your interest in the education of the young.

Prof.Nithiyanantham, is a person of high academic achievements and wide and varied experience. We are honoured to have him grace this Prize-Day function.

Prof.Nithiyanantham, had his education at Hartley College, the cradle that has produced many illustrious men. He entered Peradeniya University and obtained an Honours Degree in Economics. After a short spell as Assistant Lecturer in Economics he won the Colombo Plan scholarship which took him to Reading University in England. He returned to Sri Lanka armed with Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics and worked as lecturer in Economics at Colombo University till he came to Jaffna as Senior Lecturer in Economics and become the head of the department in 1984. In the meantime he won the Commonwealth Fellowship and was a Visiting Lecturer at the University of Reading.

Prof Nithiyanantham became the Founder Professor in Agricultural Economics when the Faculty of Agriculture was set up in Jaffna. Three years later he migrated to New Zealand where he joined the Massey University in Auckland as Senior Lecturer.

He returned to Sri Lanka a year ago. He holds the position of Professor of Economics at the Jaffna University at present.

Besides his academic work he has also written several books on Economics and articles in journals of international repute and serves as consultant to several bodies, institutions and universities, we are fortunate to have him as our chief guest today.

We are also happy to welcome Rev. Fr.A.Jeevendra Paul, O.M.I Provincial of the Jaffna Province. Father A Jeevendra Paul is no stranger to us. He has involved himself in many of our activities especially in the A. L. classes. Coming from a pious Catholic family it was natural that he dedicate himself to the service of God. We all knew him as a well-known preacher before he was installed in his present position.

Father Jeeva Paul is always available whenever we need him, to offer mass for the children or to conduct talks for them. Our girls have benefited immensely from the talks and leadership seminars he organized for them.

## CURRICULAM

### Religion

To ensure the spiritual formation of the children great attention is paid not only to the teaching of religion but also to its practice. We try to instill in the minds of the young true religious values through the daily practice of assembly prayers and Holy Mass on special occasions.

Talks are arranged by the Catholic Union for A.L. students on contemporary issues. A one-day programme was arranged for all the upper classes on leadership, spirituality and psychology.

Christmas. Oli Vila was celebrated in the open air as a night festival and was greatly appreciated.

One of our students, Nitharshana Paramsothy came first in the Island in the

religious knowledge contest conducted by the Siva Paripalana Sabha and was awarded a gold medal.

## **Tamil**

Every effort is taken to help students develop their creative skills by providing opportunities for taking part in contests, debates, drama etc.,.

In the inter school contests held at zonal level in connection with Tamil Day our students got 2<sup>nd</sup> place in two group events, Dance, and Folk Drama and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in Villupattu. Dharmini Edward Premkumar and Dharshini Gnanendran both came second in Individual Dancing and Chanting Poetry respectively.

Tamil Day was held this year with Mr. Aru. Thirumurugan (Vice Principal, Skanda-varodaya College) . The classical drama “புகழ் கொண்ட பார்” was staged on this occasion, Anne Thushyanthy Joseph was adjudged the best actress. Juditta Anton won the first prize in the essay contest held at District Level in connection with World Food Day. Infanta Shyani Selvam Gomez came first in the essay competition conducted by White Pigeon Technical Institute of Prosthesis..Our children also got places in contests held in connection with Children's Day and Elders' Day.

## **English**

We are glad to note that many parents have realized the importance of English in their children's studies and are trying to give them extra help to improve their standard. The

school provided a number of facilities to enable the students to do better both in their studies and in their use of English.

English Medium classes are being conducted for Grades 6 and 7 and it has been found that these students are doing better and their English is improving.

English Day contests were held at school level and competitors sent up for Divisional Level in all the activities. Our students have done well. We got 6 first places, 7 second place and 11 third places. Our senior group song was placed first . Our junior group song, primary drama and senior poetic drama got second places.

## **Science and Maths**

The Science-Maths Union organized an Astronomy Camp for grade 9 students on March 19<sup>th</sup>, A team of In-Service Advisors were there to give explanations.

40 students from grades 6-13 participated in the quiz contest conducted by the Science-Maths Union of Jaffna Hindu College, and 8 students from the Advanced Level in the competitions conducted by the Jaffna Science Association. Science Day was held on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2004 with Dr.T.Kalamany from the Dept of Education, University of Jaffna as Chief Guest

Our students from grades 8,9 and 11 got 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in the Science-Maths Quiz at Divisional Level. Jeevasulakshi Jeevaratnam came second at Zonal Level



## **AESTHETICS**

Art, Music and Dance are not only popular subjects but noble arts. They fulfil the yearning of the spirit for beauty and harmony. They sharpen one's senses and enable one to appreciate beauty in nature and art. Considerable talent is found among the pupils and the various activities in school give them scope to develop these talents.

Notable achievements are as follows.

### **Art**

In the competition held by the Jaffna Co-operative Society Carmel Jasmine Wilfred came first and Sulojana Selvaratnam came second at District Level. Carmel Jasmine was placed third at Provincial Level and was awarded a prize of Rs. 1000/- Carmel Jasmine also got the first place in the competition organized by Ahavoli Center. Arani Ratnarajah gained the first place in the Art Competition held in connection with Tamil Eelam Students' Day.

In the competition organized by Jaffna T.R.O. Harriet Jeyashanthi John Antony won the first prize of Rs 2500/- and a wall clock

### **Music and Dance**

Our Music and dance students enliven the various events of the school by their performances. They also participated in the competitions held in connection with Tamil Day. Our dance drama came first at Divisional Level and several students got places in individual events.

## **Computer Studies**

Computer studies have been included in the school curriculum for A/L 2004, 2005 and 2006. The classes were held daily in the evenings. Full day classes were conducted on Saturdays and Sundays for 170 students from grade 6 to grade 13 for six months. An examination was held at the end of the course and certificates issued. We are grateful to Catwas .Com Computer Academy for helping to organize this course.

Five teachers followed the Teachers' Training Programme conducted by N.I.E. and three followed the course conducted by the Education Department.

### **Commerce**

The Commerce Union has organized various activities to enhance classroom studies and to enable students to gain practical experience. Essay Contests and Quiz Programmes were arranged as an impetus to students.

Preparations are afoot to bring out the 8<sup>th</sup> issue of the Union's magazine "Vanigathalir"

Guest speakers from the University were invited to give talks on contemporary topics. The lecture on "Share Market" by a chartered accountant was notable.

### **Home Science**

Forty students accompanied by the Home Science teacher participated in a Home Science Camp at Vaidesvara Vidyalaya on 19.10 2003. The students took part in the demonstrations in cake-icing, making short-

eats & etc... Preserved food was packaged and sold at a profit.

This venture was commended by the Zonal Director of Education

## **Library Week**

"Library Week" was organized from Oct. 21<sup>st</sup> to Oct 27<sup>th</sup> last year. Various activities were conducted to make children interested in reading. Quiz and essay competitions were held and students wrote their own slogans which they displayed in prominent places. Funds collected by students on "Flag Day" were used to purchase books for the library. Students and teachers were encouraged to donate books and talks were given by teachers, students and outside speakers. There was also a book exhibition.

## **SPORTS AND GAMES**

Our Annual Inter-House Athletic Meet was held on Feb 20<sup>th</sup> at Bishop Deogupillai stadium(S.P.C) with Mr. M. K. Sivapathaviruthayar, Regional Manager, People's Bank, Jaffna, as Chief Guest. Rev.Dr. B.J.Gnanapragasam, Rector, St.Patrick's College was the Guest of Honour. Clare House emerged champions after 11 years. A fifth house named "Theresa House" has been created in addition to the existing ones.

## **Mini Tennis**

We are proud to say ours was one of the schools selected for Mini Tennis. Forty students from grade 4 attended the training camp at St.Patrick's College on June 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. A competition was held among 12 selected students and four who were successful, namely Jetsoniya Kaithampillai, Gowthamy Thasarajan. Christa Sri Balendran and Carmelita Pathmarajah were taken to Colombo where they participated in competitions and were given certificates.

## **EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

### **Guides and Little Friends**

The guide movement contributes much to the formation of our pupils. The guides are enthusiastic workers in school and their helpful presence is felt at all school functions. There are 25 guides on roll and 15 Little Friends. There are a number of students being trained to be admitted to these two groups. Meetings are held regularly every Thursday. Baden Powell Day was celebrated in February. One of our senior guides, Mary Sinthuja Thilagaratnam had the opportunity to participate in the Guides' conference held in February.

### **St. John's Ambulance Brigade**

The cadets of St. John's Ambulance Brigade render active service both in and outside the school. They were on duty at the Annual Sports Meet, the 140<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the school and the Nallur Temple Festival. They also rendered assistance during the Provincial Tamil Day contests to the outstation schools that were housed on our premises.

### **Interact Club**

Our Interact club has been active as usual. It has a membership of 100. Our interactors are on duty at the school entrance to regulate traffic during peak hours. Our members participated in a two-day Leadership Camp at Jaffna Central College. They took part in the various games played and scored the highest among the 49 participant schools.

### **The Prefect Body**

The new prefects assumed duties on 30<sup>th</sup> Jan- Mary Sinthuja Thilagaratnam was chosen Head Prefect and Roshni Thushara Anton Deputy Head Prefect. The Prefect Body comprises of 21 senior prefects, 10 junior prefects, and 5 primary prefects.

The prefects render yeoman's service in assisting the staff and helping to keep order in school.

The 140<sup>th</sup> Anniversary was a happy occasion when the past pupils rallied around involving themselves in the planning, catering and serving. A sum of Rs 36000/= was also collected to defray expenses.

We were very happy to have with us Dr. Sybilla Kumar ,the President of the U.K. Branch and Miss Marina Martyn President of the Colombo Branch on this occasion.

The A.G.M of the Association was held on 2004.07.10 and new office bearers were elected. The P.P.A. had its Christmas Get-together jointly with the O.B.A. of St.Patrick's College.

### **The 140<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the School**

A memorable event of this year was the celebration of the 140<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of this institution. This convent school, the first in the island, founded in 1862 by a band of valiant French missionaries rose to its present proportions through the labours of the Irish nuns and their native counterparts.

The event was commemorated on the 5<sup>th</sup> of March with a Thanksgiving Mass at the Cathedral, presided over by the Bishop of Jaffna-A large congregation consisting of students, parents, past pupils and well wishers were present on this happy occasion.

The formal celebrations were held on the following day in the school premises. Rev. Sr. Margaret Muldoon, the General Leader of the Holy Family Association was the chief guest. A number of distinguished guests, including the Bishop of Jaffna, the Presidents of the O.G.A, branches in U.K., and Colombo and officials of the Education Department, graced the function. The cultural performance, comprising of Tamil folk dances was presented by our children and by sister schools. The Souvenir, "Familian Fragrances" was also released on this occasion.

### **Comments**

Before I conclude ,I wish to share with you a few thoughts that occur to me regarding the education of our children.

It goes without saying that the home is the primary educator of the child. It is the good example shown by parents and the values they impart that give the child the right orientation.

Present day children are open to various influences that may lead them astray unless a proper foundation has been laid. Our children have to be protected from the dangers they face due to a deterioration of morals that is undermining the Jaffna society. Moreover today's students are reluctant to accept and correct their faults and even try to justify them. Therefore superhuman tact and patience are needed when dealing with them.

The films and mega serials that are being telecast throughout the day are a menace and greatly detrimental to our children's studies. They not only waste the children's time but also give them false values. It will be much more beneficial if this time can be utilized in creative activities like aesthetics, hobbies and reading which can enrich one's personality.

In the present system of education children have their hands full with assignments, tests and extra curricular activities. Therefore they should not be overburdened with private tuitions. Childhood should be a time of joy. Young children need a lot of leisure time activities, the freedom to play, sing or dance and enjoy the company of parents and friends.

It is regrettable that some parents use their children to compete with their neighbours or to maintain a social status. Therefore I request parents to act with good judgement and awareness, in order to give our children good values in life so that in the future we may have a healthy society in our land.

In conclusion, I wish to express my gratitude to all who have helped me. I thank the officials of the Department the S.D.S and the O.G.A., our parents, well-wishers and prize donors who have given me able support. I express my appreciation to the principals and teachers of other schools who have honoured our invitations to our various school events. Thank you for your kind presence and participation.
