CURRICULUM

Religious Formation

Since our aim is the formation of a sound character and a solid religious foundation, due importance is given to religious activities. As religion is caught and not taught we are careful to maintain a Catholic atmosphere in school. It is the religious training they receive in school that will stand them in good stead later on in life.

At morning assembly a gentle music is played to help the children to recollect. It is followed by assembly prayers and inspiring thoughts for the day.

Important functions like College Day and Teachers Day are always celebrated with holy mass. When students are about to sit an examination mass is offered to call God's blessings on them. Lenten confessions and adorations on special feast days are other opportunities for spiritual growth.

Catholic Students' Union

The Catholic Union is very active. Its activities include First Friday Masses and organizing seminars for A/L and O/L students. A full day seminar was conducted for students from Grade 6 to Grade 13 by Valarpirai counselling centre.

Members of the union collected clothes and stationery to be distributed to students in IDP camps.

Owing to the war situation and the havoc caused by Nisha, this time our Christmas "Oli Vila" was conducted in a simple yet touching manner. Rev. Fr. Peter OMI delivered the message.

Hindu Union

Members of the Hindu Union participated in many activities. Out of those who did the religious knowledge exam conducted by the Saiva Paripalana Sabhai. 90% obtained passes.

The students also took part in the contests

conducted by the Department and won 2 places in the written events and 3 places in the cultural events, Pavithra Vijayakumar (gr-7) won the first place in garland - making. Four others also got places.

Seven students obtained distinction passes in the religious knowledge examination conducted by the Jaffna Municipality. Vithushana Vijayakumar (gr-6) was awarded a prize for outstanding performance.

As usual, the Hindu staff and students observed Saraswathi Pooja at Thurkai Amman Temple.

Tamil Union

The Tamil Union plays an important part in helping the students to develop their creative skills by providing opportunities for taking part in contests, debates, drama etc. which enable the students not only to speak and write better Tamil but also to appreciate Tamil culture and tradition.

Contests were organized in connection with Tamil Day and the winners sent up for Departmental Contests. We are proud to say Priyangi Kesavasarma came second in chanting poetry at District Level.

Tamil Day was celebrated with the usual enthusiasm with Mrs. Aruleswary Vethanayagam D.E Jaffina as Chief Guest and Rev. Fr. R Nesaraja as Guest of Honour. Items of song, dance and drama depicting Tamil culture were staged. The highlight of the occasion was the folk drama: Pari" which won the first place at District Level.

English Union

We are glad to see that the necessity for a knowledge of English has been recognized by our parents, as is seen from the results of the G.C.E (O/L) English medium students.

The English Union plays a considerable part in making English come alive for the students. It has done its share by conducting a variety of written and oral competitions. The winners were awarded certificates at the English Day celebrations which took place on the 5th of June with Rev. Fr. Justin Gnanapragasam, Vicar General of the Jaffna Diocese as Chief Guest. The items staged, especially the dramas were much appreciated.

My sincere gratitude and appreciation to Mac & Felician Ernest family for financial assistance for maintaining an English Activity room and the payment for our school English Volunteer teachers.

Information Technology

Information Technology is taught as a general subject in the G.C.E. (A/L) classes and as an optional subject in the G.C.E (O/L) classes, but we have extended it to all students from Gr -8 to Gr- 11, though the number of computers available is insufficient for all the students.

At the G.C.E. (O/L) exam held last year 21 students (18 in the English medium and 3 in the Tamil medium) appeared for the subject (I.C.T). All were successful. But the GIT results for 2007, 2008 and 2009 of the A/L exam have not been released yet.

At the GIT competitive exam conducted by the Jaffna Science Association this year, Nishalini Navaratnarajah came within the first 53 out of 4733 candidates and is eligible to do the second exam.

Many students participated enthusiastically in SEMP III Competition at Provincial Level. Altogether 152 CD's have been submitted from our school.

Aesthetics

The fine arts of music, art and dance are important especially for girls to make them cultured and give them a sense of beauty and harmony. Considerable talent is found among the girls and the various activities give them scope to develop these talents. Their performances have graced our stage at all special functions. They have also taken part in various competitions and brought credit to our school.

At the art competition conducted by the Department Catherina Anton of Gr-12 won the first place at Divisional Level and 2nd place at Zonal Level.

Drama and Theatre:-

This year we had two full day workshops for grades 10 and 11. The resource persons were artistes from Thirumarai Kalamanram. At the Tamil Day competitions our social drama "Ethatkum Oru Kalam Undu" (There is a time for every thing) got the first place at Divisional Level and second place at Zonal Level.

Commerce Union

The Commerce Union has been very active under the leadership of the president, Thenuka Jeromius and the guidance of the moderator Mrs. P.Thirugnanasampanthan.

Preparations are being made for the publication of the 10th issue of "Vanigathalir".

Class competitions were conducted among Gr10 - Gr13 students to step up their general knowledge in commercial subjects.

Our students who are working with the Banks functioning in the school are performing their duties satisfactorily. Last year one of our students, Babitha Yoganathan was selected for six months' internal training at the Bank of Ceylon.

Maths and Science Union

Our Science students have been involved in a number of activities. The president Hema Dusmine and the secretary Vijenthini Kumarakulasingam have been the live wires in organizing various events. under the guidance of the moderator, Mrs. P.Jeyarajah

The school Science Day was held on 06-02-2009 with Mr. S. Arivalahan (Dept. of maths and statistics, University of Jaffna) as Chief Guest and Mr. Ratnasingam. as Guest of Honour. The third issue of the Union's Magazine "Parithichudar" was released on this occasion.

In the Australian National Chemistry Quiz conducted by the Royal Australian Chemistry Institute, two grade 11 students passed with distinction and 4 others passed with credit.

A science exhibition was held on June 15th by the students of grades 6-11. Some of the exhibits were selected for the Zonal Level.

Last year Anne Annisia Annsale Rajkumar, an English medium student was placed third in the Maths Quiz at Provincial Level. This year too she has been selected to compete at Provincial Level.

A maths workshop was held in our school on 21-06-2009 at which students from neighbouring schools (St. Charles M.V, St. Mary's Vidyalayam) also participated. There were various activities which were evaluated and prizes awarded.

Environment Pioneer Group

This group has as its aim the preservation of a clean environment in the school premises and its surroundings. Fifteen new members have joined the former group of 25. The members are divided into 3 groups and perform their duties under the direction of the moderator, Mrs. Anoja Anton and their respective leaders. They also keep files which are evaluated at the end of the year.

The Library

Our Library has been re—organised for the benefit of the students. The books have been categorized into reading section, lending section and reference section. There are altogether 4890 books and 54 teacher's guides. 117 books have been newly attached this year.

300 students use the library daily. 58 new members have joined this year. Library week is celebrated from 21st to 27th of October every year. During this week General Knowledge Competition, Essay Competition and Tamil Poetry Competition are conducted and prizes are given to the winners.

Sports and Games

Our Annual Athletic Meet was held on February 19th at the School Ground with Mr.N.Seevaratnam, Asst. General Manager, Bank of Ceylon, Northern Province and Mrs.Nalini Seevaratnam as Chief Guests and Rev.Fr.Montfort Francis C.M.F as Guest of Honour.

It is inevitable that children growing up in an adverse environment are subject to various stresses. It is the work of the counsellor to relieve these stresses and bring the child to function normally. The need for counselling is felt very keenly among students affected by war, violence and other factors.

A special unit has been setup in the school to provide guidance and counseling to children who are troubled by emotional problems. Mrs.P.Patrick and Miss.I.Parameswary are in charge.

Seva Lanka held a seminar on April 7th on "The Problems of Adolescents"

Dr.S. Thirumakal and her team conducted a seminar on the same topic for the teachers.

The Director of the Counselling Centre for the Northern Province, Miss.S.Uthayakala addressed the teachers on the topic of "Stress".

The School Development Society

The S.D.S gives able support to the administration in the development of the school. The society provides funds for the immediate needs of the school, like repairing furniture, pipe - lining and cleanings wells. The salary of the cleaner is also paid by the S.D.S. It also advanced funds for setting up a computer room.

The members participate at all school functions and take a keen interest in its activities.

Past Pupils' Association

The Past Pupils' Association both here an abroad continue to give us loyal support in our activities. Our Branch Associations in Colombo, U.K, Canada and Australia keep in touch with us and help us generously by providing funds for the various needs of the school. I wish to thank all our branch associations for their timely aid.

With their help we have been able to employ two volunteer teachers and a day time security officer, provide under privileged children with exercise books and shoes and uniforms for the school Basket Ball Team.

Part of the expenses incurred in cocurricular activities, major school functions and taking participants to the Provincial and National level competitions is also paid out of the P.P.A funds.

I am glad to state that the committee of the Jaffna P.P.A works in close collaboration with the principal. Their presence at all school functions is an encouragement to us.

Mid - day Meal

Students from Grades 1 - 9 are provided with an adequate and nutritions mid - day meal under the World Food Programme. The W.F.P supplies the major part of the provisions while the school is expected to supplement the rest.

A committee drawn from the staff is monitoring the programme. Mrs. P. Thirugnanasampanthar is in charge. The assistance of parents has also been enlisted by the S.D.S.

A number of our students coming from a distance travel by C.T.B buses. To ease traveling difficulties it has been arranged to issue season tickets in school. Thus saves the students much time and trouble. A teacher Mrs.S.Tharmarajah is in charge.
