CURRICULUM

Religious Formation

The school takes special care to instil Christian spiritual and moral values in its charges. Great attention is paid to religious knowledge and religious practices to ensure the formation of a sound character.

The day begins with prayer meditation is conducted on Fridays. The Lentern devotion of the way of the cross and the sacrament of penance were duly arranged. Extra care is given in preparing the children for the religious knowledge exam conducted by the catechetical centre.

Catholic Students' Union

The members of the Catholic Union were at the forefront in organizing religious events and in creating a religious environment. The G.C.EA/L students regularly participated in the First Friday masses arranged for them in the Convent chapel. A day of recollection

was conducted for all the Catholic students in September.

Christmas "Oli Vizha" was celebrated on Dec. 7th with devotion and joy. Rev. Fr. Thayaparan delivered the message of the day.

Hindu Union

The Hindu Union had its usual round of activities for the year. The union under the teacher in charge Mrs. D. Nagendran planned its programme so as to enhance the knowledge and practice of religion. The students sat for the written exam conducted by the Saiva Paripalana Sabai and obtained good results. They also took part in the Competitions conducted by the education department and got 3 first places and 4 second places in chanting and speech as well as in making garlands, thoranam and kolam.

Due to unforeseen circumstances the Navarathri pilgrimage to Durgai Amman temple had to be cancelled.

Tamil Union

The study of Tamil language and literature form an integral part of the school curriculum. Besides this academic approach students learn to appreciate Tamil culture and tradition through the activities of the Tamil Manram which helps them to develop their talents.

Various contests were held in connection with Tamil day and the winners sent up for inter school competitions. Eeastina Wencslaus won the 2nd place in drama script writing at zonal level. Dilaxi Theivendran came 3rd at district level for chanting poetry.

Our students also took part in the verse writing and essay competitions held in connection with the Elders' Day and Children's Day and got 10 places in the two divisions. Mary Sonia Gonsals and Marin Rachel Mariathan won the 1st and 3rd places respectively in the essay contest held by the cultural Division of the Jaffna Municipal Council.

Tamil Day was celebrated with the usual enthusiasm. Mrs. K. Sridevi was the Chief guest. Rev. Fr. Thamilsenan, president of the Mannar Tamil Sangam was the guest of honour.

English Union

We are glad to see that the English Union has played a considerable part in making English come alive for the students. It has done its share by conducting a variety of oral and written competitions, in connection with English Day which was held on 12th July 2011. The winners were awarded certificates on that day.

Our students got a number of places in the English day contests held by the Department of Education.

Our junior group song got 3rd place and senior group song got 2nd place at divisional level. Our senior poetic drama "Mid summer Night's Dream" got 3rd place at divisional level.

We must not forget our English teachers who spend their energy in uplifting the standard of English in our school. Our G.C.E O/L English medium class got 100% passes in English language.

Miss. Arabi Shanthakumar got 3rd place at provincial level for oratory (prepared) in grade 13.

Information technology

There has been considerable progress since I.T was introduced as a subject in classes from gr. 8 to gr. 13. Results of the G.C.E O/L exam shows 100% passes in the Tamil medium and 89% passes in the English medium.

82 students and 2 teachers received their certificates in the school educational software competition 2010. The CD prepared by 469 students and another prepared by 44

teachers were submitted for the competition held in 2011.

A multimedia projector and a laptop were procured from the Rs. 300,000.00 allotted to our school in the national ICT excellence award.

Aesthetics

The fine arts of music, dance, art and drama provide an opportunity for students to develop their individual talents. They are also a means of instilling culture and refinement in a generation that is fast losing these values.

Students have done well in these subjects both in the exams and in competitions. Our students won the first three places in the art competition held at divisional level and also in the art contest conducted by the Nature Appreciation Club.

In Carnatic music our group song came second at divisional level and third at zonal level. Renuka Satkunapalan came first at divisional level and second at zonal level in the individual event.

Grade 11 students participated in the aesthetic contest and were placed 1st at zonal level. Our students also took part in the dance competition held by the A.G.A.'s division and in the full moon day programme.

Our folk drama "Kumbakarnan" which was presented at the Tamil day competition retained its 1st place from the divisional up to the provincial level.

The modern drama "Santa Claus in Jaffna" performed at the Oli Vilza was greatly appreciated.

A full day work shop on drama and theatre was conducted for gr. 11 students by

resource persons from Thirumarai Kalamannam.

G.C.E A/L students offering this subject obtained 100% results and 23 students got "A" grade passes in the O/L.

Commerce Union

The commerce union has been functioning actively under the guidance of the moderator, Mrs. T. Chandramohan and the leadership of its president Pratheepa Vincent and the other office bearers.

Our commerce students have done well in the G.C.E A/L exam and 6 have gained admission to the university.

The union organized a general knowledge contest for students from gr. 10 to 13 to increase the students' knowledge in this field. The winners participated in inter school contests and got places at zonal and district levels.

Members of the union have been working satisfactorily with the banks functioning in the school.

The union is looking forward to the release of the 11th issue of its magazine "Vaniga Thalir".

Our students participated in the quiz competition conducted by the education department Kubenusha Sutharshan won the 1st place in the short science fiction in Tamil in the competition conducted by the School Science Society of the National Science Foundation.

Lisy Levitha Xavier carried out a project on "water purification" under the Sri Lanka Science and Engineering Fair 2011 and it was selected as one of the first ten projects.

Both these students and the teacher who guided the project were awarded medals on World Science Day 2011 celebrations at the BMICH.

An astronomy camp was arranged for the gr. 9 students in order to awaken their interest in celestial bodies.

A science exhibition was organized for the students from gr. 6 to 13 and some of the exhibits were selected for the zonal level exhibition.

Three of our senior guides were recruited for service at the International Camp for the Differently abled that took place from Aug 11th – 17th they got awarded certificates.

A live-in awareness programme was conducted by Rev. Fr. Robin Confucius O.M.I at Pandatheruppu Retreat House. 40 A/L students participated in this programme.

Nature Appreciation Club

This club was inaugurated on 14.02.2011 by Rev. Sr. Ladislaus with an initial membership of 35 students and 2 moderators.

Professor Kottagama from the University of Colombo set the club going by initiating its first project. The members attended a talk by him at St. Johns College on "The preservation of the environment" they also participated in a seminar conducted by ORAN in connection with World Literacy Day.

Essay and Art competitions were held. The English essay written by Ann Annisia Rajkumar was placed 1st, 16 students were awarded certificates and the best ones received valuable books autographed by Professor Kotagama.

The club holds its meeting every month and draws up plans to enhance the natural environment of the school through Shramadana. It also seeks to create ecological awareness among students.

The inauguration of the 150th year celebration was held on the 17th of November 2011 and the past pupils' Association contributed in the organizing of this event.

On the 26th of November a Holy Mass was offered for the repose of the souls of the deceased past principals, teachers, students and workers of the school.

School Development Society

We express our thanks to the SDS for its cooperation and support in the activities of the school. The members of the SDS personally assist at the school sports meet and other functions.

The society provides funds for the immediate needs of the school. The salaries of the office computer clerk and the day & night watcher are paid out of the society's funds.

The society has attended to most of the repairs in school, like the repairs to computer, photocopy machine, pipe lines and electrical fittings.

The work of laying a permanent basketball court had been dragging on for the past two years. This year we have been able to complete it with the funds received from Ministry of Education, Cultural Affairs and Sports Northern Province. The SDS has been mainly responsible in supervising the work.

Season Tickets

Over 75 students coming from distant places travel by C.T.B.buses.

To ease travelling difficulties it has been arranged for season tickets to be issued in the school. This saves the students much time and trouble.

Mid - Day Meal

Students from gr 1 to gr 9 are provided with an adequate and nutritious mid-day meal under the World Food Programme. W.F.P supplies rice and dhal and Rs.250 per child which is paid through the S.D.S

A kitchen and storeroom have been set up for this purpose. Five parents work on a voluntary basis in the preparation of the meal. A committee drawn from staff is monitoring this programme.
