Information Technology

This year Information Communication Technology has been introduced in the Advanced Level classes. Four students are taking this subject.

In the I.T Master mind 2013 Quiz, Priyanki Kesavasarma was selected in the On Line exam and came within the first 12 in the written test conducted at Provincial Level. She took part in the National Level contest and won third place at semi finals. This was telecast on the ITN TV. She was awarded a certificate by ESOF and a gift voucher for Rs. 50,000/=.

Innovative teachers and students competition was held on 2012. Our school teacher Mrs. Jenitavathany Jebanesan won the fifth place at the Provincial Level in the Grade 1 - 8 categories. Further more she has proved herself that she is eligible to participate in the "Expert Educator Programme 2013" at National and Global Level. Two members and a teacher visited Ilavalai Convent and shared their experience about their trip to Sinharaja Forest with the help of a computer. Three more schools have been attached to our school under the auspices of the Club.

The teacher's field event took place on 27th March 2012. The Resource Persons were the members of the Bird Watchers Club of Colombo.

The last event for the year was an excursion to the Jaffna Fort.

Environment Pioneer Group

The aim of this group is to create awareness of keeping the environment clean and beautiful. Twenty five students from Grade 8 are members of this group acting under the guidance of the moderators Mrs. S. Sriskandarajah and Mrs. A. Anton.

The group does Shramadana in school and grows ornamental plants. It also displayed posters on the importance of keeping a healthy environment. Trees

were planted on 15th November as part of the tree planting campaign.

The group has also planted a small vegetable garden. The vegetables grown here are used in the preparation of the mid-day meal.

St. John's Ambulance Brigade

44 cadets have been freshly recruited and trained in First Aid by Mr. S. Eelanesan the Asst. District Commissioner.

The cadets are on duty at Sports Meets and other school events and attend to injuries in case of accidents.

School Development Society

The School Development Society plays a major role in the activities of the school. The management greatly appreciates the contribution of the society both physically and financially.

The monthly payments for the day and night watchers, the office computer clerk, the cleaner and the periodic payments of the Basketball coach are paid out of the School Development Society funds. Various other expenses of the school like the Electricity and Phone bills and additional expenses incurred at school functions and the supply of mid-day meals are also met by the School Development Society.

We thank the committee members of the School Development Society for their unstinted support. Their presence and co-operation at all school

functions are always appreciated and welcomed.

World Food Programme

Students from Grade 01 to Grade 09 are provided with an adequate and nutritious mid-day meal under the World Food Programme. This is a great boon to many students in this area, who are living in difficult circumstances. This scheme also fosters unity and equality among students.

The School Development Society lends its assistance in implementing this programme.

150th Anniversary of Jaffna Holy Family Convent

Holy Family Convent, which functions specially for women's education in Jaffna, grandly celebrated its 150th Jubilee celebrations in 2012. The school in collaboration with the Holy Family Congregation, joined hands in celebrating this historical function. It was not only a mini function, but it created an opportunity to express our gratitude to all the Holy Family Principals and thereby regenerate the school's past endeavors.

Opening ceremony

The customary beginning of the Jubilee year of Holy Family Convent started with the offering of a Holy mass on 17.11.2011 at 4.00 pm in St. Mary's Cathedral which was organized by both the Holy Family Sisters and the school. Bishop of Jaffna Diocese, His Lordship Bishop, Rt. Rev. Thomas Savunderanayagam presided on this occasion and offered

the Holy Mass. Rev. Fathers, Rev. Sisters, Old students of the school, well-wishers and, many people participated in this simple and lovely occasion. This was the beginning for the Golden Jubilee celebration and this was followed by variety of celebrations, by the Old Girls' Association and School Development Society. Plans were drawn for a continued celebration for some days.

Publishing of diary & Calendar

With the aim of making of the Jubilee year a meaningful and fulfilling a calendar for the year 2013 and diary were published.

The calendar contains the history of the school, information about the special activities, and achievements of the schools these are depicted with pictures.

Following the publication of the calendar, for the first time in the history of the school a diary was published. The history of the school, Mission, Vision statement of the school, daily prayers, the details about the present Principal and teachers are included in this diary.

Competitions
