#### INTRODUCTION

Prize Day gives us a welcome chance to keep our parents and well wishers informed about the progress of the school. Our school as you know has a very long history having been established in 1862. It was the first institution in the North to prepare pupils for the Trinity College Music Exams. Our destinies were guided by the Europeon Missionaries who up to 1970 headed our institutions as its principals Our first native Principal Sr. Martina took up the reins in 1970. Today the strength of our school is 1600, whereas in 1922 it was only 300. Our present staff numbers 49. This will show you how changes inevitable in growth; have brought us problems too, in their wake. I need not tell you that the foremost amoung these are the lack of accomodation, the tution menace and the shifting sands of political and economic. policies. We often find the brightest pupil left behind in the race for University Admission, due to no fault of her own.

#### EDUCATIONAL PROBLEMS

The clamour for admissions continues unabated, classes become too unwieldy for efficient control. We have an assortment of pupils and teachers coming from different cultural & social back-grounds. Such a diversity in the school population itself poses a problem. Yet we try to intergrate them into a unified whole dedicated sincerely and loyally to the cause of education. Absenteesim is another disrupting feature. In spite of all help given by the department, furniture is inadequate to meet the needs of the pupils. Class-rooms are over-crowded. One is also forced to compare with regret the present day pupil who boycotts tests with the earnest pupil of yesteryear who did not have the allurements of newly found middleeast riches. The picture is not rosy to paint.

Jaffna and Mrs. Nesiah. It was the first meet of its kind after several decades. Since we had never had an opportunity to hold athletic meets due to lack of playing field in the school premises. The Chief Guest congratulated the school on its well-organized display. Visitation House emerged champions. The relay events decided the winners. Josephine House were runners up.

Special mention must be made of Miss Amuthini Stanislaws who secured Ist place in the A.G.A. circuit meet in-Long Jump, 100 metres, 800 Metres, and Track events and was judged the best athlete in the women tract event. Nalayini Selvarajah, Koshala Ponnampalam & Joy Rose Maruseleen too deserve special mention.

The Tamil Union of the school strives to encourage students to take an interest in the Tamil Language & culture.

We are glad that it is now acknowledged as a powerful tool in education and culture as well, and is on the way to becoming a national language. school English Day in1981 was honoured by Mr. Anton Alfred former A.G.A. Jaffna as Chief Guest. An except from "My Fair Lady" titled "Eliza and the Professor" was greatly appreciated and won accolades from the Chief Guest. Last year our school won first places in Gr. VI (Reading) and action song and Grade 8 and 9 Choral Recitation at the District Level English competitions held by the Education Department. Our playlet presented by Gr 7 won second place at the circuit level contest. We won first and second places at the Reading and Composition contests held for Grade Eleven pupils.

We met with outstanding success in the Western Singing District contests held by the Department. We won first places in all Junior, Intermediate & Senior contests.

#### SCIENCE UNION

The Science Union participates in many competitions held by the Association for the Advancement of Science in These vary from speech Sri Lanka. addition it quizes. In contests to participates in the activities of the Thondaimanaru Field Camps, such as the camp on Palmyrah Products (1981) The Energy Camp (1982) and the Camp on Electronics (1983). The Union holds regular meetings and participates in inter-school debates.

#### WESTERN MUSIC

The Western Music section has been singularly blessed with success this year. The convent singing groups have won first and second places for three consecutive, years in succession, in the contests held by the Jaffna Y.M.C.A. from 1980-1982 and won the championship shields in 1980. "The Lucky Trio' won first place, while, the "Marmalades" came second. In 1981, "The Seven Sisters" were first, while "The Familians' came second. In 1982 "The Familians' emerged first.

In the competions organised by the Education Department in the Jaffna District in 1982, our school won the First place in Part singing and singing in Unison. (Senior section) while the first place was won by the Junior Group too.

In the English Day singing items Grade 6 won first place for the Action song. "The Kings Navy", while the Primary school won Third place in the Grad e —7, and 5 singing contests.

The Western Music Band consists of thirty-six students grouped as Senior & Juniors. The Band performed at the Athletic Meet held at St. Patrick's Sports Ground and honoured the Chief Guest Mr. Devanesan Nesiah. It also plays at the important school events.

### A.L. COMMERCE UNION

The Commerce A.L. Union has completed its third year since its inception. Under the leader ship of Mrs. Chitra Rajaratnam the Union grew from strength to strength. Debates and discussions took general-knowledge place from time to time, on varied topics. The advantages of free trade, was a topic on which the Central college A.L. commerce union and our union had a debate. Varsity Lectures from the Jaffna campus are invited periodically to address the Union Mr. S. Kanagaratnam who works in the Education Ministry Colombo. addressed the Union on Public Administration. #### GIRL GUIDES

#### CARNATIC MUSIC

Carnatic Music is one of our Pre-Vocational subjects taught from Grade 6-10. In 1981 our pupils participated in the all Island contest. At the district level contest the intermediates won second place. In 1982 our pupils were placed first in the music contest at circuit level and third at district level. They also secured second place in Carnatic music in the intermediate section.

### BHARATHA NATIYAM(Oriental Dancing)

This classical dance form is taught from grade 6-10. In 1981 the intermediates and Juniors both secured 2nd places and were selected to compete in the all Island contest at which they secured second place. In 1982 they once again entered the all Island contest held at Trincomalee and won first place in the intermediates section.

### THE CATHOLIC STUDENTS FEDER-ATION

The Catholic students Federation was once again revived, under the leadership of Rev. Fr. Jesunesan. Retreats, and seminars were organised for the spritual benifit of the students who participated in them with great enthusiasam.

## THE HOUSE SYSTEM—REPORT CLARE HOUSE

In 1982 the four Houses changed names, thus honoring the most recent missioneries, who left after their period of service. Members too were re-allocated giving the Houses a new membership. They were also runners-up in Senior Net-ball and Junior Throw ball.
