

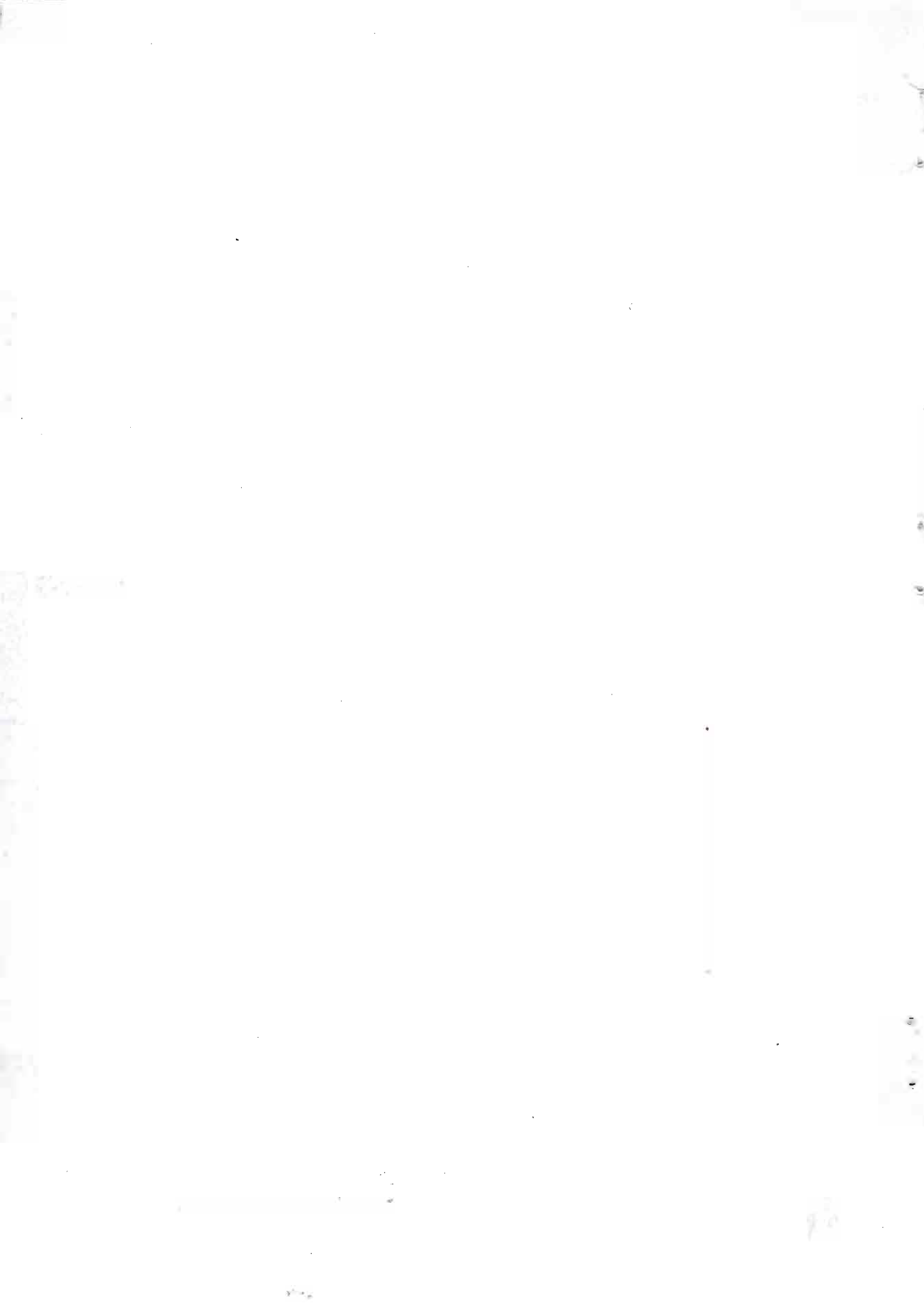


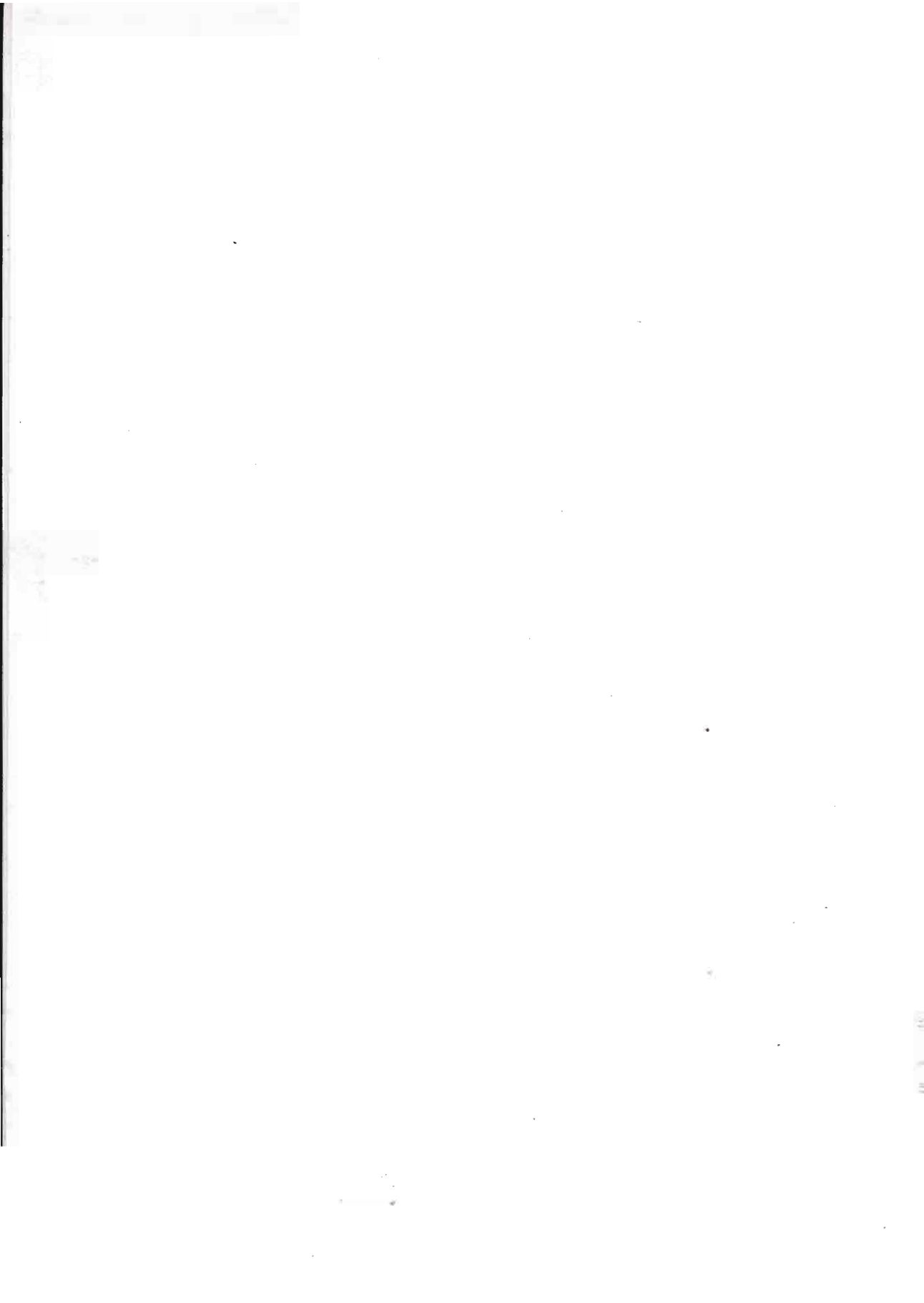

Earth Quake

We hear about earth quakes in our life time Via news on some people may have the experience in the earth quakes. The earth quakes great damages and loss of life. So they get our attention while they occur in highly populated area. This article discusses what is earth quake, how an earth quake begins, how earth quakes spreads and damage by earth quakes.

Earth quakes are a shaking of the ground. Caused by the sudden breaking and shifting of large section of earth's rocky outer shell. These occur when energy stored in elastically strained rock is suddenly released. This release of energy cause intense ground shaking in the area near the source of earth quake and send waves throughout the earth.

The force of an earth quake depends on how much of rock breaks and how far it shifts. Powerful earth quake can shake firm ground violently for great distance. During minor earth quakes, the vibrations may be no greater than the vibrations caused by passing truck. On average powerful earth quakes occurs less than once every two years. At least 40 moderates earth quakes cause damage somewhere in the world each year. Some geologist estimate that more than 800 minor earth quakes occur each day without causing any damage of those only about 1100 are strong enough to be felt.

If we see how an earth begins, the most earth quakes occur along a fault. The fault means a fracture in earth's rock by outer shell where sections of rock repeat slide past each other. Most faults lie under sea floor because the crust of the ocean. Stresses in earth cause large blocks of rock along a fault to strain or bend. When the stress on the rock becomes great enough the rock breaks and snaps in to a new position causing the shaking of a earth quakes.

Earth quakes usually begin deep in the ground. The point in earth where the rocks first break is called the focus, also known as hypocenter of the quake. The focus of most earth quakes lies less than 72km beneath the surface. The point on the surface of earth directly above the focus is known as the epicenter of the quakes. The strongest shaking is usually felt near the epicenters.

The release energy during the breaking of rocks produces the seismic wave's moves outwards from the focus in all direction. As the waves travels away from the focus, they become weaker for this reason the ground generally shakes less farther away from the focus. There are two types of seismic waves first one is body waves move through earth slower surface waves travels along the surface of earth. The body waves cause more damage to the buildings and structure the earth surface.

Scientists have developed a theory, called plate tectonics that explain why most earth quakes occur. This theory says that the earth's outer shell consist of about to large rigid plates and about 20 smaller one each plate consist of a section of earth crust and a portion of the mantle, the thick layer of hot rock below the crust scientist call this layer of crust and upper mantle the lithosphere,. The plates moves slowly and continuously on the asthenosphere, a layer of hot soft rock in the mantle. As the plate move they collide, move apart or slide past one another will produce the earth quake.

Earth quakes almost never will people directly, instead many deaths and injuries results from falling objects and the collapse of building, bridge and other structures. Fire resulting from broken gas or power line is another major danger during a quake spills of hazardous chemical are also a concern during an earth quakes.

The undersea earthy quakes causes one of the castle is tsunami. Anybody did not forget the world Tsunami after the following jokes tell us regarding this unknown world .one telephone call from Sumatra to Sri Lanka disaster management ministry.

Tsunami is gallant ocean waves that can rapidly travel across the ocean earth quakes that occur on the ocean floor can give a tremendous push to surrounding sea water and create one or more large destructive waves are know as

Eric Drexler, which he defines it as "Technology based on the manipulation of individual atoms and molecules to build structures to complex atomic specifications.

The technology, which Drexler speaks of, will be of the order of 'Nano' structures will only measure 100 nanometres, or a billionth of a meter. Such fine structures can only be seen with the STM, or Scanning Tunnelling Microscope that allows the scientists to not only to peek at the molecular level, but also to pick up and move atoms as well. But the STM has been regarded as too big to ever produce nanotech structures.

Researchers had an opinion that they are moving forward and will one day be able to produce Nano machines. One such machine is regarded as a replicator. A replicator, as its name implies, will replicate; much like the way in which genes are able to replicate themselves. Another perceived nan machine is the assembler.

The assembler is a small machine that will take in raw materials, follow a set of specific instructions, re-arrange the atoms, and result in an altogether new product. Hence, one could make diamonds simply by giving some assemblers lump of coal. Along with the assemblers comes its opposite, the disassembler. As a result of the enhanced production effects of assemblers Drexler believes that they will be able to shrink computers and improve their operation, giving us minicomputers.

These machines will be able to do all things that current computers can do, but at a much more efficient level. Through this and similar processes the possibilities of nanotech are endless. Hence, there is no limit to what nanotech can do, it could arrange circuits and build super-computers, or give eternal life. Nanotechnology could greatly increase our means of production. This new revolution won't require crushing, boiling, melting, etc. Goods would now be built from the atom up by nan machines one great advantage to nanotech will be the improvements it will lend in the areas of medicine.

However the good comes the bad, nanotechnology could take for new disease organism which might wipe out whole species, including Homosapiens and destroy everything including the human race. Nanotechnology capable to turn the biosphere to dust. Nanotechnology could give a life style never before imagined on the other hand it could destroy entire species.

Karnaugh map

Introduction

So far we can see that applying Boolean Algebra can be awkward in order to simplify expressions. A part from being laborious [and requiring the remembering all the laws] the method can lead to solution which though they appear minimal are not. The Karnaugh map provides a simple and straight forward method of minimizing Boolean expression with the Karnaugh map Boolean expression having up to four and even six variables can be simplified.

So what is Karnaugh map provides a practical method of grouping together expressions with common factors and there for eliminating unwanted variable. The Karnaugh map an also be described as a special arrangement of a truth table. The diagram below illustrates the correspondence between the Karnaugh map and the correspondence between the Karnaugh maps and that the truth table for the general case of a two variable problem.

Truth Table

The value around the edge of the map can be thought of as coordinates. So as an example, the square on the right top hand corner of the map in the above diagram has coordinates $A=1$ and $B=0$. this square corresponds. to the row in the truth table where $A=1$ and $B=0$ and $F=1$ note that the value in the F column represents a particular function to which the Karnaugh map correspond.

Note that the values of the input variables from the input variables from the row and columns. That the logic values of the variables A and B respectively (with one denoting true from and zero demoting false form) from the head of the row and columns respectively

Bear in mind that the above map is a dimensional type which can be used to simplify an expression in two variables.

There is a two dimensional map that can be used for up to for variables and a three dimensional map for up to six variable using algebraic simplification

Variable "B" becomes relaxant due to Boolean Theorems

Referring to the map above the two adjacent 1's are grouped together. Through inspection it can be seen that variable "B" has its true and false from within the group. This eliminates variable "B" leaving only variable "A" which only has its true form. The minimized answer therefore is $Z=A$

Tamizh, the aspiring director, is idealistic and wants to come up with a story that is interesting in every scene. His associates include passionate youngsters as well as an industry veteran who has failed to make a movie for a long time. Tamizh is married and his lover-wife Daksha is "eccentric" (the film calls her so). Daksha wants to see Tamizh as a film maker but at the same time, she is also wary of reality of daily life. Will Tamizh and his team be able to find a story and script?

The film is basically a witty commentary on the film industry and in this, it is quite similar to the recent 'Jigarthanda' which was also a film on the film industry dressed up as a gangster movie. Here too, you get the veteran breaking into a monologue on the disappointment that this glamorous industry offers to those who strive to make a mark. There is also a film being made within the film, and unlike Jigarthanda, here, we are given a fair linking of what kind of film it is.

There is a lot of Parthiban-isms in the film in fact, every character converses in Parthiban-speak, but this doesn't tire you out and in fact, most of them bring a smile. The director himself appears on screen quite a bit - sometimes to steer the story, sometimes to let us in on a later development and sometimes just to keep the film wacky.

The film moves forward and backward, sideways and at times even nowhere but the writing is quite good that we are always clear where it stands. Even when it is aimlessly chugging along, you feel that the movie is going somewhere. It is a proof of the confident writing that even though the stories in the film aren't resolved the film feels complete when it ends.

I think this is a starting to new trend. It is quietly good to the Tamil audience. Every director in cinema industry try to do different script like this. I love the way that move of the film.
