We are unable to succeed in our mission this year due to the terrible events that happened in Vanni. Our thoughts and prayers are with all the families who went through the hardship and are still suffering.

You all agree that we are the fortunate and well-blessed people and it's our duty to look back on our footsteps. I am sure that when we look back our immediate family and our alma mater would appear to be the main part of our lives and in the name of our school we all gather tonight.

Our aim is to enhance the quality of school life of the current pupils so we need to work so hard to achieve this goal. We need all your continuous support and expect you to spread the word among our ex pupils.

We are proud of our schools current academic achievements, 2008 GCSE result was remarkable. In Dec 2008, 14pupil had taken the exam in English medium for the first time since the compulsory Tamil medium was introduced. Out of these 14 Girls, 8 were awarded more than 5 A's from the 9 subjects. They had 100% pass rate. In Tamil medium 18 Girls was awarded more than 5A's and the pass rate was 97%.

A/L result too was excellent, 86% of the pupils are eligible for University Entrance. In summary 3A's - 13%, 2A, B - 16% 2A,C - 8%. Well done girls and we congratulate the teachers and parents especially Mrs Suntharesan for her guidance.

We can help them to achieve more and it's our responsibility to support and encourage them. Our school shows great achievements in extracurricular activities too but their main constrain is transport. PPK (UK) was approached for help in this aspect and this would be our target for next year and we all need to work on this.

I personally feel a shame of our membership number as there are several hundred ex Methodist girls live in UK and we failed to knock their hearts. I hope the new committee will focus on this and act accordingly.

Finally, I would like to thank each and every committee member for their active participation throughout the year, our vice patron Mr Jeyakumar for his guidance and Patron Mrs Suntharesan for her regular contact and support. At last but not least a big thank you for all of you for your presence to make this event a success.

Secretary's Report


This is my privilege to summit the annual report on behalf of the Executive committee 2009 - MGHS Past Pupils Association UK.
