I THE EMBLEM: The current Lion Emblem was adopted at the 1919 Convention. Today, Lions throughout the world are recognized by it. It consists of Gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field. Bordering this is circular gold area with two Lion profiles facing away from th center. The word "Lions" appears at the top and "International" at the bottom. The Lions face both past and future - showing both pride of heritage and confidence in the future. Always wear your Lions emblem pin proudly.

THE MOTTO: The official motto of the association is simply "WE SERVE." What better way to explain our mission?



THE SLOGAN: - The slogan is Liberty Intelligence Our Nations's Safety

OFFICIAL COLOUR: The royal colours of purple and gold were selected as the official colours when the association was organized in 1917. Purple stands for loyalty to friends and for intergrity of mind and heart. Gold symbolizes sincererity of purpose, liberality in judgement, purity in life and generosity in mind, heart and purse to those in need.

Natural disasters continue to devastate towns, cities and communities around the world. Time has come for us to be more mindful of the natural environment and be ready for such disasters. Let us make it our mission to create and maintain an eco-friendly, clean, healthy, pollution free environment within our communities by creating Green Team concept at club level through -

- a) Tree planting campaigns.
- b) Disaster Management & Prepadness
- c) Energy conservation WASTE TO WEALTH.
- d) Home Gardening and Animal Husbandry.
- e) Adoption of Green Cities and Green Villages.

2. Sight Conservation and Restoration

"Will you not help me hasten the day when there shall be no preventable blindness; no little deaf, blind child untaught; no blind man or woman unaided? I appeal to you Lions, you who have your sight, your hearing, you who are strong and brave and kind. Will you not constitute yourselves Knights of the Blind in this crusade against darkness?"

(Helen Keller)

Our mission is to preserve and restore eyesight in our communities by optimum utilization of facilities available at our own Sight First Hospital, Hendala, by provision of IOLs from the Eye Bank, and also by supporting cataract surgery programs centered on government hospitals and such other institutions.

Clubs are encouraged to:

- a) Optimize the use of Sight First Hospital facilities
- b) Sponsor Cataract Surgery.
- c) Provide 10 Ls & Spectacles
- d) Screen school children.
- e) Work with visually handicapped.

3. Building Bridges.

Lions can bring greater benefits to the communities by building bridges of communication and relationships with Government and Non-Governmental Organizations, Blue Chip Companies, and Large Hearted Community Leaders, as it would open avenues of access to better resources, leading to greater benefits at lesser cost. These relationships would also help in publicizing the noble services rendered by Lions, paving way for more and more qualified, socially responsible men and women to be drawn in to our organization.

Some of the bridges that clubs could build to derive such benefits are

- a) Leo-Lion relationship.
- b) Work with NGO's
- c) Work with blue-chip companies under CSR programs
- d) Work with G Os.
- e) Recognition of Non-Lian service
- f) Providing apportunities for youth
- g) Giving Special Vocational Training to differently abled.

4. Retention & Growth

"Is it worth filling a pail with a hole?"

Time has come for us to look deeper into this question, due to the simple reason that we find more ex-lions in the society, than our membership within. If we could have retained at least 50% of those ex-Lions, Lions International would have achieved the goal of two million membership a decade ago.

Our desire is to see that the club membership grows in numbers, and the number of clubs also grow in numbers. The lesser option would be to retain the existing membership 100 per cent.

5. Health.

"Health is wealth."

As Lions, we have a responsibility to play a major role in providing health care to the needy, and also do our share in the improvement of health care facilities to the people. Lions have always been playing a pivotal role in the provision of health care to the lesser privileged segments of our society.

Diabetes is looming as the greatest threat to humanity in this decade; projections are that one in every ten would be a diabetic within the next five years. Since elevated sugar levels cause serious harm to vital organs in the human body, effective screening and awareness programs could help to contain diabetes from reaching such life threatening proportions.

The best chance for a cancer patient lies in early detection, but social taboos, ignorance, poverty and fear psychosis, precludes many a patient from seeking medical attention at the appropriate time. We the Lions can play a merciful role within our communities by taking the initiative to enlighten the people through awareness programs that early detection gives the best chance for survival.

"Good eating habits lead to healthy lives". Medical Research has shown that consumption of fast food laced with harmful chemicals and preservatives is the main cause of obesity and diabetes amongst the young people.

Lions could save these young lives by embarking on awareness programs highlighting the benefits of natural and low cost nutritional food, very especially to the young.

Lions are therefore urged to focus the attention of your communities with programs such as

- a) Diabetes Awareness.
- b) Cancer Awareness.
- c) Multi-Clinics
- d) Care to handicapped
- e) Nutrition & Benefits
