

TO ENCOURAGE service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavours.

THE EMBLEM - The Current Lion Emblem was adopted at the 1919 convention. Today, Lions throughout the world are recognized by it. It consists of gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field. Bordering this is a circular gold area with two Lion profiles facing away from the centre. The word "Lions" appears at the top, and "International" at the bottom. The lions face both past and future - showing both pride of heritage and confidence in the future. Always wear your Lions emblem pin proudly.

THE MOTTO - The official motto of the association is simply. "WE SERVE" What better way to explain our mission?



THE SLOGAN - The slogan is LIBERTY INTELLIGENCE OUR NATION'S SAFETY.

OFFICIAL COLOUR - The royal colours of purple and gold were selected as the official colours when the association was organized in 1917. Purple stands for loyalty to friends, and for integrity of mind and heart. Gold symbolizes sincereity of purpose, liberality in judgement, purity in life, and generosity in mind, heart and purse to those in need.





# Lions Prime Product "SERVICE"

Service begins with the head before it influences the hands, feet, or tongue. There must be the will to serve before there is any pleasure or benefit from service.

We all join clubs not because of a sense of duty but because we feel that we have something to give and which we will enjoy.

Our inputs are the talents, the time, the energy, and the resources of our members. Our task is to transform the raw materials of our members into a finished product-SERVICE.

We can only achieve this task if we work together, but working together implies a need for organisation. Organisation suggests two things. First it requires a structure a President a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a board of Directors. This means that the typical club has been divided into separate, independent committees, each under the leadership of a Director, like a company divisional manager, each director is responsible for his particular "product" an avenue of Service.

A searching look within ourselves reveals the presence of an inner force which can enable us to transcend the barriers of our self centred thoughts, word and deeds to look beyond ourselves. With the release of this inner strength, infinite and dynamic, the human spirit soars to new and greater heights. It generates in us a vision and a mission.

The vision is of peace within, and a happy world without fear and want. The mission is to translate that vision into reality through positive acts of service. Through you, Lionism has this vision, this mission, because you have the powerful capability to look beyond yourself.

What does this really mean to you? Think for a moment. A new focus in life, from 'me' and 'mine' to 'OUR', emerges by first looking inward and then beyond yourself-to your family, your Club, your community, your country, our world Your thoughts are noble when they radiate Lionism's objective - to serve others. Your heart is generous when you seek to improve the lives and livelihood of others. Your caring hands express the power of your love when they reach out to help others. You truly grow when 'others' become a part of your world.




