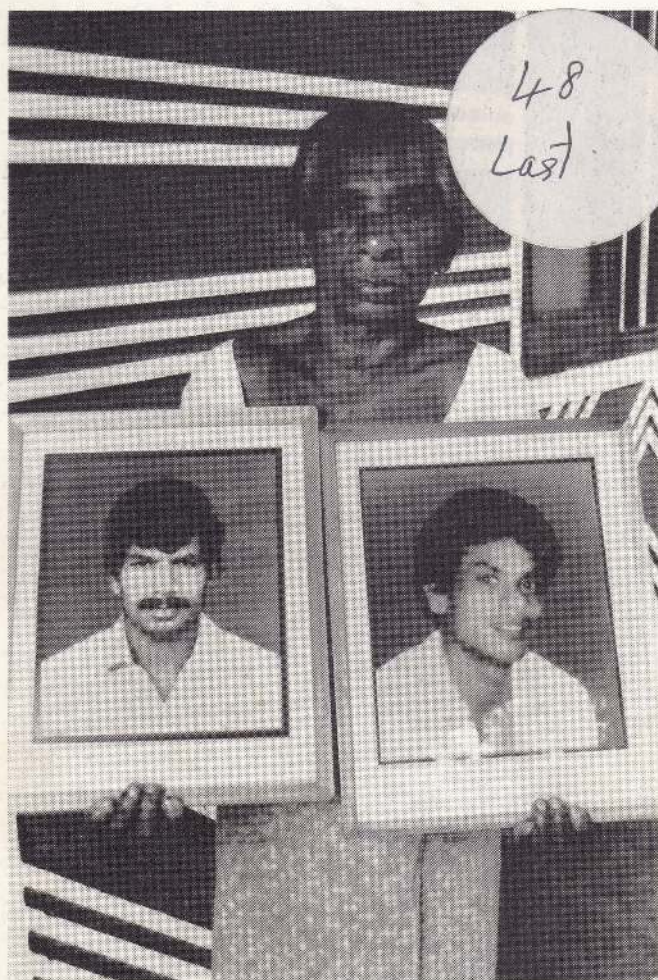

INTRODUCTION

In general news reports in the western media about Sri Lanka have almost exclusively focused on armed clashes between the Tamil militants and the Sri Lankan security forces or the Indian Peace Keeping Force (IPKF) in predominantly Tamil areas, ie in the North and East of the Island. There has been little coverage in the world press about the massive crackdown unleashed by the government of Mr Ranasinghe Premadasa in which over 100,000 have been summarily executed and another 60,000 people have "disappeared". It was far more brutal and bloody than Pinochet's campaign of terror in Chile and the number of people killed by the Sri Lankan security forces was much bigger.

Burnt and Dismembered Bodies

Western Correspondents stationed in Sri Lanka were not unaware of what was happening around them, particularly at the height of the repression between September 1989 and March 1990. Few people could have failed to see partly burnt or dismembered dead bodies floating in rivers or piled up on the roadside. In one instance the security forces cut off heads of 25 people and arranged them like flower pots. When a well known British journalist stationed in Colombo was asked why there was little coverage about these activities, his reply was that he had been specifically instructed only to report on the IPKF and incidents in Tamil areas.

Reign of Terror

In Sri Lanka itself people were too frightened to speak out against these arbitrary arrests and extra-judicial killings. Lawyers who dared to intervene on behalf of parents whose children had been abducted by government death squads were themselves shot. Over 25 Lawyers were killed during this period; others fearing for their lives fled the country. Even a Magistrate who had dared to inquire into summary executions by the police was forced to go into hiding.

The media was largely owned and controlled by the government and only published reports sent by various government agencies. A few

independent journalists who dared to tell the truth were soon silenced. The house of one Newspaper Editor was bombed. Another reputable journalist - Richard de Zoysa was abducted, tortured and killed.

Even parents of young men and women who disappeared did not dare to make a complaint to the police because they knew the police or army would then abduct the other children or relatives of the family and they too would disappear for ever.

Counter Insurgency?

Initially the Sri Lankan government tried to make out that the tens of thousands of people who were killed or disappeared were members of the Janata Vimukthi Peramuna, which had organised the assassination of certain politicians, in the ruling party as well as the opposition, disrupted the economic life and killed members of the police and the army. Even if it was so, no government had the right to arbitrarily arrest and execute people. Every citizen has the right to be properly tried and convicted before any sentence is imposed on him. The reality, however, was that a substantial section of the people who disappeared had little or nothing to do with the JVP or any other organisation which espoused violence. Some were Community activists like M Lionel who worked at the Legal Advice Centre, Katunayeke; some were trade unionists such as Fernando, the Print Worker who was employed at the Government Press; some were hostages taken into custody by the security forces like the three brothers - Neil, Sarathchandrasiri and Kumarasiri Kulatunga - arrested and detained because the army could not find their brother, Buddhika Kulatunga, whom they really wanted. Yet others were innocent bystanders who saw or knew too much about what the security forces had done. According to a very high official of the legal bureaucracy who worked closely with the National Security Bureau (NSB) which supervised this crackdown, the total number of JVP activists did not exceed 2,500. Conversely if the 160,000 or more men and women who disappeared or were killed had been JVP activists the security forces would never have been able to eliminate them so easily.

Gathering Information

A small group of men and women - a few opposition Members of Parliament and Human Rights Activists - in Sri Lanka patiently

collected information about the disappeared. Although these groups have gathered a lot of information it is still not possible to accurately estimate the total number of people who had been killed or disappeared. This is partly because the government is still holding an estimated 10,000 to 15,000 detainees incommunicado and partly because some of the disappeared may be living in hiding.

International Delegation

In May 1990 our organisation - Friends of the Disappeared in Sri Lanka - decided to send a delegation of lawyers and Eruo MP's to investigate the extent of the disappearances. For various reasons it was extremely difficult to assemble such a delegation - there were problems of availability of suitable persons at any given time, problems of co-ordinating with Sri Lankan Human Rights Groups, problems of raising adequate finances, problems of getting the delegation into the country at a time when the Sri Lankan government had publicly attacked the Amnesty International as a terrorist organisation etc. Despite these difficulties, on 27th October 1990, a delegation led by Christine Oddy MEP and comprising of Alex Smith MEP, Bernard De Wit, a renowned Belgian Lawyer and Corjan Schroot, a Dutch Lawyer who specialises in Refugee and Asylum matters, succeeded not only in visiting Sri Lanka and meeting relatives of the disappeared, human rights activists and opposition Members of Parliament but also discussing this issue with the Commander of the Army and the then Minister of Defence, Mr Ranjan Wijeratne.

Wide Publicity

The report that was published by this delegation received very wide publicity and strengthened the hands of all those who were fighting to restore democratic rights in Sri Lanka. Even the Sri Lankan government, stung by its contents and recommendations, promised to appoint a committee to investigate human rights violations. Although President Premadasa ultimately appointed a handful of government officials to look into complaints about human rights violations that may occur in the future (!) there is no doubt that Mr Premadasa has come under increasing pressure from aid donor countries to put an end to these human rights abuses.

Mothers Come Forward

All these developments have encouraged the mothers and relatives of the disappeared to organise themselves in their villages, towns and regions and link up with others nationally and seek justice for the disappeared. Despite slander, intimidation, threats and the murder of some parents of the disappeared, these movements have grown and become more self-confident. Over 10,000 mothers and relatives attended the Mothers Front meeting held in July 1991 at Colombo.

Information

The Sri Lankan government have taken special measures to prevent news about the atrocities it had committed being published abroad. Earlier this year an opposition Member of Parliament - Mr Mahinda Rajapakse - who was on his way to Geneva to attend the meeting of the UN sub-committee on human rights - was detained at the Colombo airport and all the documents in his possession at the time were confiscated. They were mainly copies of affidavits of parents and relatives of the disappeared and they contained detailed information about the people who had disappeared.

Although Mr Rajapakse was prevented from bringing those documents out of Sri Lanka, other persons were able to bring them to Europe. Copies of these affidavits were handed over to the UN Office in Geneva by Christine Oddy and Alex Smith. Although these documents relates to a small fraction of the disappeared - about 1,400 persons - they nevertheless reveal important and interesting facts.

The two research assistants who analysed these documents found that:

- (a) about 70% of the disappeared were from rural areas;
- (b) 25% of the victims were members of the Sri Lanka Freedom Party and about 10% were members of the ruling United National Party; Over 50% of the victims seem to have been apolitical; 15% did not provide any data;
- (c) 95% of the victims were Buddhists;

- (d) 60% were abducted in unmarked vehicles by persons dressed in civil clothes 25% by the army and 15% by the police.
- (e) The dates on which the victims had been arrested/abducted revealed that while most of the arrests/abductions had taken place between September 1989 and March 1990, there had been some arrests before 1988;
- (f) In some cases several members of the family had disappeared;
- (g) 80% were below 30 years and 52% were below 20 years old;
- (h) 55% were the sole bread winners of their family;
- (i) In 35% of the cases the relatives had seen the victim at a police station or an army camp before they disappeared; often the police/army would simply deny that they were ever in their custody.

The work of documentation, however, is far from complete. Even the affidavits do not provide all the information. For instance parents and relatives cannot give any details about the people who carried out the killings or where the dead have been buried. Like in Chile it will take years to compile such information. Nevertheless it is important to support the painstaking work of human rights groups in Sri Lanka who have begun to collect and compile records about these disappearances. Perpetrators of human rights abuses should know that information about their activities are being collected, recorded and preserved. When governments change such people may be called to account for their past actions.

Glimmers of Hope

The task of achieving justice for the disappeared is long and an arduous one. It may take years or even decades. However, already there are small, almost imperceptible, signs of hope. First, is that in the course of their judgment in the case of Wijedasa Liyanaratchi, three High Court judges have said that the Deputy Inspector General of

Police - Mr Udugampola - gave untruthful evidence in court and that he had conspired with another to fabricate false documents. Furthermore they indicate that the man behind this murder is none other than Mr Udugampola. The fact that these three judges had the courage to make these observations is a small sign of hope. In any other country either the Deputy Inspector General would have resigned or the Minister responsible would have relieved him of his duties.

The second, and equally important development, is the decision of certain Members of Parliament to impeach the President and to include violation of human rights - unlawful arrests, torture, killings etc - as one of the grounds of the proposed impeachment. Whatever may be the final outcome of this impeachment motion, it is an important development not least because it is the first time that even Members of Parliament have openly implicated the President in these atrocities.

The Struggle for Human Rights

Although these are unexpected and welcome developments it is important for us not to be complacent about the human rights situation in Sri Lanka. Recent disappearances both in the North/East and South as well as the incidents like the Kokkaddicholai massacre reminds us that the reign of terror is by no means over. For some policeman and soldiers torture and murder of detainees has become something of a routine activity. Moreover they know that whatever they do they will be immune from prosecution. Therefore we must redouble our efforts. Our communications must be streamlined, our support for Sri Lankan human rights groups must be substantially increased, our lobbying must be more effective and above all our determination to restore human rights in Sri Lanka must be even more resolute.

We hope this report will encourage more people to support the efforts of the courageous few men and women in Sri Lanka who continue to fight for human rights - efforts which may lead to their own abduction and disappearance.

Finally we wish to thank all organisations and individuals, who have helped us to publish this report.

REPORT OF INVESTIGATIVE MISSION INTO ALLEGED VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN SRI LANKA - 27 OCTOBER TO 4 NOVEMBER 1990

INTRODUCTION

1. AIM OF MISSION

The mission was organised to compile a report on violation of human rights in Sri Lanka and the disappearance of Sri Lankans.

2. BACKGROUND

Sri Lanka has had direct universal suffrage since 1931. The UNP (United National Party) replaced the SLFP (Sri Lankan Freedom Party) in the 1977 election as the governing party of Sri Lanka. The UNP extended its term of office by referendum in 1982 and cancelled the elections which were due to be held. The 1989 elections were held in an atmosphere of intimidation with the nationalist radical JVP calling for a boycott of the election.

Disappearance and extra-judicial executions have been reported with increasing frequency since mid 1983. In addition, in the late 70s opposition groups engaged in armed struggle to establish a separate Tamil State. From July 1987, armed opposition escalated in the Sinhala majority areas of southern Sri Lanka and were particularly numerous towards the latter half of 1989.

In addition, the Prevention of Terrorism Act and Emergency Powers Regulations give power to police and armed forces to arrest and detain suspects without any democratic accountability.

3. METHODOLOGY

In order to obtain the widest possible view of the current situation in human rights, we met Members of Parliament across the political spectrum, the State Minister of Defence, the Army Commander, and representatives of a number of human rights organisations.

We met about 250 relatives of disappeared people and interviewed about 50 families. We have obtained at least 1500 written documented cases of people who have disappeared. Conclusions and findings in this report are restricted to information which was verifiable by verbal testimony or written report. Names and details of addresses have been omitted to protect the people involved and their relatives.

FINDINGS

Reports were received of people who have been taken and their bodies later discovered, often burned or mutilated. Other people were taken into custody and disappeared after release from custody. In many cases, people have disappeared without trace. Families seeking information about their relatives from the police station receive no information and are still waiting to hear.

Various estimates received suggest that at least 60,000 people disappeared in the south of Sri Lanka since 1987. This represents about one in every 250 of the population. This excludes the north and east of Sri Lanka. During our stay we received reports of continuing disappearances. For example, between 20 and 50 per week in the Kandy area since 1990.

A large number of reports were received alleging direct or indirect involvement of the police and armed forces. Sometimes, it appeared that vigilante forces and police took away relatives at night. Sometimes police in uniform, or police in plain clothes, but known to be police, took away relatives. The Prevention of Terrorism Act and Emergency Powers Regulations appear to be abused.

When we asked the Minister of Defence and the Chief of Army for explanations of the killings and disappearances, the Chief of Army attributed some killings to army deserters and people dismissed from the Army. The Minister of Defence admitted that there had been some excesses in the Jaffna area during the JVP insurrection, but stated that there was a police investigation underway.

We were appalled by accounts of brutality. For example, we received one account of six boys who were publicly shot and beheaded and mutilated by police (some in uniform) in front of a bank for allegedly raiding a bank. Two boys

had been in police custody at the time of the bank raid and it was therefore impossible for them to have taken part in the raid. In another case, a mother reported that her son had been abducted in the early hours of the morning and two days later his head was left outside her home.

In addition, we discovered many groups are restricted in their operations. For example, trade unions may not operate in the free trade zones and are intimidated if taking part in industrial action elsewhere. H M Ranjith disappeared after making a complaint about dangerous machinery. Lawyers are threatened who make habeas corpus applications on behalf of disappeared and some lawyers have actually disappeared themselves. Journalists have to exercise extreme caution and some have disappeared as a result of publicising the human rights situation. The killing of journalist, Richard de Zoysa, and disappearance of Lakshman Perera, UNP municipal councillor for Mount Lavinia, co-authors of a satirical play, are significant because this raised the consciousness of the middle class of Colombo to the gravity of the situation.

CONCLUSION

1. Although the army and authorities deny responsibility for the killings and disappearances, the scale is such that the State cannot be absolved from responsibility. The State has either failed in its duty to maintain law and order or has condoned the activities of the security forces.
2. The Government claims that the JVP problem was resolved in December 1989. It claims that any problems of violence are now restricted to the north and east of Sri Lanka. According to the Government, the situation is normalised in the south, but it is apparent that many killings and disappearances continue.
3. It seems clear to the delegation that many people are affected by a climate of fear and terror in the country. If this continues, it is feared that there will be retaliation and blood baths in the future.
4. Fear of economic collapse has fuelled the intimidation and the continuation of the underlying climate of violence and repression.
5. The growth of human rights groups illustrates an increasing will to find a solution to the problems of the country through peaceful and democratic means.
6. For a lasting solution, mutual trust and harmony among various communities should be promoted. No distinction should be made on the basis of caste,

race, ethnicity, religion, or language. Human, civil and democratic rights of all communities should be guaranteed in actual practice by the state, legal process, and law and order forces in the country.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. According to President Premadasa, the latest foreign aid package to Sri Lanka shows that the government's programmes and policies are endorsed by the whole world. (Reported in the Sri Lanka Daily News on Monday 29 October 1990). Despite the European Council of Ministers' which we welcome, we feel that there must be a real mechanism to identify progress in human rights and law and order before any further aid packages are agreed.
2. We support the visit of the United National sub-committee on Disappearances and Human Rights which was accepted by the Minister of Defence for February 1991.
3. We support an investigation into disappearances by an independent body and would support the resolution of the Sri Lankan Bar Council for an enquiry by an independent Commission.
4. We wish to encourage increased co-operation between the Government and the International Red Cross.

SRI LANKA REPORT UPDATE

Since returning from Sri Lanka in November 1991, Alex Smith and I have constantly lobbied the European Parliament, the European Commission and the European Council of Ministers to condemn the human rights abuses in Sri Lanka and to refuse aid until there is an identifiable improvement in human rights. The European Parliament has unanimously approved the resolution reproduced in this report, our own report was approved by the Parliamentary sub-committee on human rights, the European Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation condemned the expulsion of British High commissioner, Mr David Gladstone. As most aid to Sri Lanka is given by the Japanese government, we have also lobbied the Japanese Government to refuse aid until Human rights abuses cease.

Since our return, the Sri Lanka government has announced that a Commission would be set up to investigate human rights abuse. Although this appeared to be a useful initiative, its effect has been emasculated by restricting its terms of reference. It has only started to operate in 1991 and will not investigate past atrocities. There are many families who are living in constant pain and distress, either because they do not know what has happened to their children, or because they see the perpetrators of murder walking free and unpunished near their homes. We must not forget that for each family it is a tragedy and each and every family deserves an investigation into the circumstances of the death or disappearance of their relative.

Despite all our efforts over the past few months, it is clear that massacres are still occurring in Sri Lanka, that human rights activists are still at risk. Each week we receive reports of wanton deaths and disappearances particularly in the east of the island. Even amnesty international received death threats when they visited the island in June.

It is important that the west continues to help lawyers and human rights workers in Sri Lanka. They are brave people who carry on relentlessly working for people who have suffered, irrespective of any personal danger to themselves. Very often these workers are very short of funds and equipment, but manage to continue in difficult

circumstances. Even by taking an interest in their work, we are helping. We must make every effort to give them as much financial and moral support as we can.

- having regard to the statement of 19 October 1990 by the twelve Member States on Sri Lanka and noting their concern at human rights abuses in Sri Lanka,
 - having regard to the statement of the President of Sri Lanka that the October 1990 aid package was an endorsement of his Government's policies and programme,
 - having regard to the European Parliament's resolution of July 1990 on Sri Lanka,
 - whereas numerous cases of disappearances and extra-judicial executions continue to be reported in Sri Lanka,
 - whereas the violence of the JVP contributed to a climate of brutality and repression,
 - whereas the Sri Lanka Government has acknowledged that the JVP was suppressed by December 1989,
 - whereas renewed conflict by the LTTE in June 1990 has exacerbated problems in the North and East of Sri Lanka,
 - whereas about 1500 documented cases of disappearances and extra-judicial executions were delivered to the United Nations in November 1990 by members of the European Parliament,
 - whereas no lasting solution to the conflict will be found without protection of equal rights for all people in Sri Lanka irrespective of religion, caste, class, race or ethnic background,
1. calls on the Sri Lankan Government to constitute an independent commission of Enquiry into disappearances and extra-judicial executions;
 2. calls on the Sri Lankan Government to publish immediately full and complete lists of those held in detention camps, police stations and other forms of incarceration;
 3. calls on the Sri Lankan Government to uphold its commitment to allow a UN working group to visit Sri Lanka in February 1991 to investigate disappearances;

4. calls upon the Member States to implement adequate mechanisms to indicate progress on human rights and proper law and order before further aid packages are agreed;
5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Foreign Ministers meeting in political co-operation and to the Sri Lankan Government.

PRESIDENT: Question No. 28 by Mrs. Oddy (H-0556/97)

Subject: Sri Lanka - Allegations of election malpractice

Following reports in European newspapers of allegations of election malpractice in the recent local elections in Sri Lanka, what steps does the EPC intend to take to ascertain the truth of these allegations?

WOHLFART: Exercising President of European Political Co-operation (translation). First of all, I would like to draw the attention of Honourable Member to the fact that I am referring to a response to a question given to Mr. Lomas No. 1/91. In effect, the situation in Sri Lanka has led to several diverse declarations and initiatives by the Community and the Member States to the democratic authorities elected in that country, particularly in the realm of the rights of Man. Therefore, they are not unaware of the importance that the Community and the Member States attach to the reinforcement of the democratic institutions in that country, of which the running of free elections constitutes a fundamental element.

The allegations to which the honourable Member refers to have not yet been the subject of discussion by the relevant authorities - that is the European Ministers meeting in Foreign Co-operation. The President wishes to add, at this point, that an international team of observers, composed of representatives from countries with traditional democracies which are very well established has followed closely the local elections in Sri Lanka and they have arrived at the conclusion that generally they were freely and fairly conducted.

ODDY: (S) Since tabling my question the British High Commissioner in Sri Lanka has been declared persona non grata for allegedly interfering in the local election process. As this is a serious diplomatic incident, I would like to know what co-ordinated action the twelve foreign ministers intend to take to show disapproval of this expulsion.

SMITH: (S) In response to what my colleague has said on the unwarranted action by the Sri Lankan Government in declaring the British High Commissioner persona non grata, is the President-in-Office prepared to consider, firstly, an urgent reappraisal of Community aid programmes to Sri Lanka. Secondly, a reduction in trade exchanges with that country and thirdly a curtailment of high level meetings with the Sri Lankan Government?

WOHLFART: Until this evening I felt that all information relative to the electoral process which is of interest to the European Political Co-operation had been considered and that every Member State could raise issues relevant to this process. But having heard the Honourable Member raise the expulsion of the High Commissioner by the Government of Sri Lanka I can assure her that the working group responsible for this matter, namely the "Asia" working group, which will on the 19th of June very shortly.

Given the gravity of the situation, which has just been mentioned by the honourable Member, there is no doubt in my eyes that the problem which has just been mentioned will be on the agenda on that occasion. In any case we will ask for a report from our ambassadors.

It is clear in the second aspect of the other question relating to the consequences of economic aid to Sri Lanka that we must wait for the report and the conclusions of the working group to draw the conclusions and what they show.

POLITICAL CO-OPERATION DECLARATION BY THE TWELVE ON SRI LANKA

Following the questions in the European Parliament by Members, Christine Oddy and Alex Smith on the 12th June, the twelve Foreign Ministers made the following declaration reported on the 24th of June.

"The Community and its Member States deplore the Sri Lankan Government's recent decision to declare the British High Commissioner to be persona non grata. They wish to underline that his expulsion, which they consider wholly inappropriate will not lead to any reduction in the emphasis which they give to human rights questions in their dealings with the Government of Sri Lanka."

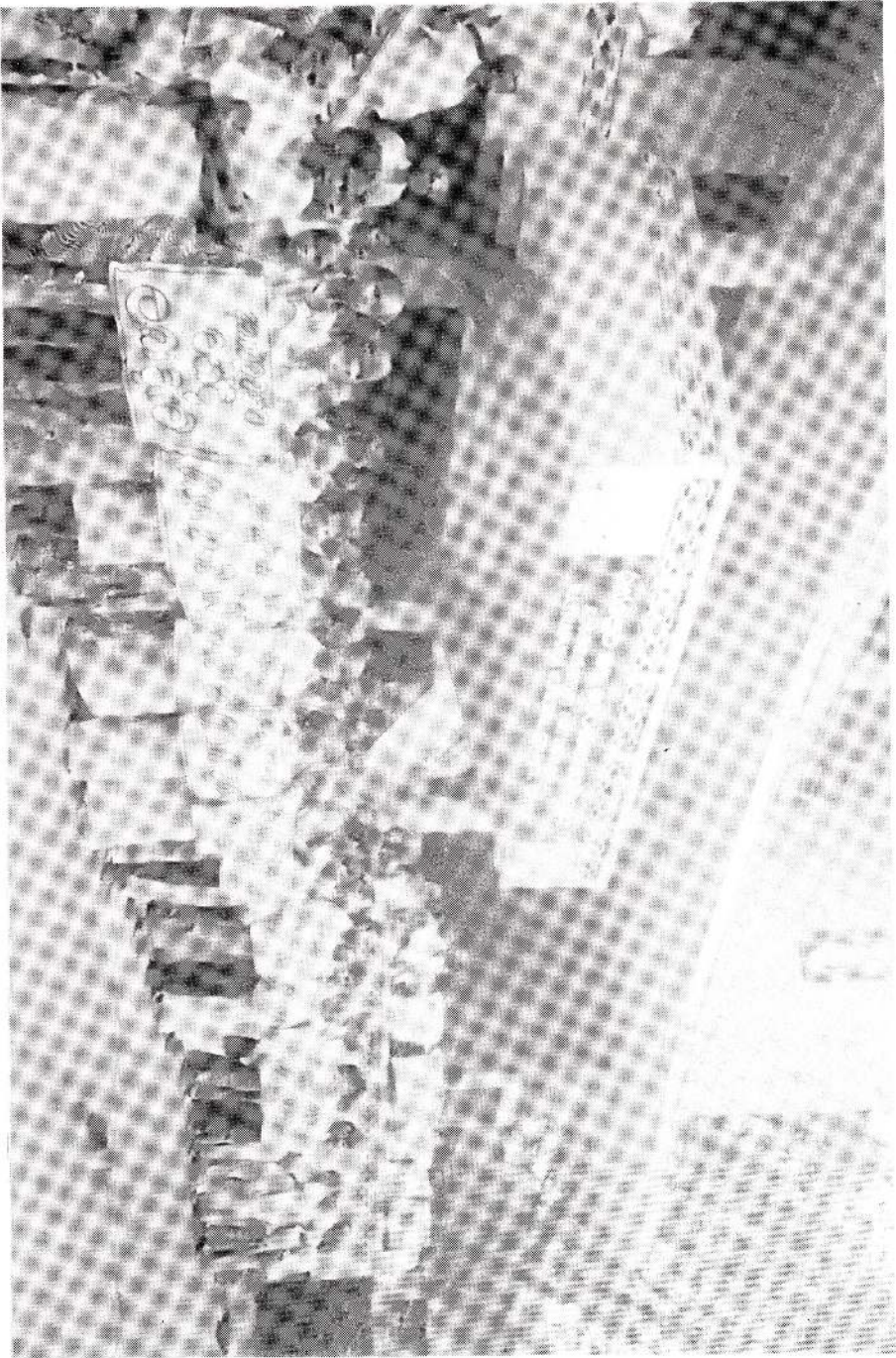

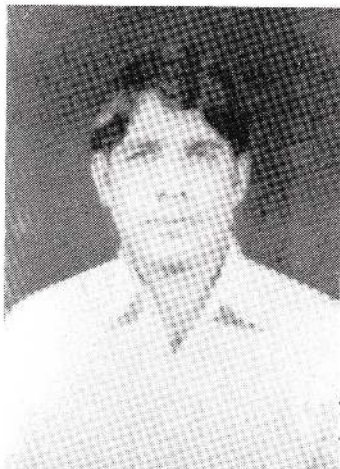

On 4th October 1989 at 4.30pm, a group of persons, who were armed, arrived at the house of Mr Abeyaratne in a white Delica van. These persons were not dressed in uniform. However, they wanted Mr Abeyaratne to accompany them in order to obtain a statement from them. Since that date there is no further information about the whereabouts of Mr Abeyaratne. Several enquiries have been made, both to the Police of Medawachiya and also to the Army Camp at Anuradhapura.

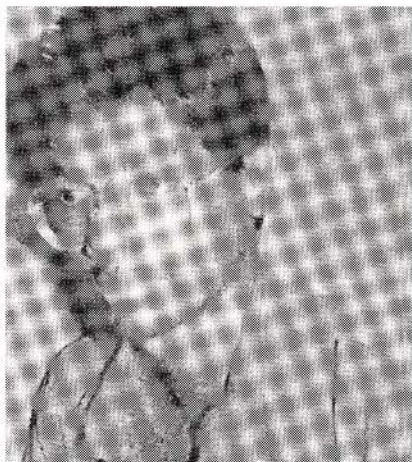
Mr Abeyaratne contested the Provincial Council elections from the Sri

Lanka Peoples Party and he is an active Social Worker. Mr Abeyaratne has three children and his wife Rajani Abeyaratne, had written to the President, the Prime Minister and many other officials of the Government, but so far she has not received a satisfactory reply from any of these persons.

CASE STUDY 2

NAME

CHANDARADASA RANASINGHE



Chandaradasa Ranasinghe disappeared on the 22nd December 1989. On that particular day he left his home in Matara and did not return home. On the same day there was a joint operation by the Army and several youths were rounded up. It is known that Chandaradasa Ranasinghe was an active member of the United Socialist Alliance and he contested the Provincial Council Elections under the U.S.A. banner. At the time of his arrest it was known that he had certain information which he had gathered to be sent to the Amnesty International and the Red Cross Society. He was last heard of on 26th December 1989 and it became known that he was being held in custody at the Matara Police Station. Since then there has been no further information about Mr Ranasinghe. Again, representatives have been made to the Government Authorities and so far they have failed to respond.

CASE STUDY 3

NAME SUDATH DESAPRIYA PATHIRANA

Sudath Desapriya Pathirana was an employee at the Sri Jayawardanepura hospital. On 10th December 1989, at about 12.25pm, a group of armed persons raided his house and abducted him while he was sleeping. Mr Pathirana was the Secretary of the Health Workers Union at this hospital. On that same day, the President of the Health Workers Union, Mr W A Somaweera was also abducted in the same manner. Mr Pathirana was a very popular employee and he was an Active Social Worker. He was also the Vice President of the Colombo District Branch of the National Youth Service Committee. Since his abduction from his home at Serpentine Road, Colombo 8 on the 10th December 1989, no further information has been received about his whereabouts.

CASE STUDY 4

NAME PIYAL LEKAMGE

On 22nd September 1989 a group of Army Officers from the Sinha Regiment came to the house of Mr S.A.R. Perera 28/61, Labowala, Kandy and enquired about a motorcycle that had been parked outside his house. Thereafter, they took into custody his second son, Mr Piyal Lekamge and 4 others who were young men living in the vicinity. Although the other 4 persons were released during the next six weeks Mr Lekamge was held in custody. He was detained at the Mahanuwara Sinha Regiment Headquarters from 22nd September 1989 to 10th October 1989. In fact, Mr Perera and his wife were unable to visit him during this period. Since then, there is no information about his whereabouts. The Police and the Army had refused to give any details. Despite several requests made to the Police Officers and the Army Officers as well as Members of the Government, Mr Perera has not been able to ascertain the whereabouts of his son Mr Lekamge.

CASE STUDY 5

On 7th October 1989, Mr Bandara was taken into custody near Pahalagama Kandurugaldola. He was taken into custody with two others and according to the information received from the people who had been released from various Army Camps, he was taken to Hapugastanne Army Camp. He had been detained at Hapugastanne for 17 days and thereafter he had been transferred to Kuruwita Army Headquarters, from there to Moragahayata Army Camp in November 1989. Thereafter he had been transferred to Embilipitiya on 12th December 1989. So far his wife, Darsini Karawita and her two children have not been permitted to see Mr Bandara. Mr Bandara was a member of the Sri Lanka Freedom Party. Mr Bandara has not been released to date and there is no information about his present whereabouts.

CASE STUDY 6

During the first two months he had been brought to his house three times; thereafter there is little information about his whereabouts. The mother and his sister were dependent on him. Although they visited the Kurnegala Army Camp, they were not allowed to see him. The present whereabouts of Mr Dayananda is not known.

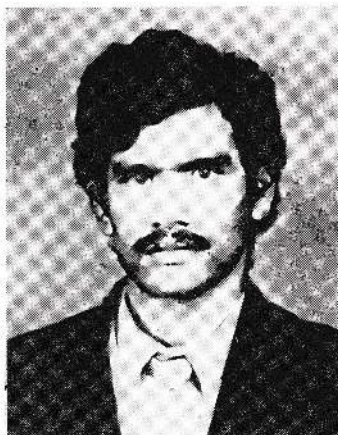

His father has made representations to Members of Parliament, to the Prime Minister, the President and Police Officers but so far he has not received any response from them.

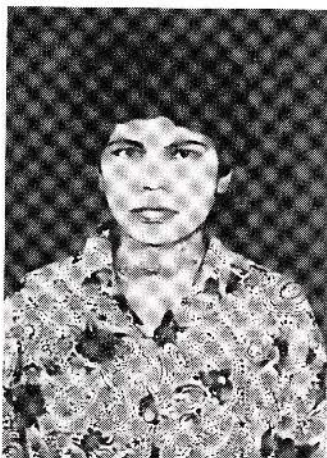

He was taken in a cream coloured Hiace van. His parents had received information that Mr Wijesinghe was taken to Minwangoda Police Station and thereafter to Hunumulla Army Camp. His present whereabouts are not known.

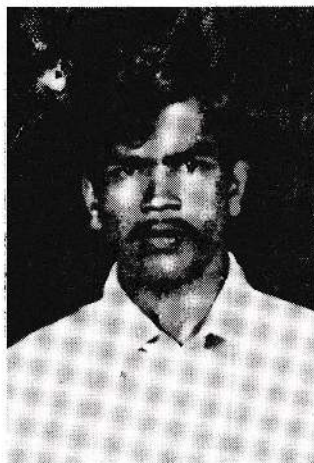

Five other young men had been arrested at about the same time and they were all taken to the Tangalla Army Camp. Two of the men were subsequently released. The others were taken to Ranna Army Camp but when enquired about their whereabouts, the officers of the Ranna Army Camp said they had not arrested Mr Cyril and they did not know his whereabouts. Mr Cyril was the only bread winner of the family and at the present moment his wife and three children have no way of earning a living.

CASE STUDY 13

During the first two weeks, he was seen by his parents, sisters and brothers. Thereafter, he was taken to the Army Camp at the Sugar Mill in Kanthale. When enquiries were made about him at this Army Camp, his parents were informed that Mr Kias was never sent there. Since that day there has not been any information about the whereabouts of Mr Dias.

CASE STUDY 15

THIS CASE INVOLVES FOUR BROTHERS FROM THE SAME FAMILY

BUDDHIKA R.H. KULATUNGA - TEACHER

KUMARASIRI KULATUNGA - FARMER

SARATHCHANDRASIRI KULATUNGA - DRIVER

NEIL RANJAN KULATUNGA - DRIVER

Originally it was Buddhika who was arrested. He was arrested on 5th May 1989 by the Army and held at the Sevana Camp at New Town, Emgilipitiya. Apparently he was arrested in order to ascertain the whereabouts of two of his pupils from the Emgilipitiya School where he was a teacher. He was held in custody for one month. He was badly tortured whilst in custody. But he was released from custody on 5th June 1989. During the time he was in custody, Buddhika learnt that the normal procedure adopted by the Army was to release persons who have been detained by them into the custody of their parents, and then, either on the same day or a few days later to abduct these ex-detainees and kill them. Such abductions were carried out by Army Officers who were dressed in civilian clothing. Since he was aware of this practice, Buddhika did not go home after he was released; instead he went to Colombo, stayed with a friend and then contacted certain non-governmental organisations who helped him to come to Britain. Meanwhile the Security Forces were looking for him. They searched his house and his parents could not give the Army Officers any information about Buddhika's whereabouts. Therefore they first arrested his brother Neil, on 17th December 1989 and from all reports he too was tortured in order to ascertain the whereabouts of Buddhika. When they failed, they arrested another brother, Sarathchandrasiri on the 19th December 1989 and thereafter the third brother, Kumarasiri on 22nd December 1989.

Neil is 27 years old, Kumarasiri is 32 years old and Sarathchandrasiri is 29 years old. To this day neither Kumarasiri, Sarathchandrasiri nor Neil have been released. Several attempts have been made to ascertain their whereabouts. Despite the efforts of National and International Human Rights Organisations, it has not been possible to

ascertain the present whereabouts of Buddhika's three brothers. None of them were involved in any political activity nor did they know the whereabouts of Buddhika, at the time they were arrested.

CASE STUDY 16

K.A.D. SUDATH PRASANNA AND R.A. PREMASIRI RUPASINGHE

Sudath was an employee at Ansler Limited and he worked as an unskilled labourer. On the 1st September 1989 at 11.30pm a group of Army Officers who were armed entered the house of Prasanna's father, Mr Marshall, and arrested Prasanna and his brother-in-law Premasiri.

At 10 o'clock the following morning, Prasanna's mother went to the Kandana Police Station and made a complaint about this arrest. They also wrote to their Member of Parliament and to the District Minister. They made enquiries from the Red Cross and from various Army Camps where detainees are being held. Despite this, they have not been able to ascertain the present whereabouts of either Prasanna or his brother-in-law Premasiri Rupasinghe.

Neither Prasanna or Premasiri were involved in any political activity. At the present moment Premasiri's wife has no income because she was dependent on Premasiri. Prasanna's father and mother, who are quite old, were supported by Prasanna.

CASE STUDY 17

NAME

W.G. SHANTHA

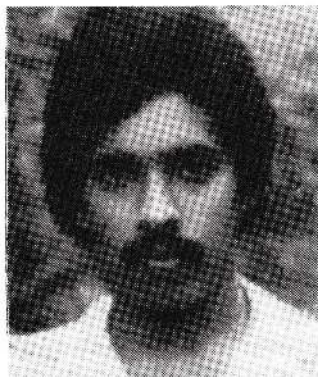
Shantha was a worker at the Free Trade Zone, Katunayake. He went back to his village Thihagoda because he was unwell. He was at his father's house on 13th December 1989 when a group of Army Officers entered his house and arrested Slantha.

At the time Shantha was arrested, he was with two other friends, Ratnasiri and Shelton. They arrested all three but subsequently Shelton and Ratnasiri were released. All efforts to ascertain the whereabouts of Slantha have been fruitless. His parents have visited various Camps, made complaints at Police Stations, sought the help of the International Red Cross, but despite all these efforts so far, it has not been possible to ascertain what happened to Shantha.

CASE STUDY 18

NAME

MADURAPPULIGE LIONEL AND
H.M. RANJITH



At about 7.45pm on 27th October 1989 M.Lionel and H.M. Ranjith were abducted by the police in a white Hiace van. They were on their way home after attending an inquiry at Floral Green Ltd, a company which operates in the Free Trade Zone [FTZ], Katunayeke, Sri Lanka.

Ranjith was an employee of Floral Green. A few months before their disappearance two women workers at Floral Green were badly injured by defective machines. On that occasion Ranjith complained about unsafe working conditions and the foreman assaulted him. When he reported this matter to Floral Green management, both Ranjith and the foreman were suspended although a few days later the foreman was reinstated.

Ranjith then approached the Legal Advice Centre, Katunayeke and Lionel took up his case. Quite unexpectedly Floral Green agreed to hold an inquiry into Ranjith's case and asked him to come to the Factory at 2pm on 27th October 1989. Since Ranjith was permitted to bring in an observer, Lionel went along with him. However, the inquiry did not commence at the appointed time. It was delayed by more than two hours. According to the Inquiring Officer even after

the proceedings began, the Personnel Manager was deliberately delaying it by constantly going out of the inquiry. Furthermore on several occasions the Inquiry Officer had heard the Personnel Manager telephoning a police officer. After the inquiry was concluded she had telephoned the police again and informed them and that they "could now do the needful".

A few minutes later, after Lionel and Ranjith had left the FTZ, a group of policeman abducted them. They have not been seen since. There were reports of two dead bodies being burnt by the police on 28th morning, not far from the place where they were last seen; but it had not been possible to determine whether they were the bodies of Ranjith and Lionel.

About two weeks before their disappearance the assistant superintendent of police at Katunayeke had threatened Lionel about his activities at the Legal Advice Centre. Large numbers of FTZ workers who had been fired by their employers had managed to win compensation from their employers with the help of the Legal Advice Centre. Although no trade unions are allowed to operate in the FTZ, the Legal Advice Centre provided was providing most of the services a trade union should perform. the FTZ employers and the government did not welcome the activities of the Legal Advice Centre.

The police have intimidated and harassed all those who have tried to ascertain the whereabouts of Lionel and Ranjith. On one occasion two persons who visited Lionel's wife to give her some money were arrested and detained. They were only released after their case was taken up by Diplomats, Lawyers, Members of Parliament etc.

Lionel's two children - aged 2 and 8 - and his wife are now destitute because Lionel was the sole breadwinner of the family.

CASE STUDY 19

NAME RICHARD DE ZOYSA

PROFESSION JOURNALIST, CORRESPONDENT OF
INTERNATIONAL, PRESS SERVICE AND ACTOR

DATE OF ABDUCTION 18 FEBRUARY 1990

On 18 February 1990 at about 3.30 pm six armed men, two of whom were in police uniform, came to Mr De Zoysa's house and abducted him despite protestations by him and his mother, Dr Manorani Savaranamuttu. Subsequently, Mrs Savaranamuttu identified one of the abductors as Gunasinghe, a Senior Superintendent of police.

Immediately after his abduction, Richard's relatives contacted police and the Ministry of Defence. They were initially told that Richard was in police custody and that he would be released soon. Later they denied that the police had ever arrested or abducted Richard. At that time the person in charge of the National Security Bureau, which was responsible for overseeing all security operations, was General Sepala Atygalle, who is now the Sri Lankan High Commissioner in London.

On 19 February 1990 Richard de Zoysa's naked body was found off the Moratuwa beach. He had been shot at close range. The discovery of his body caused considerable embarrassment to the government. Conflicting reports were leaked to the press in order to blacken Richard's character. At the same time the government obstructed the investigations into his murder. Richard's relatives and friends including his mother and her lawyer received numerous death threats. The Attorney General refused to prosecute the Police Officer who had been identified by his mother as one of the abductors.

This was not surprising because Senior Superintendent Gunasinghe was being groomed by the government to become the Inspector General of Police. He is said to be a close confidant of the President, Mr Premadasa.

It is also obvious that Richard was murdered because he had produced a satirical play about President Premadasa and in particular abuse of power and violation of human rights by the state. It is common

knowledge that Mr Premadasa is extremely intolerant and is ruthless in dealing with his critics.

Richard's murder established beyond all doubts that the disappearances and extra-judicial killings were carried out not by lawless soldiers and policeman but by people at the very top of the state hierarchy.

CASE STUDY 20

NAME	WIJEDASA LIYANARATCHI
PROFESSION	ATTORNEY AT LAW
DATE OF ARREST	25 AUGUST 1991
ARRESTED BY	POLICE OFFICERS

Mr Wijeydasa Liyanaratchi was a lawyer who had initiated legal action by [filling several hundred Habeas Corpus applications] in the Sri Lankan High Court on behalf of parents who were trying to ascertain the whereabouts of their sons or daughters arrested by the security forces.

On 25th August 1988 at about 4 pm Mr Liyanaaratchi was abducted by three policeman - Senior Superintendent of Police Dharmadasa, Sub-Inspector of Police Mendis and Police Constable Dissanayeke. Mr Liyanaratchi was walking towards the High Court in Colombo when he was stopped, bundled into a car and then taken away to Tangalle. Mr Liyanaratchi was in Dharmadasa's custody from 25th August until 6 pm of 1st September 1988. Thereafter he was taken to the "anti-subversive unit" of the Police at Sapugaskanda.

On 2nd September 1988, at 11.20 p.m, Mr Liyanaaratchi was admitted to the General Hospital in Colombo by Police Inspector Wickremasinghe of the Sapugaskande Police station. According to the Medical Officer who examined him at the time Mr Liyanaaratchi was admitted to Hospital, his condition was so serious and critical, that he could not answer questions put to him by the doctor. The doctors then transferred him to the intensive care unit, but at 12.55 am on the following day Mr Liyanaaratchi died.

Injuries

Due to popular outcry that followed Mr Liyanaratchi's death three policeman who abducted him were charged with murder. At their trial the Judicial Medical Officer, Dr L L B de Alwis who conducted the post-mortem on Liyanaratchi's body gave evidence and stated, inter alia, that:

- (a) the injuries which caused Liyanaratchi's death had been inflicted 3 to 8 days before his death;
- (b) out of an aggregate of 24 ribs 19 ribs of the deceased were fractured;
- (c) there had been patchy areas of haemorrhage in the heart with inflammatory cells;
- (d) there were injuries to the lungs;
- (e) acute tubular necrosis of the kidneys.

In short the police had brutally and repeatedly beaten Mr Liyanaratchi to death.

Deputy Inspector General Udugampola is a liar and a cheat!

Although many aspects of the trial of the three policeman for the murder of Liyanaratchi are very unsatisfactory and the final verdict and sentence was little more than a farce, nevertheless during the course of their trial it became clear that these three men had in fact acted under the orders of DIG Udugampola. The court found that the arrest and detention of Liyanaratchi was illegal, that it had been done on the orders of Udugampola, that Udugampola was an untruthful witness and that he had fabricated documents after the murder of Liyanaratchi to save his skin. In fact the Court having examined the evidence and the role of Udugampola expressed the hope that the Attorney General, Law Enforcement Agencies and the Executive investigate into the issue as to "who caused his death".

Verdict

In the middle of the trial the court permitted the defence to amend the charges by adding two further charges - unlawful arrest and unlawful detention. Not unexpectedly the three policemen pleaded guilty to the murder charges. the court accepted these pleas and convicted the three policeman of the lesser charges. they were subsequently fined Rs 55,000, 17,500 and 7,500 respectively.

There was no justification for accepting guilty pleas to lesser charges and acquitting these three torturers of the murder charges. Once it was established that Liyanaratchi was arrested and detained by these men and the fatal injuries were caused while he was in their custody, they should be held responsible not only for wrongful arrest and unlawful detention but also for what transpired whilst he was in their custody.

RECENT DISAPPEARANCES IN THE SOUTH

The abductions and summary executions by the security forces and government death squads continue. Now the large scale abductions and summary executions are taking place in the Tamil areas of the North and East. However even in the South the disappearances still take place although on a smaller scale than 1989 and 1990. Members of the ruling United National Party quite openly threaten their political opponents that they would be abducted and killed. People are still too scared to publicise information about disappearances; they believe that if they do so they may never be able to procure the release of their loved ones. The following cases had been publicised by the Parents and relatives of the disappeared.

9 April 1991

On 9th April 1991, M.A. Kapurubanda of Kinawa, Millewa, Nikaweratiya and W. M. Nihal Wickremanayeke of Kinawa, Karuwalagaha had been abducted at night by a group of persons who wore Police Uniforms. A tractor belonging to M. Gunaratne Banda was also removed by these men. When the relatives of the abducted men went to make a complaint to the Kotawahawehera police station, the police refused to record their complaint. The Gunaratna Banda's tractor was seen near the police station.

13 May 1991

On 13th May 1991 an armed group had abducted A.N. Jayaratna, a teacher, from his home at 49, Magolla, Mawathagama.

5 June 1991

At 5.45am on 5 June 1991 a group of persons in civilian clothes had abducted R.M. Abeyratne Gunaratne of Madatugama, Kekirawa from his home.

13 June 1991

On 13 June 1991 E.G. Siripala of Molkawa, Badureliya had died whilst

he was being taken to the Pimbura hospital by the police. This man had been taken into custody by the police a few days prior to his death. The Superintendent of Police for Kalutara has admitted that Siripala had died as a result of internal injuries.

8 July 1991

On the 8th July 1991 dead bodies of two young men were found at the public cemetery in Dansalwatte, Mallehewa, Mirigama. Their hands had been tied and shot. The previous night people in the neighbourhood had heard the arrival of a number of vehicles to the cemetery. Shortly after that they had heard gun shots.

On 8th July 1991 an armed group had abducted Anura Vidana Pathirana of Mahena, Maharukgoda, Beliatta. Pathirana was a first year student at the Agricultural Training School at Mapalana, Kamburupitiya.

4 August 1991

On 4 August 1991 R.S. Jayaweera and M. Bandara of Labunoruwa, Kekirawa were taken into custody by Kekirawa police. They were in police custody until 5th August. However on the 6th their relatives were informed that their dead bodies were in the mortuary of the Kekirawa Hospital.

KOKKADDICHOLAI MASSACRE

On 12th of June, two Sri Lankan soldiers were killed and another two were injured in an LTTE landmine attack in Kokkaddicholai, Batticaloa district. In an unnerving replay of "Mai Lai", the Sri Lankan army went on a murderous spree in Mahiladitheevu, and Muthalaikudah villages in Mannmunai A.G.A. Division. Several innocent people including women and children were shot dead and hundreds of houses were set on fire. Some reports spoke of women being raped by the soldiers.
