



I am proud that Union College has always been supportive of TSSA, some of our members have served in the Executive Committees and are still actively involved with TSSA. 1992 யூன் மாதம் 26ம் திகதி யாழ்ப்பாண மாவட்டத்தைச் சேர்ந்த எட்டுப் பாடசாலைகளைச் சேர்ந்த பன்னிரண்டு விளையாட்டில் அக்கறை கொண்டவர்கள் லண்டன் - விம்பிள்டனில் கூடி யாழ்ப்பாணப் பாடசாலைகள் விளையாட்டுச் சங்கத்தை (JSSA-UK),உருவாக்கினார்கள்.

இவர்கள் தமது கிரிக்கெட் விளையாட்டுப் போட்டியை ஆகஸ்ட் மாத வங்கிவிடுமுறை தினமான திங்கட் கிழமை நடாத்த ஒழுங்குகள் செய்தார்கள். யாழ் மாவட்டத்தின் பன்னிரண்டு பாடசாலைக-

ளின் பழைய மாணவர்கள் பங்குபற்றிய இந்த கிரிக்கெட் போட்டி இந்த மண்ணில் வாழுகின்ற தமிழர்கள் மத்தியில் ஒரு புதிய உற்சாகத்தை உருவாக்கியது. தொடர்ந்த ஆண்டுகளில் உதைபந்தாட்டம், பெண்களுக்காக வலைப்பந்தாட்ம் என மேலதிக போட்டிகளும் நிகழ்ச்சிகளும் உள்வாங்கப்பட்டு சங்கம் சீரான பாதையில் செல்லத் தொடங்கியது. காலத்தின் தேவைகருதி சங்கத்தின் பெயர் தமிழ்ப் பாடசாலைகள் விளையாட்டுச் சங்கம் என் மாற்றப்பட்டது. சங்கத்திற்கு 1993ம் ஆண்டில் ஒரு யாப்பு உருவாக்கப்பட்டு, பழைய மாணவர் சங்கங்களிடம் கையளிக்கப்பட்டு ஜனநாயக முறைப்படி செயற்பட்டு வருகின்றது.

கடந்த இருபந்தைந்து ஆண்டுகளாக நல்லமுறையில் இயங்கிவரும் தமிழ்ப் பாடசாலைகள் விளையாட்டுச் சங்கம், விளையாடில் அக்கறை கொண்டதான ஒரு நிலையைத் தமிழர் சமூகத்திடம் உருவாக்க முயன்று ஓரளவு வெற்றி கண்டுள்ளது.

யாழ்ப்பாண மாவட்டத்தில் மாணவர்களின் விளையாட்டின் தரத்தை தரமிக்கதாக மாற்ற சங்கம் கடந்த பதிணைந்து ஆண்டுகளாக முயற்சித்து வருகின்றது. பல ஆண்டுகளாகச் செயற்படாமல் இருந்த யாழ்ப்பாணப் பாடசாலைகள் விளையாட்டுச் சங்கத்தை (JSSA - SL), அந்த மாவட்டத்தைச் சேர்ந்த அதிபர்களை ஒன்றுகூட்டி மீள உருவாக்கியது. வருடாந்தம் உதைபந்தாட்டப் போட்டிகளையும் பயிற்ச்சிகளையும் நடாத்த ஒழுங்குகள் செய்யப்பட்டு, நடாத்தப்பட்டு வருகின்றது.







TSSA(UK) CRICKET TOURNAMENT - 2016 - Over- 40





THE RULES OF THE 7 A SIDE CRICKET TOURNAMENT

The success of the tournament depends on fair play, sportsmanship, co-operation and keeping with the spirit of the tournament. T.S.S.A (U.K) Organising Committee requests all OSAs/TSAs to respect and abide by the rules of the tournament. All teams are expected to report to the tournament committee (at the ground) on the day of the event not later than 8.30 am.

1. Eligibility

- **1.1 UNDER 19:** Players selected for the teams must have been born On or after 1st September 1996.
- **1.2 UNDER 17:** Players selected for the teams must have been born On or after 1st September 1998.
- **1.3 UNDER 15:** Players selected for the teams must have been born on or after 1st September 2000.
- **1.4 UNDER 13:** Players selected for the teams must have been born on or after 1st September 2002.
- 1.5 UNDER 11: Players selected for the teams must have been born on or after 1st September 2004.
- 1.6 Over 40: Players selected for the teams must have been born on or before 1st September 1976.

Identification and Proof-of-Age:

On request of the tournament committee all T.S.S.A (UK) Challenge Cup participants must be able to identify themselves by the following:-

- 1) Age Declaration form or
- 2) Current Passport or
- 3) Valid drivers licence (applicable to Over-40s)

N.B: Citizen card will not be accepted.

2. Team

- 2.1 Each team shall comprise 7 players to be drawn from the list of up to 10 registered.
- 2.2 Substitution shall not be normally allowed during a match except in the event of serious injury (and subject to approval of the cricket sub committee.)
- 2.3 No person may play for more than one team.





3. Match:

- 3.1 First Round: Each team plays the others in its group.
- 3.3 One innings per team, each innings to be of FIVE (six balls) overs duration with one over per player.
- 3.4 Used balls shall be used throughout the tournament.
- 3.5 Each bowler's run-up shall be limited to ten yards.
- 3.6 Negative or short-pitched bowling shall be no-balled.
- 3.7 The ball shall reach the batsman within striking distance and below shoulder height - otherwise it shall be a wide. Umpires will strictly apply the laws relating to wide balls.
- 3.8 No Ball & Wide Ball:- There will be no extra ball given except in the last over of each innings, instead FIVE runs will be awarded to the batting side in addition to whatever runs have been scored for that ball. The FIVE runs penalty for a No Ball/Wide Ball will not apply in the final over of the match. In the final over , the normal 'Wide/ No Ball' rules shall apply.
- 3.9 At least two fielders shall be placed on either side of the batsman, i.e at least two fielders on the off-side and two fielders on the leg side.
- 3.10 The wicket keeper shall wear pads and gloves as normal and he shall not be allowed to bowl. if for any reason, a bowler is incapacitated during an over, a player may be allowed to complete the over provided the player who is replacing him has not already bowled and be aware that this player will not be allowed to bowl another FULL over.
- 3.11 The laws of cricket shall apply outside local rules defined by the T.S.S.A. (UK) cricket festival organisers.

4. Tie match:

- 4.1 In the event of a tie (i.e. each team has the same number of runs after the allotted number of overs), the following rules shall apply;
- 4.2 The side that has lost the least number of wickets shall win.
- 4.3 If each team has lost the same number of wickets as well, then the winner shall be the side that has scored the highest number of runs off the bat. i.e, total runs less total extras scored.

5. Tie Group:

In the event of teams in a group having equal points, the following rules shall apply;

- 5.1 The total number of runs scored by each team will be divided by the total number of wickets they lost. The team with the highest average will be deemed to be the winner of that group.
- 5.2 In the event of this average being tied as well, the rules for tied matches, in rule





- 4 shall apply.
- 5.3 If still equal, two wicket keepers shall bowl one over, overarm, at an unguarded, wicket, then "SUDDEN DEATH".

6. Winner.

6.1 The winner of each match shall be awarded TWO points.

7. Best Loser (If applicable):

- 7.1. The best loser will be judged on faster scoring rate, ie. the team having the best batting average (number of runs scored divided by the number of overs used.)
- 7.2 In the event of a tie rule 4 shall apply.

8. General:

- 8.1 The cricket sub-committee will be the sole adjudicators of the timing of matches and of penalties imposed. The captains of each team should liaise with the cricket sub-committee to confirm start times of their matches. There will be no alteration to these start times or to the order in which matches are played under any circumstances.
- 8.2 In the event of rain interrupting the tournament, the matches shall be played on a reduced overs basis, as necessary with the agreement of all of the teams. The final decision shall rest with the cricket Sub Committee.
- 8.3 If the games are abandoned completely due to rain or for any other reason, there shall be no awarding of the T.S.S.A (UK) Challenge Cup.
- 8.4 The Organisers reserve the right to transfer or schedule games to another pitch from those allocated originally, if required.

9. ARBITRATION:

On the field of play the UMPIRES ' decisions shall be final: in the event of any dispute, or clarification of the rules of the tournament, the decision of the organisers shall be final.
