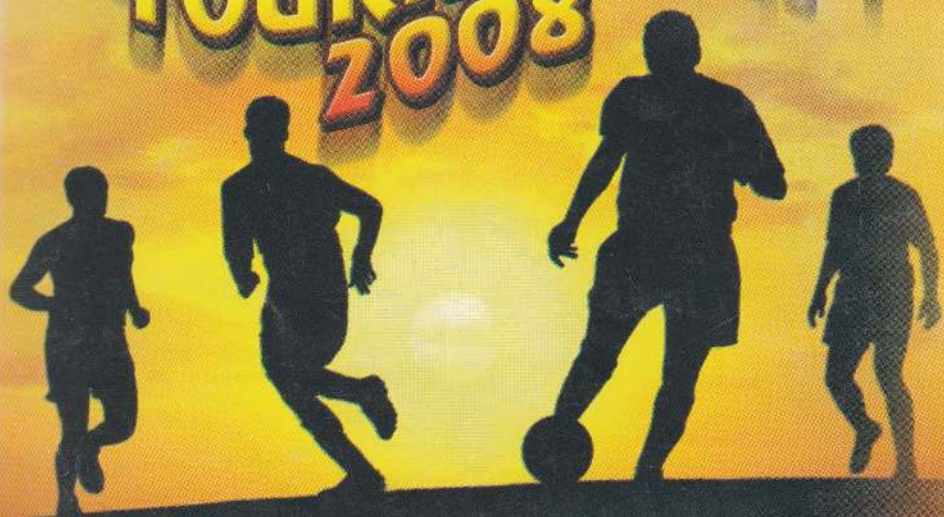

In the 1940s the schools in Jaffna realised the need for a sports organisation to encourage inter-school sports activities in that region. The then Principal of Union College took up the challenge and the Jaffna Schools Sports Association (JSSA) was born. From then on until about 1990 when it became defunct due to the civil unrest, schools in Jaffna actively participated in JSSA organised sports activities - Football, Cricket, Netball and Athletics.

So after almost half a century since the birth of JSSA in Jaffna, 12 Students from eight UK OSAs met in London in June 1992 and created an overseas branch of JSSA (UK), thereby providing a forum for Tamils to come together in Sports. After many successful sporting events, there was a need to incorporate the aspirations of the sports loving Tamil population in the United Kingdom. Consequently, the JSSA was enlarged to incorporate all schools from the NorthEast and hence the conversion to the Tamil Schools Sports Association (TSSA) in 1998.

Over the years, TSSA has enlarged its membership and holds two major sports function every year, the Football Tournament on the first bank holiday Monday in May and a Summer Sports Festival on the bank holiday in August.

TSSA (UK) has, in it's agenda the aim of improving sporting facilities in the Tamil Schools in the NorthEast of our homeland. To facilitate this agenda, TSSA(UK) returns a share of the proceeds from their events back to participating OSAs to utilise it to improve the sports facilities in their respective Alma Mater. In it's short history, TSSA(UK) has successfully resurrected the defunct JSSA in 2003. They sponsored a football coach to travel from the UK to the NorthEast. However the biggest project TSSA(UK) embarked on is the Sports Academy for NorthEast(SANE) which will provide a sports complex with the ideal environment for children to be trained from a young age and represent the Tamils at international sports competitions. After some initial work, the project had to be halted due to the current unrest in the region. However TSSA (UK) would love to share the fun and enjoyment of its sporting function in the United Kingdom with the people of NorthEast and sincerely hopes this will be soon.

TSSA(UK) TOURNAMENT RULES

The success of all TSSA(UK) events depends on fair play, sportsmanship, co-operation and keeping with the spirit of the tournament. TSSA(UK) Organising Committee requests all OSAs to respect and abide by the rules of the tournament.

The following is applicable to all our events.

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Players selected for the school team should have attended their respective schools, or are children / Grand Children of former students as declared by the OSAs.
- 1.2 A player shall not represent more than one OSA/Tamil school in an event.
- 1.3 The table below shall be used for calculating the qualifying age for each category.

- 1.4 For the purpose of age declaration, each member of the team to which age declaration applies, must complete the Age Declaration Form supplied by TSSA (UK). The completed Age Declaration form must be certified by the Head of his or her main stream school. The completed and certified Age Declaration Form must be sent to the TSSA (UK) two weeks prior to the tournament. If these requirements are not met, the current valid passport showing the photograph and date of birth shall be accepted as proof of age. Valid driver's license or current passport shall be used for age verification for the Over 40 teams.
- 1.5 Each team should take a team photograph prior to the starting time of the match as announced by the official.
- 1.6 Event Organisers reserve the right to suspend a player/manager/team for inappropriate behaviour during, before or after the match either at the pitch or at the venue and shall if necessary impose a further period of suspension from participation at TSSA(UK) events.

2. Team

- 2.1 Each OSA/SA should submit a list of ELEVEN players for their team to any of the TSSA Sub-committee members at least 15 minutes before the starting time of the match.
- 2.2 No player may play for more than one team except for Under 12, Under 14, Under 16, for which Rule 2.3 below shall apply.
- 2.3 Under 14 or Under 16 or Adult teams may draft up to Three additional Substitutes from their Under 12, Under 14, Under 16 teams respectively, with the following restrictions:
 - i) Such substitutions must not interfere with the tournament schedule.
 - ii) Under no circumstances may Under 12 team players play for Under 16 team or Adult team and Under 14 team players play for Adult team

3. Substitution:

- 3.1 Only players whose names appear on the Official Team Sheet and in the team photo shall be allowed to play for that team.
- 3.2 Teams wishing to substitute a player shall:
 - a) Bring to the attention of the TSSA Sub-committee member who is in charge of the ground, where the match is being played, that they wish to substitute a player.
 - b) Supply the TSSA Sub-committee member the shirt number/name of the player to be substituted.
 - c) The TSSA Sub -committee member shall then draw the attention of the match referee/umpire of the intended substitution.
 - d) A substitute player shall enter the field of play only on indication by the referee/umpire.
 - e) Any player entering the field of play without the indication of the match referee shall be appropriately penalised by the referee.
 - f) The player who has been substituted (player who comes out) during a game shall not be allowed to play in that game again.

4. General

- 4.1 The Sub-committee shall be the sole adjudicators of the timing of matches and of penalties imposed. The captains of each team should liaise with the Sub-committee to confirm start times of their matches.
- 4.2 If the competition is abandoned completely due to adverse conditions or for any other reason, there shall be no awarding of the TSSA (UK) Challenge Cup and there shall be no refund of any payments made to the TSSA (UK).
- 4.3 The Event Organisers shall reserve the right, if necessary, to transfer or schedule games to another pitch from those allocated originally.

5 Complaint Procedure

- 5.1 Any team that wishes to make a complaint relating to a player's eligibility for participation should submit their complaint in writing through their captain and manager in the appropriate form before the 'final whistle' marking the end of that particular event.
- 5.2 Where a complaint relating to a player's eligibility for participation is made after the match and within 7 days after the result has been announced and the organising committee is satisfied that the said complaint is justified, the organising committee shall have the right to forfeit the award and prohibit participation of the particular team up to a maximum of two following years.
- 5.3 It is the responsibility of the complainant to produce evidence in support of any complaint. The decision of the organising committee relating to any complaint shall be final.
- 5.4 Any participating team that wilfully refuses to participate in an event after a decision given by the organising committee following a complaint may be prohibited from participating in that event and up to a maximum of two following years.

6. ARBITRATION:

On the field of play the REFREES'/UMPIRES' decisions shall be final: In the event of any dispute, or clarification of the rules of the tournament, the decision of the Event Organisers shall be final.

THE RULES OF THE 7-A-SIDE FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT 2008

1. Match

- 1.1 If any team in a group of **TWO** fails to turn up, Team from the nearest group of **THREE** will be substituted for them
- 1.2 A preliminary round will be played on a All-Play-All basis. (Teams in each group play each other in that group.)
- 1.3 Duration of the match is as follows:

Preliminary rounds: **10 - 3 - 10 minutes**

Quarter Finals **10 - 3 - 10 minutes**

Semi Finals **10 - 3 - 10 minutes**

(For tie matches, Rule 3 below shall apply.)

Final: **15 - 5 - 15 minutes**

(For tie matches, Rule 3 below shall apply.)

- 1.4 The game will be played under normal FA law except that ;

a) There will be **no offside** rule.

- b) Maximum of three substitutes will be allowed for each match.
- c) If a player is sent off from the field by the referee he cannot be replaced for the match and he cannot take part in the next match.

1.5 Points will be awarded as follows: **WIN 3 points, DRAW 1.**

1.6 If a team fails to turn up at the appointed playing pitch and time a "WIN" will be awarded to the opposing team present at the pitch. For the purpose of goal average the winning team will be awarded three goals.

2 Tie Group

2.1 In the event of teams having equal points, the following criteria will be applied to declare the winner.

Goal average (i.e. - number of goals by the team less number of goals against the team).

If not resolved

Highest number of goals scored in the group.

If not resolved

Less Goals Scored against.

If not resolved

"Sudden death" penalty kicks.

If not resolved

"Toss of a coin"

3.0 Tie Match (Semi-Finals & Final)

3.1 In the event of a tie at full time in the Semi-Finals and Final the following criteria will be applied to declare the winner

FIVE minutes each way of Extra time will be played.

If not resolved

The best of Three penalties will be used.

If not resolved

"Sudden death" penalty kicks.

If not resolved

"Toss of a coin"

Our Founder Member Late Mr V R Rajasingam



On 1 January 2008, we in the TSSA(UK) along with many others were shocked by the untimely demise of one of our Founder members Mr V R Rajasingam at the young age of 58 years. We now like to share our thoughts about him with you!

Mr Rajasingam hailed from Manipay and was an old student of Jaffna Central College (JCC). He was extremely proud of his roots back home, so much so, that he was popularly known amongst friends and relatives as 'Manipay'. A keen sportsman in his school days - he was an outstanding athlete, a footballer and an excellent cricketer. In fact, he captained the JCC cricket team in 1970 when they won the big match against St Johns College, Jaffna by an innings, a record which is yet to be broken. He simply loved and excelled in sports.

He was a true and loyal Centralite. His passion in maintaining the name of JCC continued even after he came to the UK. He and a few others were instrumental in inaugurating the Jaffna Central College Old Boys Association (JCCOBA) in the UK twenty years ago and he was the President of the Association in 2004.

Late Mr Rajasingam's interest in sports did not stop with JCC and JCCOBA. He was passionate about providing opportunities for the Tamils in this country to develop their sporting skills. Therefore, it was no wonder he was one of the twelve people who founded the JSSA (UK) in 1992 which is now known as TSSA(UK), their main objective was to provide a forum for all Tamil schools to play inter-collegiate cricket. He served in the Executive Committee for a number of years until his health made him slow down. Even then, he would not miss any of our events.

The beauty of 'Manipay' was his ability to embrace everyone with his cheeky but welcoming smile even after a debate or argument. He would always fight for what he believed was right and spoke his mind without losing his respect for himself or others. He valued other people's opinion. He would never bear any grudges against anyone. He had a big and forgiving heart and he loved being with people.

Late Mr Rajasingam will be missed by many but TSSA (UK) will always remember and miss him at their events. Today, we remember Mr Rajasingam with sadness but as one of ours. TSSA(UK) is proud to have had him amongst us.

May his soul rest in perfect peace!

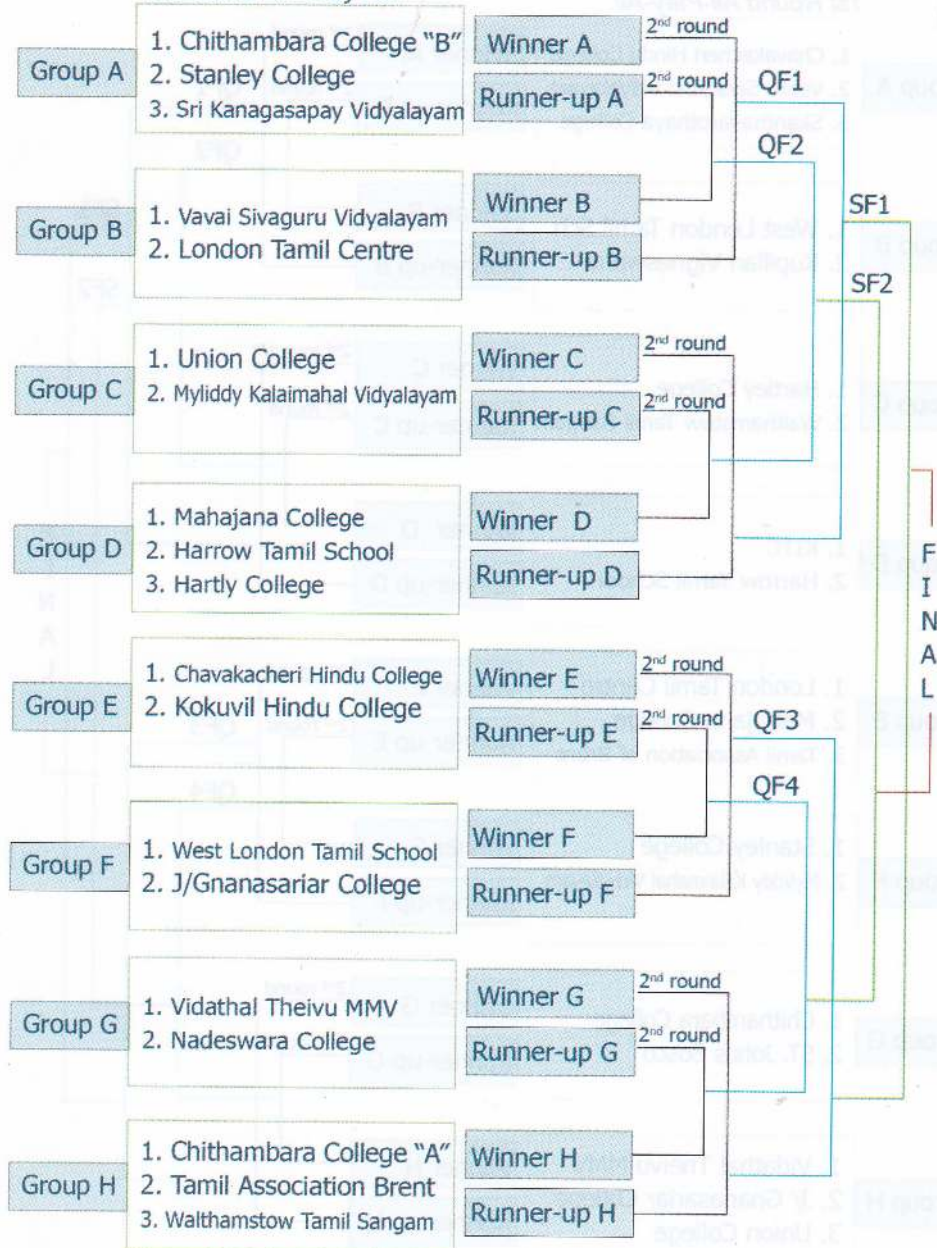
