

Archaeological interest has been aroused by the recent discovery near about the Swami Rock in Trincomalee of three statues of Lord Shiva and Parvati Ammar. made of the finest bronze ever found. The exami-The examination of the three statues by experts leads to the inference that the images must have been the handi-work of a thousand years ago.
