come to recognise that freedom is an essential condition of development. This freedom of thought it denies to no one.

### Humane world order

Now it wishes to go a step further. Not only by example but by precept and gentle persuasion, it would help the world to overcome its limitation of outlook and hardness of heart, which thinks of other faiths as alien, and looks upon their members with distrust and suspicion. In point of fact each religion contains in itself a part of the great universal truth and is, therefore, supplementary to the others, rather than contradictory to them. How foolish are they who wish to limit the Infinite Being within the range of the finite, and who would kill the higher creative energy of the mind by standardizing the very soul of man. It is in the clash of thoughts that thoughts awaken and truth at best takes its colouring from the heart and understanding of the individual man. Many allowances must be made for differences in birth, education, and surroundings, and besides which we must remember that an embodied soul brings with it into the world the stamp of its own infinite past. If religious give up their arrogance, they will become seekers of Truth rather than preachers of it, and their followers also, united by this bond, would look upon themselves as belonging to the common family of devotees of the world. And if a more humane world order is to arise it must measure the future progress of humanity in terms of co-operation rather than competition or destruction and of assimilation of fresh ideals rather than exclusion and intolerance amongst the faiths and peoples of the world.
