Principal's Report

The President, All Chief Priests, The Chief Guest, his better half Principals of neighbouring schools, Old boys of the College who have affection, the parents who are the pillars of the college, beloved students who are going to receive awards.

I have pleasure in expressing my thanks to all of you on this sacred day.

This College Celebrates its 188th birthday today. This college has faced many hard - ships within this long period. There are no educationists who are unaware of the prestige this oldest mother who is placed in the second in Sri Lanka.

She was injured, bedridden and torn into pieces because of the cruelty of the civil war that took place three times.

Because of the duty - minded untiring efforts of some principals who looked after her, she has survived.

I was instructed to look after this mother on 4th of November 1996. As an adopted son, It gave me mental agony when I saw the pathetic and disfigured condition of her.

I determined to change the sorrow into power. Yes, I firmly determined to bring back her position as it was for 180 years.

The Halls without roofs, broken walls that are pierced by gun bullets, Classrooms without furniture, library without books, laboratories with no equipments and the playground that was seen with trenches and ditches.

I remember with gratitude the noble people who toiled hard to change the dilapidated buildings into beautiful ones that you see now.

The parents, old boys with good attitude and teachers who worked hard along with me are the root cause for this development.

The students who are produced by this college are wide - spread and living in all parts of the world.

Our Chief Guest Mr. Suzendzan is one of those. Who is this suzendzan? He is a young noble man created by this college.

Our chief guest Mr. A.R. Suzendran is an old boy of Jaffna Central College. He was a student from 1963 to 1974. During this time he excelled in studies and extra curricular activities winning many prizes on number of occasions. In addition to winning subject prizes and class prizes for academic excellence he also won prizes for English oratory, General knowledge and General Proficiencies. He had the distinction of winning the 1st prizes for General knowledge at all annual prize giving from 1967 to 1973. He was a College prefect and the President of the Advanced level Students Union (1973). He was also the House Captain of Percival House (1972) and the President of Hindu Students Union (1972). He represented college at many inter colleges debates and oratorical contests held both at the District and the Provincial levels and won the 1st Prize for English oratory in the Northern Province.

He was called to the Bar in 1979 and has been in active practice at the Colombo Bar for the past twenty five years. In 1988 he obtained a Masters Degree (LLM) (Hons) in International and Comparative Law from the University of Brussels, Belgium, securing distinctions in international Economic Development Law, International Trade Law and International Taxation. The thesis submitted by him on the subject "The GATT Rules and their application by international and national adjudicatory organs" was given the rating "A" and was recommended for publication by the faculty of law of the University of Business. He has also carried out research work at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies of the University of London and the Bod Leaz library, University of Oxford.

He has an extensive civil practice mainly in the areas of Commercial law, Banking Law, Administrative Law and Property Law appearing in the original and appellate courts. He has appeared as counsel in a number of leading cases. He has also worked with eminent legal luminaries of the past such as Mr. S. Nadesan, Q.C. and Mr. C. Renganathan, Q.C. in the landmark Saturday review case in which he appeared with late Mr. S. Nadesan, Q.C. the Supreme Court for the first time recognized the right of the readers and subscribers of a Newspaper to challenge the ban placed on a Newspaper, on the basis that the freedom of publication includes the readers "right to receive information". Many cases successfully argued by Mr. Suzendran in the Supreme Court and the Court of Appeal have established important principles of law. In 1998 he had the privilege of

appearing as Counsel before the ICC international Court of Arbitration where eminent Judges drawn from U.S.A, U.K. and Italy served as arbitrators.

In 1990 he was appointed to the Board of Examiners to the Incorporated Council of Legal Education in which capacity he functioned till 1995 as an examiner in administrative Law, Law of Property and the Law of Persons for students at Sri Lanka college. Apart from this he has also been a Lecturer in Commercial Law for the Post Graduate Diploma Course in Business and Financial Administration conducted by the University of Wageningen Holland at the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka.

Recently he was appointed as Presidence Counsel by her Excellency the President on the recommendations of an independent Committee.

Mr. Suzendran is an active member of social and religious organizations. He is a Senior Vice President and the Chairman of committees of the Colombo Vivekananda Society and a Trustee of the Sri Anubindho Centre, Sri Lanka. He has also been closely associated with the Colombo Ramakrishna Mission and the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation in 1997 he delivered the Annual Sir P. Ramanathan memorial oration. In 2002 he delivered Swami Vivekananda Commemoration talk at Ramakrishna Mission, Colombo.

He is the eldest son of Mr. A. Ratnavadivel and Mrs. Ratnes Ratnavadivel of Nallur Jaffna.

Mr. Suzendran who is present here to award the prizes Mrs. Renukadevi Suzendran is a past pupil of St. Bridget's Convent, Colombo - 07 where she was the Secretary of Tamil Literary Association. She holds a Diploma in Montessori Training awarded by the Association Montessori Internationale, U.S.A. Apart from being the Directress of Mitra Montessori House of Children for the past twenty three years she has also contributed many articles so reputed journals on Education and Child Psychology. She has also been invited by the Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation and the Sri Lanka Rupavahini Corporation to give talks on Education and child Psychology. Having successfully passed the Carnatic Music and Veena Examinations conducted by the North Ceylon Music Society upto the fifth grade, She shows a keen interest in Music.
