Many of his students who are employed in Malaya and Ceylon are conversant with Siththan tham, Mr. Jambulingam of Madras supported him. The teaching and testing of religious knowledge today on the basis of Siththantha even to the higher classes is chiefly due to the work Sivapathasundram. His student P. Kailasapathy is considered to be the best among Siththantha thinkers in Ceylon.
