THE SERVICES OF CEYLON TAMIL SCHOLARS

Towards the Propagation of the Saiva Siddhanta Philosophy

The true services of Navalar created a generation of great scholars in Siddhanta. The success of his mission attained its climax during the period of செந்திரசுந்தரர் Senthinatha Iyer. So far no research work or any thesis had been written on such scholars who rendered service to Siddhanta. In his introductory notes on Sivagana Siddhiyar S. Sivagurunathapillai of South India focuses light on the services of Navalar to Saiva Siddhanta. He adds further that the persons who inspired him with sowing the perennial seeds of Saivism are Sabapathy Navalar and C. W. Thamoderampillai who were born in Ceylon and did service in Tamil Nad. Other noteworthy scholars of Ceylon are Saravanamuttu Pulavar of Nallur, Karthigesu Iyer, Sambantha Pulavar and Sanhara Pandit of Neerveli who wrote the book சைவபிரகாசனம் Saiva-pragasanam in Tamil prose.

The period of Senthinatha Iyer 1879-1924

Kasivasi Senthinatha Iyer delivered many lectures in Colombo in 1880 and in India after 1882.

On the request of Somasundara Nayakkar a guru of மஹாநாயக்கர் Maraimalai Adigal Iyer delivered lectures in Madras in 1898. In 1904 he established the Buddhavada Saiva Vidyasalai at Thirupparankuram. "Vaitheeka Sudda Athuvada Saiva Siddhanta Padam" was published in 1904. He established a press in 1906 and translated "Neelakanda Padi-

yam" into Tamil. The following books were written and published by him - Saiva Siddhanta Thathva Pada Vinavidai, Sivagana Bhoda Vachanankara Deepam Thevaram Veda Charam, Kanthapurana Navaneetham. Today his works are not available, even in Public Libraries. Saiva Siddhanta Mahasarakam Kathiravetpillai, Swaminatha Pandithar, Sabapathy Navalar, Mudaliyar Sabaratnam, Vaitthilingapillai, Nadaraja Iyer, Vetpillai, Judge Kathiravetpillai Thiruvilangar, Siddhanta Carthigesu, Muttukumaraswamy Kurukkal, Mappana Mudaliyar, Kanthapillai, Perampala Pulavar, Ambalavana Navalar, Saravanamuttu, Sivapragasa Pandithar, Erambaiyar are note worthy Saiva Siddhantists. Many other names are not given to avoid elaboration. The following Siddhanta leaders of Ceylon presided at the Conference of Saiva Siddhanta Maha Samajam in India: Sir Pon Ramanathan (1906), Sir A. Kanagasabai (1909), T. Ponnampalappillai (1912), Ambalavana Navalar (1915), Mudaliyar Sabaratnam, (1916), Swaminatha Pandithar (1918), Sir Pon Ramanathan (1921),

Swaminatha Pandithar (1922), Sir Pon Ramanathan (1925). Sir Pon Arunasalam's translation of Sivagana Podam is worth mentioning. Sir Pon Ramanathan delivered lectures on Saiva Siddhanta Philosophy in the United States and his talks were collected in a book form entitled "The culture of the soul among the western nations."

Late t Period

After 1924 the Hindu public did not show so much of enthusiasm as shown earlier. The causes for this slackness are many. The struggle for political independence in India and Ceylon and the urge to strengthen national co-operation without religious leanings are some. After 1925 the number of Ceylonese who went to India for the purpose of Saiva Lectures and publications of books decreased. During this period the knowledge of Tamil Language and Literature was excluded from the knowledge of Saiva Siddhantam.

The Services of leading Societies

The Saiva Paripalana Sabha, Jaffna: This Society was founded in 1888 to carry out the aims and ideals of Arumuga Navalar. It has a long record of achievement. It publishes "The Hindu Organ" in English and "Inthusathanam" in Tamil and has brought out a number of Saiva Siddhanta Works. It conducts the Saiva Pulavar and Sithanthan Panditha Examinations. It can also claim the distinction of having enabled the Tamils in Ceylon listen to the teachings of great Sithanthan

Motor Transport in Malaysia

General Transport Company (FMS) Limited was inaugurated then by purchasing the operation rights of some individual bus operators from Kuala Lumpur to Sentul, and Kuala Lumpur to Brickfields and Bungsar by paying goodwill. One Mr. Sangarapillay, owner of the defunct K. L. Motor Exchange, a second-hand car dealer then, was the major operator in the Sentul area, whose rights were also bought over by the General Transport Company for a meagre sum of \$ 10,000/-. Mr. Mailvaganam could remember that at the start of the business he was given a cheque for a sum of \$ 100,000/- by Messrs. Wearne Brothers Limited in 1936 to credit the capital account of the General Transport Company (FMS) Limited with the Kuala Lumpur Chartered Bank. At the initial stage, General Transport Company (FMS) Limited employed about a hundred workers and multiplied its capital nearly twenty times, and employed about a thousand men and women when the business was taken over by the present Sri Jaya Transport Company (PIM)

Limited with a bus fleet of about 160 and 50 Yellow Tops. At present, Sri Jaya Transport Company (PIM) Limited is considered to be the largest omnibus and taxi operating Company in Malaysia with a floating capital of about \$ 4,000,000/- employing 1200 workers.

The Sri Jaya Transport Company (PIM) Limited has now at its helm a General Manager, Enche Mohamed Yunus in Abu Hanifah, who is an Economics Honours graduate and an Associate Member of the Institute of Transport, England, with varied experience in the field of transport.

Mr. Mailvaganam, after serving for 41 years in various positions in bus transport, as Chief Clerk in 1935, Accountant and Chief Cashier in 1942, Company's Secretary in 1957, retires now as Office Manager. Notwithstanding his exacting official duties Mr. Mailvaganam found time to devote to the betterment of his community and to the social and economic welfare of the State.

The writer is well aware of the tremendous amount of work Mr. Mailvaganam had put in, in the early days as a committee member and Honorary Literary Secretary of the Selangor Ceylon Tamils Association, Kuala Lumpur and recently as a committee member and Business Manager of the Malayan Ceylonese Congress periodical "Berita Ceylonese". As a member of the Civil Defence Corps and other cultural organizations he devoted much time and labour. Unlike most men in public life, he is refreshingly unpretentious about his own endowments. An attractive quality in him is his cheerful spirit, which seems to derive its inspiration from the motto "Work is Worship".

BEYOND BOTH
CONTROL AND
CORRECTION?

Time and again we have in our columns drawn the attention of the Authorities to the immediate need for drastic changes in the administrative setup and the operative arrangements of the Ceylon Transport Board. The vigilance of the public in this context may not be enthusiastic; but the Authorities cannot plead, insufficiency of agitation from the public for the failure on their part to have made any significant approach to the question of rearranging the C. T. B. Omnibus Service.

The incidents of the past few months in which the C. T. B. organisation has been involved and the general deterioration in the capacity and content of the Omnibus Service throughout the Island must certainly call for the attention of even the most absent-minded Administration.

The question that is being repeated by the public is whether travel by Motor Bus is advisable. The answer to this self-explanatory poser must be provided by the Minister in charge of Transport. We need not reiterate the numerous defects that are so very glaring as to be commonly commented upon by the travelling public in a contemptuous manner. The vehicles that were purchased at a very prohibitive price have been allowed to be dilapidated

conducting Saiva Pulavar Examination. The following Ceylonese presided at the Conference of this Samajam after 1925:—Swamy Vipulananda (1935) Siddhantha Vithagar V. Nagalingampillai (1953) Sir Kanthaiah Vaithianathan (1954) Dr. Nadesapillai (1955 & 56). There are many more Societies engaged in the study of Siththantha philosophy. Lack of space prevents my mentioning all of them. However their work deserves further study.

The Revival of interest in Siththantha with the advent of Sivapathasundaram (1875 - 1953):—

After 1924 the number of students of Siddhantha who were well versed in Tamil and Sanskrit began to decline very much. However a Siddhantha leadership evolved among those who followed English as the chief language. One of those was Sivapathasundaram Pillai. Many of his students who are employed in Malaya and Ceylon are conversant with Siththantha. Mr. Jambulingam of Madras supported him. The teaching and testing of religious knowledge today on the basis of Siththantha even to the higher classes is chiefly due to the work of Sivapathasundaram. His student P. Kailasapathy is considered to be the best among Siththantha thinkers in Ceylon. 'A Science Graduate' has proved the agreement of ideas of the Sanskrit Upanishada Agamas and Tamil Siththantha Sastras and written some books in English. He is A. Visvanathan of Neeravadi, Jaffna. Navaly Somasundara Pulavar wrote a play 'Uyirilankumaran' based on Siththantha philosophy. Muttukumar Thambiran spent his life for Saiva Siththantha in India. Mr. S. Rajaratnam established 150 Saiva Schools. Yoga Swamigal founded Sivathondan Nilayams.
