If the Gandhian thought shows up a halo of spirituality around it, Communism has at its back the support of a scientific terminology. Having proved its worth by securing Swarai for us, Gandhism Swaraj for us, Gandhism may no longer be dubbed visionary and impracti-cable. And Communism, too, has for the moment proved its virility by re-juvenating the hoary old China. This tempts some workers to seek a reconciliation of the two systems, and has led to the enunication of formula like, "Gandhism is Com-munism minus violence." The fact of the matter is is that these two ideologies are irreconcilable; the differences between them are fundamental
