





Always to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state and my community,


and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act and deed, To give them freely of my time labor and means.


FOUNDER LION MELVIN JONES

- Some Important Events

1879 (13]an)		Birth of Melvin Jones in fort Thomas Arizona Father John Calvin Jones (A Captain in the Army) and mother Lydia nee Gibbler.
1904		Followed a course in business administration at hte Union Business College and Law at Chaddock College Quincy.
1905	:	Joined the Insurance Firm of Johnson &. Higgins as a trainee Insurance Brokers.
1909	:	Married Rosa Amanda freeman - A leading Goiter during this period.
1912	:	Introduction to the Business circle of Chicago and soon becomes an active and highly involved member.
1913	•	Started his own business Circle.
1915	:	Elected Secretary of Business C ircle.
1916	9	Conceived the idea of forming a service club organisation and invited the members of business circle to promote his idea. Thus the spirit of Lionism was born
1917 (7 June)		Meeting conducted in the East Room of Chicago's Hotel La Salle which was attended by 20 delegates representing 27 Business Club from various parts of U.S. A. Thus was planted the sailing of the World's largest and active service organization.
1918 (8 Oct)	:	He first Annual Covention of the Association of Lions held at the Adophus Hoel Dallas, Texas.
1918	:	The first issue of Lions magazine released. Melvin Jones becomes the first Editor of the Lions Magazine.



1920	: Melvin Jones withdraws his involvement from his company to make his services available to the Lions International at all times.
1920	: Melvin Jones visitedCanada to Inaugurate the first Lions Club in Canada Winsor Ontario Lions Club which was inaugurated on the 12th of March 1920.
1939	Cuban Government honoured Melvin Jones tl Merit of Carlos Mqnaql De Cespeds - the higl honour given to a civilian
1950	: International Board Confered upon Melvin Joi of Secretary General of Lions Clubs International for life
1952	Melvin Jones shifted the Lions Headquarters for Insurance Agency Building to No 209, N. MidiAvenue to open a separate Hedquarters for Lions International.
1945	Melvin Jones invited along with past International Presidents David Skeem andd Fred Smith played important role in formulating the non Government ection Charter.
1954 :	Rose Freeman the wife and constant companion Meli Jones passed away after a 45 years parnership
1956 (21 June) :	Melvin Jones married his neighbour Lilian M. Radigan
1961 (1 June)	Death of Melvin atthe age of 82 in floss moor, illinois.
1961 (3 June) :	Melvin Jone's mortal remains interred at Mount Hope Cemetery

I have no doubt all those people living along the coastal belt from Wattala to Mannar who would benefit from this project would be ever so grateful to Lions for this facility which is a luxury those poor cannot afford.

The Lion Ladies played a major role in raising funds for the project though their fund raiser "Rhythms Close to the Heart" sing-along. The Fund raising team also did a fantastic job in making the Maruti Car Raffle a viable project under extremely difficult circumstances.



Regardless of the security situation in the country especially in the North which led to the closure of A9 early in the year, the Clubs continued their service activities. It is heartening to note that the Clubs in the war torn areas were also quite active despite their own situation. With this commitment the District has carried out over 1500 projects at a value of more than sixty million rupees. This is excluding the nine million rupee cardiac unit.

We have also extended six new clubs during this period keeping to the promise we had made to the International President.

Let us complete within the next few weeks, what we have started and leave no loose ends for the next team. Let us support a smooth baton change which would help the district to gather further momentum in the ensuing year under the Leadership of Vice District Governor Lion Raghavan.

Voting delegates, I invite you to use your franchise wisely. Let us please have a clean election. Once the election is over let us leave it behind, continuing the camaraderie and good work, irrespective of whoever wins.


