


## Message from the District Governor 306 B2

#### Brief profile of the

Membership: The year began with a membership of 38. Three members were dropped for non attendance of meetings and projects and three members were added. As at 31.03.2006 the membership stands at 38. There is a strong possibility that before the end of the Fiscal year the club would record a membership of 40.

Meetings: Board and regular meetings are held each month in addition to the three committee and project meetings. All meetings have had a very satisfactory attendance. The majority of our meetings are held at our own club house. The lion ladies who have their own agenda for service activities also have their meetings at the same venue. The club was fully represented at all Zonal and Regional meetings.

Finance: The Finances of the club are very stable. The District and International dues were paid during the stipulated time. The annual fund raiser was combined to the charter celebration which also featured the official visit of the District Governor. With the funds raised along with donations from club members a and friends, the club was able to pay over a million rupees to the Sight First Hospital With a view to grant greater stability to the clubs ongoing projects the club has placed approximately one million rupees in fixed deposits in Banks.

Projects: The club conducts several ongoing projects namely 4 Pre Schools, monthly medical camps, monthly medical camps, Vocational Training Centre. Bursury bright students and the senior partner in the Sight First Hospital. The four schools conducted by the club have over 215 students. They are attended by eight qualified teachers who are paid a monthly salary by the club. All basic requirements of the students are provided by the club.

On every second Saturday in the month the club conducts a medical clinic. A qualified medical officer and several others including lions and lion ladies assist in providing medical aid to the sick. Patients are also tested for diabetes and treated. The allowance to the Dispensor and the cost of medicines and drugs are met by the club.

The Vocational Training Centre conducted in association with the Vocational Training Authority of Sri Lanka was the first centre to be established in Sri Lanka. It caters to the youth of the community who due to financial constraints were unable to continue higher education. They are trained in disciplines geared to provide employment. The disciplines are Computer Programming, Beautly Culture, Spoken undergone training and are gainfully employed. The club has placed over Rs. 800,000/= in fixed deposits the interest generated therefrom defrays cost of maintenance of the building.

The club has provided bursuries to serve bright-students of families of the lower income group to pursue their studies. They range from year 5 to University level. During the past two years the clubs main focus of attention was on the Sight First Hospital. The club is in the forfront in its construction, raising funds and maintenance. All Lions and Lion ladies are actively engaged in its day to day service. Being the first Eye Hospital in Sri Lanka constructed and maintained by a Non Governmental Organization it stands as a bastion of hope and solace to those who live in darkness.
