Rector's Report for 2009

My Lord Bishop the Chairperson, our Distinguished Chief Guest Dr. A. E. A. Joseph and Dr. (Mrs) Theresa Joseph, our Guest of Honour Mr. Alex Lovell, Rev. Fathers, Sisters, Ladies and Gentlemen, and my dear Students!

We extend a warm welcome to all of you to this all-important event, the Annual Prize Giving of the College. Your presence here today is expressive of your unstinted support to us throughout the year. We do appreciate it and wish that it always be forthcoming.

As you preside over this function, we, the Patricians, extend to you a filial welcome to our midst. This is an appropriate occasion to thank you for your patronage and guidance and also to pledge our loyalty to you and to St. Patrick's.

Dr. Anton Emmanuel A. Joseph. Our Distinguished Chief Guest.

We are extremely proud to have you and your gracious wife, Dr. Theresa Joseph, in our midst today and we welcome you both most heartily. As you come back to your Alma Mater as the Chief Guest, nostalgic memories of those happy days you spent within the portals of this College, will overwhelm you with emotion. You take pride in the fact that you entered the medical College because of the excellent education you received at St. Patrick's College, Jaffna. Though you excelled in studies you were an all-rounder being a cricketer and a soccer player in the College team.

The firm foundation laid at St. Patrick's has led you to achieve greater heights in the medical profession you had chosen as your career. Graduating

from the Ceylon Medical College in 1962, you served in Jaffna and were appointed as Lecturer in Forensic Medicine, Biochemistry and Nuclear Medicine at the University of Ceylon. Then you proceeded to obtain your M. Sc. in Radiation Biology (Lond) and FRCR (Lond).

With your academic excellence and professional qualifications you held eminent positions in various Institutions. In the United Kingdom at the Royal College of Radiologists, you were a member of the Training and Accreditation Committee, Lecturer and Chief Examiner. At St George's Hospital Medical School in London you had been a member of the Academic Board and Chairman of the Panel of Medical Student intake. You had been a Consultant Radiologist at St. George's NHS Trust and Southampton General Hospital.

You secured the Clinical Excellence Award, London NHS Innovator Award and London NHS Medical Devices and Equipment Award which are rare NHS awards. Your efforts at research had culminated in the singular invention you had contributed to the medical profession, specifically; it was an instrument having enhanced ultrasound visibility. (Patent no: 6,306,094 dated 23rd Oct 2001.)

You have a very impressive and extensive record of 74 publications which is yet another hallmark of your eminence in your field. They are too numerous to be outlined here but they clearly portray a personality that the Patricians can truly be proud of. You were the first President and Founder member of our SPC Alumni Association UK formed in 1983.

Even though you have risen to such great heights in your medical profession, you never failed to be



proud of your identity as a practising Catholic. You continue to be an active member of St. Elpheges' Church, London and a regular member of the choir.

Let us not forget the woman behind the success you have had in your life. It is with much pleasure we welcome Dr. Theresa Joseph. You too entered the Medical College from Jaffna at the very first attempt and graduated in 1962 with honours. You did Anastasia and were appointed Lecturer at the University of Peradeniya. You chose to be a GP and continue to enjoy general medical practice even after your retirement. Our students are indeed privileged to receive their awards from you.

Mr. Alex Lovell. Our Guest of Honour.

We are indeed proud to felicitate you, another eminent Patrician, as the Guest of Honour today. Your stay at St. Patrick's, has led you to success in another spectrum of professional career. You completed your Post- Graduate Degree in Australia and now you are a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Management Accountants, and An Associate Fellow of the Australian Marketing Institute.

As a Crown in your career, you were awarded the Most Distinguished Order of the British Empire (MBE) by Her Majesty the Queen of England for your contribution to Investment Banking. You were one of the youngest in the history of the Commonwealth to receive the award at the age of 37.

You hold various positions and responsibilities in many professional bodies – to mention a few: you are a Major Share Holder and Deputy Chairman of Union Bank of Sri Lanka, Director of Associated Electrical Corporation of Sri Lanka and Director, and share holder of a number of entities in the Middle East.

We are very grateful for your magnanimous gesture in generously donating a large sum of money for our Computer Lab to enhance the Computer Studies of our Students.

We are aware that you make professional tours around the world and you were gracious enough to find time to be with us at our Prize Day as the Guest of Honour and open the Computer Unit.

We are much pleased to honour you today for your loyalty and commitment towards the needs of your Alma Mater.

Ladies and Gentlemen.

Education is a complex task, which is made more difficult by rapid social, economic and cultural changes. Its specific mission remains the integral formation of the human person; such education requires the contribution of many agents. Parents are the primary and principal educators. Thus states the Sacred Congregation for Catholic Institutions (Circular 520/2009). It further states that Catholic Schools should provide education based on the principles of Catholic faith and imparted by teachers of right doctrine and probity of life. Here, the educational atmosphere must be permeated by the evangelical spirit of freedom and charity which fosters the harmonious development of each one's personality.

Aware of how difficult this is today, especially in a pluralistic society, close collaboration among parents, teachers and school authorities is needed as regards the process of education and the individual formation.

After three decades of war and devastation, the north has become the focus for the state, numerous institutions and business enterprises. In the wake of Development, Rehabilitation and Improvement of



Education, organizations are competing with each other and offering different kinds of promises and hopes for future career, be it for further education or for work. Our children are exposed to a new reality around. They should be able to make the sound judgment and right decision for their future.

I request the parents to be more concerned about the educational and behavioural development of your children. During their time of schooling, their personality goes through a modification and the parents together with the teachers should be constantly vigilant about their life style and guide them. The stress for the children is so severe that if we don't guide them, the changing circumstances around us can overtake them. The child needs to be motivated to go beyond the text book and his subject area to transform himself into a personality that is unique and much sought after. Teachers alone cannot be motivating the children for learning; rather the parents who are the major stakeholders in education should contribute to learning in their own domain of action.

Tutorial Staff

The strength of the staff in 2009 was 73, four with Master's Degree specializing in Education, Science, English Literature, and Tamil; 22 Graduates of whom 14 have obtained Post Graduate Diploma in Education; 23 Trained Teachers, 4 with National Diplomas and 20 with G.C.E. Adv. Level status. Miss Narmatha Rasiah returned after completing special training in Primary Education at Kopay Teachers' Training College.

Mrs. Latha Mahendran, a Physical Science Graduate, left us after serving here for five years. She was an efficient and experienced teacher who comes well prepared to deliver the curriculum and takes keen interest in every student entrusted to her care. We thank her for her valuable service.

Rev. Fr. Mahan Aloysius left us after 2 ½ years to follow higher studies in London and Mr. T. Lintus left after 3 years.

Silver Years in Teaching

Mrs. M.M. John Ariyathas completed 25 years of Service at the College. As an Honours graduate in Christianity, she was a very successful teacher whose efforts brought forth very good results in the G.C.E. Adv. Level Examination year after year. She is a much sought after teacher for Christianity even outside the College. She had been a resource person at a number of Seminars and also serves as a chief in the panel of marking for Christianity in the Adv. Level Examinations. Special felicitations were held for her on the Teachers' Day 2009.

The following teachers joined the tutorial staff: Mr. S. Thilepan for Chemistry and Science, Mr. Kabilaruban for Physics and Mathematics and Miss. R. Andrea for Primary Education. We wish all of them a long and fruitful stay at St. Patrick's. Worthy of mention is that: In the Software Competition among teachers of A/L section, Mr. P.A. A. Benchalaw, our Physics teacher was awarded First place at Provincial Level and a Merit Award at National Level.

Mr. M. Berty Bannister, our Master in charge of Athletics, obtained the Level One Technical Official's Certificate of the International Association of Athletic Federation and qualified as an I.A. A. F. Technical Official.

Wedding bells chimed for Mr. J. Jeyaganesh. We congratulate him and wish him and his spouse all happiness and contentment in their married life.

Special mention must be made of a couple who have come from abroad to help us voluntarily with the teaching of Mathematics, Chemistry and Science in the English medium. Mr. Regis Kanagasundari and



Mrs. Navamalar Kanagasundari, both Science Graduates, after a very high profile of teaching experience and Management service in Nigeria are with us. We consider it a great privilege to have them with us at a time when English as a medium of instruction is gaining ground. We are very grateful to them for their commitment and dedication to serve the children in the homeland.

The Teachers' Guild

We wish to express our sincere thanks to the Teachers' Guild led by its President Mr. P. Jeyakumar, and the Secretary Mr. S. Christyan, for the cooperation they extended to promote the staff welfare and for the smooth running of the College.

The Auxillary Staff

Our Office staff that consists of 10 members deserves our appreciation and thanks for their spirit of willing service. It is due to their conscientious and unsparing work, our entire managerial task is well done and in good time.

On Roll and Admsston

The number of students on roll in January 2009 was 1864 consisting of 455 in the Primary, 417 in the Junior Secondary, 515 in the Senior Secondary and 477 in the Collegiate Section. There were 108 admissions for Grade One, 50 for Grade Six and a few for other classes.

A special feature was the admission of 148 students who had come from the IDP camps in Vavuniya and Cheddikulam in 2009. Among them 45 were accommodated at the College Hostel. The students who had lost their breadwinners numbering 35 are being assisted by our Alumni members for their food, clothing, tuition fees and hostel accommodation.

Catholic Students' Union and Sacred Heart Confraternity

These Associations help to maintain a Catholic atmosphere in and around the College. The staff and students participate in the regular morning Assemblies and prayers under the guidance of the Prefects of Studies of the four sections. The traditional exercises of devotion were observed, such as First Friday Mass, May Devotions, October Devotions, Triduum in preparation for the feast of Sacred Heart and St. Patrick and Lenten Devotions. Whether it is daily assembly or occasional devotions, the students are guided to lead these devotions.

The members of these Associations, mainly students from Grades 9-13, take the leadership to organize the liturgy for all occasions. Mrs. M. M. John Ariyathas the Moderator of Catholic Students' Union and Mr. R Ramanan, the teacher in charge of the Fraternity, enliven the spiritual activities of the students. At the Diocesan Religious Education Examination held in November 2009, three Patricians obtained the highest marks: A. F. Jenefer (Gr.5 - 98 marks), U. Mary Jackson (Gr.6 - 95 marks), A. Antony Nirushan (Gr11- 90 marks).

STUDIES AND EXAMINATION SUCCESS

At the G.C. E.A/L Examinations held in 2009, 125 students sat and 45 passed in the Arts Stream, 25 in Commerce Stream and 12 in Science Stream and thus 82 qualified for admission to the University. We congratulate J. Ladeslous 3A (District Rank 11), M. Asock Cline 3A (District Rank 34), G. Shirly Baptist 2A B, (District Rank 60) in Physical Science; A. S. Prasanth 2A B (District Rank 03), J. P. John Shelton A 2B (District Rank 28), R. Ahalyan 3B (District Rank 29), A. Mariakumar 2A C (District Rank 46) in Bio Science; I. Thanos Emerson 2A B (District Rank 61), J. Jesly A B C (District Rank 79), A.C. Joe Fabian 2A C (District Rank 80), J. Jesuthas A B C in Commerce, A. Roshanthan A 2B, A.



Biemendi Glasan 2A C and R. Donald A 2B in Arts. At the G.C.E. O/L Exams held in December 2009, 150 students sat, 127 passed in six or more subjects and qualified for Advanced Level studies. In the Tamil medium N. Vinthushan obtained 9 A and M. Rajeevan got 8A and B.

In the Bilingual medium, 21 students sat the above exam and all of them got through. Worthy of mention is that S. S. J. Nitharshan and D. Micky Paul obtained 9A while D. Sanjeev got 8A and B.

Our special thanks are due to those teachers who deliver the curriculum in English medium. Their hard work and extra effort has yielded the dividends.

At the Grade 5 Scholarship Examination held in August 2009, 84 students sat and 14 qualified for scholarship. S. Shabeen obtained 163 marks.

Other Competitions

At the Australian National Chemistry Quiz Competition conducted by the Royal Australian Chemical Institute, in the Junior 9 students obtained Distinction and 2 students obtained High Distinction, while in the Senior Division 2 students secured Distinction and 8 students secured High Distinction. Our hearty congratulations go to six students who have won the coveted Gold Medals for Scholastic Excellence.
