Muttucumaran KINGPIN OF SCOUTING

Sithamparanatha Chettiar Muttucumaran, the fourth grandchild of the memorable figure Pasupathi Chettiar whose inspiration and perspiration together with that of Advocate Nagalingam resulted in the establishment of the prestigious seat of learning and Hindu culture, the Jaffna Hindu College the other four being the now departed Pasupathy Chettiar (Registrar), Sivakamasundary (wife of the late V. S. Nadarajah, Proctor), Sivagurunathan (Principal) and Somasundaram (Teacher - JHC) spent almost all his educational career at Jaffna Hindu, first as a student and later continued as a teacher.

Due to his intimacy and love for his Alma Mater he was benevolent enough to donate his entire first two month's salary as a teacher to buy books for the school library.


He never confined himself to classroom teaching alone but spread his wings to cover religious activities, staging dramas and most importantly scouting that was his live wire. He himself was an active scout when scouting was revived after the war and was an understudy to Scouter Jeyaveerasingam in the fifties.

"SCM or MUTTAR" as he was fondly called by his friends was the master mind behind the successful staging of the popular scout drama" IDEALIST in 1950. It was a big draw and helped to swell scout funds.

I could vividly recall two popular scout characters of the drama Naguleswaran (Professor S.Naguleswaran, now in New Zealand) and the late V. E. Pakkianathan (Librarian)

After another period of lull, scouting got activated in 1959 after which it reached greater heights at JHC and continues to be so even now. It was during this period that I got introduced to scouting by our veteran teacher KVM and had the privilege of enjoying scouting with the guidance of the "kingpin of scouting "Muttucumaran. Kingpin because of his innovative ideas and on the spot decisions that helped scouting to flourish at Jaffna Hindu and in Jaffna as a whole.

His imaginations on gadgets and campfire items were given practical shape by our young and daring scouts which helped us to win not only the Rotary shield in



Scouter Muttucumaran (1928 - 1996)



successive years but also to be on top in the Island winning the All Island Merit Flag and the coveted Sir Andrew Caldecott challenge bowl for chip-a-job.

It was during that time we sent our first ever contingent to the World Jamboree (three out of seven from Ceylon) to Idaho in the USA followed by to other regional jamborees later.

The highlight of our time was when the joint JHC - St.John's scouts participated in the Jamboree to mark the Golden Jubilee of Scouting in Ceylon held in early 1962 in the racecourse grounds in Colombo incidentally the Jamboree to mark the centenary of scouting in Ceylon was held in Dambulla in April 2012. I recall with pleasure how scouter Muttucumaran could instantly change a negative situation into a positive and pleasant one.

It was the grand campfire rehearsal night when all our scouts with scouter J.N.Ponniah went for the event while Muttar and I stayed in camp tp prepare dinner for all.

We were steaming PITTU and all of a sudden the whole stuff slipped and fell into the boiling vessel. Both of us were nonplussed as to what to do for dinner.

In a flash decision Muttar put in more flour and sugar and stirred it to make it as a fine porridge. Muttar told the scouts that for all their efforts in the rehearsal there was a special menu for dinner. All of them happily enjoyed the sweet instant porridge. That was Muttar who could instantly transform a negative into a positive one.

It was to his credit that he successfully organised the Bhartha Natya Arangetram of his eldest child Annapoorani (Shantha) in the Jaffna Veerasingam hall in the early seventies and also founded the Meenadchi Nadna Palli, now located to Eastham in London which proudly preserves and imbibes this trditional dance form of great value to scores of children for the last quarter of a century.

The proud father Muttar should be the happiest soul to hear that the Nadana Palli the he planted has now blossomed so strongly and beautifully to the extent of it being graced and admired personally by no less a person than Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the second and also to gain global popularity and recognition at the grand opening of the London Olympics of 2012.



Journey from Childhood to Pioneer & Entrepreneur

y journey, as with many others, was not an easy ride. However, I would like to share my story; it may give you an insight into what is possible if you work hard and plan effectively to achieve your goals. There are elements of luck in all successful enterprises, but as a famous South African golfer, Gary Player, once said, "The harder you work, the luckier you get".

I spent my early days in Chavakachcheri Hindu College, where I learned the fundamental skills for becoming a mature person. However, being teenagers, you know how challenging it is to think for yourself and to focus on your studies when you simply don't realise the need at the time. I wasn't an exceptional student—I was playing lots of cricket and other games in my early days, with no interest in being a successful student—although I was good at Mathematics and Science. Even so, doing well in two subjects did not put me out as the front-runner in my class.

Time passed, and I realised when I was in Grade 8 that 'it is the time to change'. I became a hard-working, determined and conscientious person — which resulted in nine distinctions and one credit in GCE 'O' Level. While studying at school, I was constantly encouraged to join in the sporting activities and competitions that regularly took place. I think that by participating in many activities I became familiar with a competitive environment, which enhanced my ability to communicate and work with others. Through sports, I definitely improved my ability to work productively under pressure.

Milestone 1 : Achieving good results at GCE 'O' Level.

Lesson learned: Unless you have a good foundation at GCE 'O' Level, it would be very challenging (or virtually impossible) to progress further. Hence, in order to lay the foundation, you've got to work hard and commit to your studies.

I was then admitted to Jaffna Hindu College to work for my GCE 'A' Levels. I chose to pursue the Mathematics stream – because Science and Mathematics were my strongest subjects and, moreover, I loved doing those subjects. I have to admit that understanding the basic principles behind these modules was one of the key factors to my success. I was very fortunate to be taught Maths, Physics and Chemistry by

talented teachers and, as a result, I achieved straight As in all three subjects.

Milestone 2: Achieving good results at GCE 'A' Level and understanding the subjects well.

Lesson learned: Picking the right stream is a key – two factors can help you choose the right one: (a) knowing which are your strongest subjects and (b) whether you enjoy doing those subjects. Without a solid foundation at 'A' Level, it would not be possible to achieve real success in a related degree programme at a University, as above all you've got to be extremely keen and committed to the programme.

I then went to read for a BSc (Hons) in Engineering at Moratuwa University in Sri Lanka. However, after a few months I was offered a scholarship to do a BEng (Hons) in Electronic Engineering at the University of Sheffield in the UK. So I decided to move to the UK to pursue that degree in 2004, where I scored the highest marks in my year and was awarded the Sir William Siemens Medal for being one of the country's top 18 science and technology students. It is worth noting that I used to ask pertinent questions in lectures and continued to ask questions until I fully understood the subject-matter.

Milestone 3: Achieving good results in a bachelor's degree and laying a solid foundation for further studies.

Lesson learned: Reading for a degree that suits you best is absolutely crucial to your future success. Three factors can help you choose the right subject: (a) what you are good at, i.e. your strengths, (b) whether you love doing it, and (c) what your real vision/ambition is. Above all, you've got to ask pertinent questions.

Finally, I moved to Corpus Christi College, Cambridge University in 2007, to study for a Masters degree (MPhil) in Electronic Engineering before beginning my PhD in 2008 on the subject of 'Passive RFID real time sensing system for intelligent infrastructure'. I have had my research work published in various journals and currently have two patents pending for my work into RFID (Wireless sensors such as Radio Frequency IDentification tags can be linked up as components of intelligent networks. The sensors can be interrogated via the internet, and their location can be determined from a distance even though they are 'passive', which is to say that they harvest their energy from the radio waves interrogating them and require no internal energy source or maintenance). As a keen cricketer, I have captained the Corpus Christi College Middle Common Room (i.e. graduate students') cricket team and am also an elected president of University of Cambridge Graduate Cricket League and Chairman of Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET) Cambridge Younger Professionals.

It was at Cambridge that I became aware of the possibility of commercialising my ideas and of helping society by continuing with my research.

I am currently a Research Fellow at Girton College in Cambridge University and I continue my research on 'Enabling Low-Cost Error-Free Wide-Area Passive RFID Real-Time Tracking'. The system will enable retailers, airlines and other businesses to monitor the location of items such as shopping trolleys, luggage, and documents) both cheaply and effectively in real time. The system could save airlines millions of pounds. Retail groups have also been engaged in the project—not just for tagging items, but also for the development of self-service checkouts. This work is supported by the Girton College Cambridge University Research Fellowship, the Boeing Company and the UK Engineering and Physical Science Research Council.

I have just been appointed to a Fellowship of the ERA (Electrical Research Association) Foundation and have recently been selected as the winner of The UK ICT (Information and Communications Technology) Pioneers Connected World Award (for the groundbreaking approach to modern problems), as well as the The Royal Academy of Engineering ERA Foundation Entrepreneurs Award 2011. I am a cofounder and director of PervasID Ltd, a Cambridge University spin-out to exploit the invention commercially.

When I drafted this article, with the aim of helping you see how it was possible to set and achieve your goals, I found I had originally put the word 'fortunately' in every paragraph. I then looked back to the start of the article, to Gary Player's words, and I deleted almost every occurrence where I had written 'fortunately' as I strongly agree with Mr Player: The harder you work, the luckier you get. One element of fortune (the only mention of the word I left in the article) concerned my teachers at Jaffna Hindu College: it really was my good fortune that they were so excellent and motivating!

I would like to end this article with another quotation, this time from Steve Jobs, American businessman, designer and inventor of Apple Inc, in the hope that it may help you focus your ideas and achieve success in all aspects of your lives:

"Sometimes life hits you in the head with a brick. Don't lose faith. I'm convinced that the only thing that kept me going was that I loved what I did. You've got to find what you love. And that is as true for your work as it is for your lovers. Your work is going to fill a large part of your life, and the only way to be truly satisfied is to do what you believe is great work. And the only way to do great work is to love what you do. If you haven't found it yet, keep looking. Don't settle. As with all matters of the heart, you'll know when you find it. And, like any great relationship, it just gets better and better as the years roll on. So keep looking until you find it. Don't settle."

I strongly agree with Mr Player: The harder you work, the luckier you get.

am privileged to have been requested by the president and the present committee to say a few words About the contributions by OBA UK since inception. We are all grateful to our college for providing a high standard of education, sports and most importantly a life full of moral values from our Dedicated teachers. Hence, some grateful old students of JHC, Late Mr.T.S.Perinpanathan, Mr.K Sevel, late Mr.S Uthayalingam, Mr.R Suresh , Mr T Ganeswaran and some others were instrumental in organising the OBA UK in 1987. That was the time, the college was a refugee camp with 40000 People for about 20 days with the occupation of Jaffna by the Indian army. The OBA was not very active Till it was revived in 1990 by the same organisers. The OBA UK successfully celebrated the centenary of the Lola Jones hall in south London 1991.

That was a difficult task as only few old boys were in Up and most Were students or struggling to get jobs?, or were refugees .We are thankful to them for organising the OBA which grew gradually to a larger organisation with the influx of more old students entering UK With the escalation of the war in north. They all understood the need to help our college at the time of Need. If one looks into the history of OBA JHC, the OBA Jaffna collected funds even in 1940,46,51 60 by organising carnivals exhibitions Even, prior to this in 1922,Mr Samaritan Singe went to Malaysia to collect Funds to expand the buildings at JHC.

The OBA UK too, under the guidance of various presidents and patrons and the hardworking committee members, collected funds by organising annual cultural evenings, Kalaiyarasi and Christmas dinner and dance. These events were always well attended and provided funds to help our college.

In addition, some of our grateful old boys have donated money to swell our funds. In the initial stages, when the war was going on in North ,even the basic things were not available or scarce, the OBA realised the need for helping the poor students who were struggling for the basic needs of books, pen and pencil ,school furniture etc . Hence, the programme of granting scholarships to the needy students were initiated with great success in 1992 by my committee and expanded by Dr. Jothilingam and still continued to benefit the students In October 1995, the students were displaced and the college was not functioning. Our help was needed During these difficult periods and OBA UK did all what it could? In 2000, the then president Mr. Ganeswaran and the committee organised an International convention of OBAs around the world to coincide with the millennium .

Mr.Srikumaran, the principal was invited and honoured during this period. He gave us an insight into the hard life at the school with the poor facilities and lack of basic needs for the students and teachers. It was a successful event and provided a platform to discuss the needs of the school and planning for the future. This, being an international conference involving other OBAs , it was decided to allocate different

Message from A Thiruketheeswaran



JHCOBA(UK) SILVER JUBILEE SYMPOSIUM 2012 Wider Objectives and Forward Ways A Speech by Mr N.Selvarajasingam.(1956-65)

Dear Friends,

As an institution, Jaffna Hindu College is the only foremost school that was set up by our forefathers during colonial times to safeguard the Hindu religion and the demise of our Tamil language. The College has grown ever since and served the Tamil Community in a wider way over the years. It has produced scores of eminent professionals.

The school has provided opportunities for children from families all over Sri Lanka. I am one of the lucky ones who had that same opportunity which has made me what I am today.

It is our duty that we should not leave our school to be any less than other similar institutions in Sri Lanka. To this end, I know we the old boys from all over the world can help a greater deal. I also know we have been doing just that for years now.

It is in my opinion, our input can only be on the infrastructure needed at the school. But this has to be done in a coordinated way.

Sadly I do not think this is happening. Year after year the management committee comes and goes. What happens in reality is that every committee just try and help the school in whatever requests that comes from the Principals of the day. I do not think we should divert our hard earned resources in this way.

Our aim should be to drive to lift the school in terms of the infrastructure to the same standard of the schools one could find in other parts of the developed world. I know of a master plan that was drawn in 2003 by one of our old boys, an architect in Australia, D+C Consortium.

I cannot recall his name now. If you look at the plan, a great deal of good planning has gone in there. But I do not think this master plan was ever being followed by the administration at the school. I also saw this plan was published by Jaffna OBA in their centenary souvenir. Unfortunately it has become apparent that buildings are mushrooming year after year without any such plans.

I am only going by the observation made myself during my last visit to the school in January 2011.

I urge the OBAs all over the world, to request the school administration to formulate a development plan for future growth and publish it wider amongst OBAs.

Another unhappy event that happens in our OBA management committees is that there is a non coherent attitude of not adhering or continuing the commitments made by previous committees before they took over.

This is not professional and we should not promote this culture amongst us.

It is appropriate to mention a classic example here. In 2002/3, the house and the land along the College Road, adjacent to former Boarding Master K.K.S's residence came for sale. The OBA UK at that time, initiated the purchase of that property for the benefit of the school. OBA UK then had the financial resources also for it.

Unfortunately the management committee that succeeded after that year, did not carry out that commitment for reasons of their own. I understand that the project has now partially completed almost 8 years after with many struggles.

Every year the committee members work voluntarily very hard to raise the finances for the school. They work at the expense of their family life and even finances out of their pockets.

In the majority of cases, the artists who participate in programmes are the major beneficiaries.

Any profit made out of these programmes, are the resources we have which could be diverted to the benefit of the school.

Therefore this should be wisely spent over the projects at the school.

However I will be happy if this speech can at least provoke the thinking along amongst the OBAS and force the school administration to come up with concrete plans for the future growth of the school. Thank you

"Heads Up" on what future looks like!

Dear Friends,

I am truly privileged to be here today as one of the guest speakers of JHC OBA's "Silver Jubilee Symposium 2012" to talk about the sports & communities in the UK and its potential future. It's absolutely a remarkable astuteness of bringing the JHC old boys together to articulate some of the HOT TOPICS in a convention style. This is very refreshing and reassuring so I am thankful to the OBA committee, secretary and president for their excellent efforts.

As people we are made up of a number of different identities, which are essentially the roles that we hold in the community.

These identities we hold have huge expectations and meanings attached to it, which come from both ourselves and from others. Since we signify ownership through language, be aware of the wording that we generally use; 'I am a Cricketer' for example is different to 'I enjoy Cricket' or 'I am a footballer' is different to 'I enjoy playing football'. The latter is merely describing an activity that you do, whilst the former, 'I am', implies identity.

It is not only the expectations that are important but how we interpret these expectations and the meaning we give to them.

In western cultures this process is highly valued. The evaluation about "us" are imperative, this practice "more or less" has been forgotten in our society at present. Competency and Capability must be assessed when handing over roles & responsibilities.

The measurement of sport's contribution within minority communities reflects the aspects of social capacity, social cohesion and social capital. There are number of Tamil Sports related organisations exists in the UK operating for many years including; a handful number of OBA's claiming to be contributing to the society.

Is that factual?

The entries I am making in this section seek to address such issues at various levels of our community's impact due to differing attitudes to social and cultural integration.

We all want to engage and contribute which is an astonishing attribute of our culture but many of us seem to divert from the original goal setting then bring in our own self invented agendas to disrupt the common goals.

Every culture has a set of customs, rules, and laws which are for the most part obeyed. But in every culture and society there are always people who refuse to follow the rules.

The Structural Strain Theory explains that deviance as a result of social strains put on people. The root of Structural Strain theory lies in the anomaly, a condition of confusion when social norms are weak or conflicting.

Apart from the above individual behaviours, we can also confidently say that a sport is often associated to politics. Analytically, we can divide sports politics into two categories: sports in politics and politics in sports.

Major organisations and associations are always built in with a sports committee or a sports subcommittee who can make imperceptible power over elected bodies or administrators.


The Future
