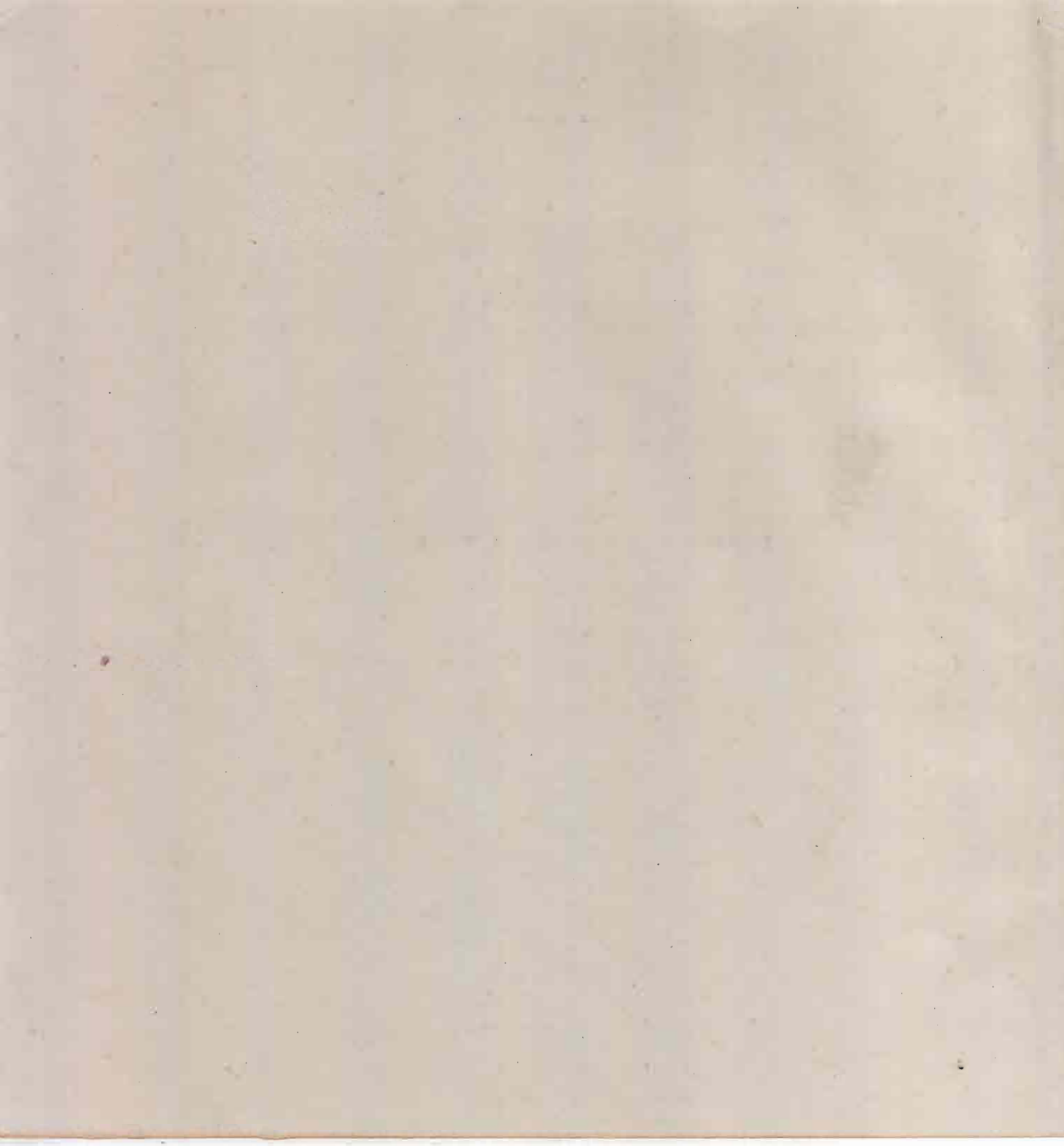
As soon as the Chancellor has arrived on the stage the National Anthem will be sung.

The Vice-Chancellor shall read the list of Prizes, Medals, and Scholarships awarded on the Final Examinations of the University of Peradeniya.

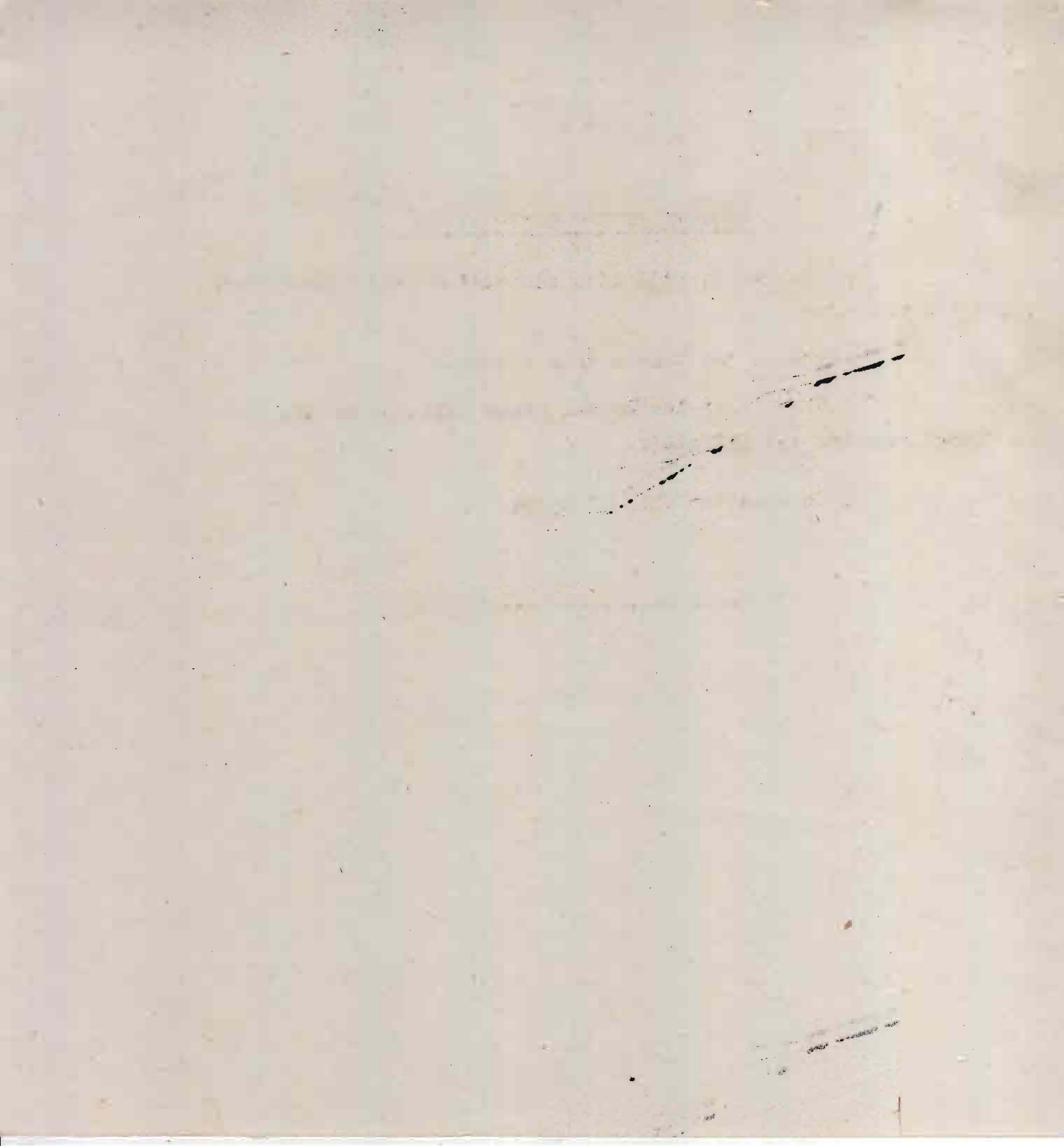
