# CEYLON AMATEUR ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

#### CONDITIONS

1. The Meet to be run under A. A. A. Rules.

2. Competitors not ready at time and place appointed for their

events will be scratched.

3. All events are confined to Amateurs. The Amateur Declaration Form as contained in the Entry should be signed by the Group Secretaries.

4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse any Entry

or Entries.

5. All Competitors are requested to wear their College/Club Colours.

6. Competitors will be excluded from taking part in an event

unless properly attired.

7. (a) Every competitor shall be supplied with and wear during competition a distinctive number corresponding to his number on the programme. Competitors who fail to fix their numbers securely to their vests will not be allowed to participate.

(b) In races not exceeding 300 yards, duplicate numbers shall be provided and worn, one on the breast and the other on the back.

8. The attention of competitors is drawn to the A. A. A. Racing Rules and notice is hereby given that such Rules will be strictly adhered to.

9. Any dispute and/or complaint shall be submitted to the

Referee concerned whose decision shall be final.

10. All Competitors in School Events should be under 19 years on the 30th September, 1948. In the case of the Junior Events, they

should be under 16 on the 30th September, 1948.

11. No Competitor shall enter for more than three individual events of which not more than two shall be track events. In the case of Junior events, no Competitor shall be entered for more than 3 events, individual and team event taken together.

12. The Entry Fee is Re. 1/- per Event. The Entry Fee for

Relay Events for Schools is Rs. 2/- per team.

13. The Entry Fee for Club Relay Events is Rs. 5/- for one event, or Rs. 10/- for all three events. These entries should be signed

by the Hony. Secretary of the Club.

- 14. Competitors' Enclosure:—Competitors are particularly requested to make use of the Competitors' Enclosure in Block E of the pavilion. Competitors' dressing room will also be in the "E" Block. Competitors in the Girls' School Relay 4×110 yards will use the cloak room and seats in "D" Block.
- 15. Competitors who secure first, second and third places will be awarded certificates.
- 15. (a) The Tarbat Challenge Cup, presented by Sir John Tarbat will be awarded to the school which gains the largest number of points. Points will be awarded as follows:—

1st Place ... 5 Points 2nd ,, ... 3 ,, ... 1 Point

In the event of a tie for the 1st place, 4 points will be awarded to each school, a tie for the 2nd place, 2 points to each school, and a tie for the 3rd place,  $\frac{1}{2}$  point to each school.

15. (b) The Tarbat Challenge Cup, for Junior Events. Points will be awarded as follows:—
