

CONDITIONS

1. The Meet to be run under A. A. A. Rules.
2. Competitors not ready at time and place appointed for their events will be scratched.
3. All events are confined to Amateurs. The Amateur Declaration Form as contained in the Entry should be signed by the Group Secretaries.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse any Entry or Entries.
5. All Competitors are requested to wear their College/Club Colours.
6. Competitors will be excluded from taking part in an event unless properly attired.
7. (a) Every competitor shall be supplied with and wear during competition a distinctive number corresponding to his number on the programme. Competitors who fail to fix their numbers securely to their vests will not be allowed to participate.
(b) In races not exceeding 300 yards, duplicate numbers shall be provided and worn, one on the breast and the other on the back.
8. The attention of competitors is drawn to the A. A. A. Racing Rules and notice is hereby given that such Rules will be strictly adhered to.
9. Any dispute and/or complaint shall be submitted to the Referee concerned whose decision shall be final.
10. All Competitors in School Events should be under 19 years on the 30th September, 1947. In the case of the Junior Events, they should be under 16 on the 30th September, 1947.
11. No Competitor shall enter for more than three individual events of which not more than two shall be track events. In the case of Junior events, no Competitor shall be entered for more than 3 events, individual and team event taken together.
12. The entry Fee is Re. 1/- per Event. The Entry Fee for Relay Events for Schools is Rs. 2/- per team.
13. The Entry fee for Club Relay Events is Rs. 5/- for one event, or Rs. 10/- for all three events. These entries should be signed by the Hony. Secretary of the Club.
14. **Competitors' Enclosure:**—Competitors are particularly requested to make use of the Competitors' Enclosure in Group D of the pavilion.
15. Competitors who secure first, second and third places will be awarded certificates.
15. (a) **The Tarbat Challenge Cup**, presented by Sir John Tarbat will be awarded to the school which gains the largest number of points. Points will be awarded as follows:—

1st Place	...	5 Points
2nd „	...	3 „
3rd „	...	1 Points

In the event of a tie for the 1st place, 4 points will be awarded to each school, a tie for the 2nd place, 2 points to each school, and a tie for the 3rd place, $\frac{1}{2}$ point to each school.

15. (b) **The Tarbat Challenge Cup**, for Junior Events. Points will be awarded as follows:—

1st Place	...	5 Points
2nd „	...	3 „
3rd „	...	1 Point

In the event of a tie for the 1st place, 4 points will be awarded to each school, a tie for the 2nd place, 2 points to each school, and a tie for the 3rd place, $\frac{1}{2}$ point to each school.

The Distribution of points in the case of the Relay events is as follows:—

1st Place	...	7 Points
2nd „	...	5 „

15. (c) **The Jeaffreson Challenge Cup**, presented by Mr. H. S. Jeaffreson, will be awarded to the school which gains the largest number of points in the two Relay Events. Points will be awarded as follows:—

1st Place	...	7 Points
2nd „	...	5 „
3rd „	...	3 „

In the event of a tie, points will be shared. Points gained in the Relay Events will be reckoned when awarding the Tarbat Challenge Cup.

16. **The Schokman Challenge Cup**, for Club Relays presented by Dr. V. R. Schokman, will be awarded to the Club which gains the largest number of points. Points will be awarded as follows:—

1st Place	...	3 Points
2nd „	...	2 „
3rd „	...	1 Point
