This is the Last Will and Testament of us James Alwis of Colombo, Advocate, and Florence Alwis husband and wife and hereinafter called ourselves the Testator and Testatrix.

I. Preliminary

We hereby revoke all or any Wills, Testaments or Codicils which we may have heretofore jointly or severally made (except a certain Last Will made jointly by me the Testator and my first wife) and specially our Joint Will and Testament dated the eighteenth day of October One Thousand eight hundred and seventy two and attested by John William Vanderstraeten of Colombo Notary Public.

II. Disposition upon the death of either of us.

We desire that our Executors hereinafter named, shall pay to the Trustees of all Saint's Church at Hultsdorf in Colombo, the sum of Five hundred Rupees and see that the same shall be laid in the purchase of one or two flagons for the Communion Table; To the Colombo Friend-in-need Society the sum of Two hundred and fifty rupees, and To the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in Foreign Parts the sum of two hundred and fifty Rupees.

III. In the Event of the Testator dying first.

We give and bequeth the following legacies or donations.

To James Thomas Alwis the sum of Two Thousand and five hundred Rupees to be invested by our Executors in the purchase of landed property and by them conveyed to him and his heirs at the expense of our Estate, under the condition that he shall not mortgage or alienate the same in any manner whatsoever, but shall only have a life interest therein.

To our trusty servant Lianage Carolis Perera Appoo a paddy field called Wavey Kumbura situated at Mulleriawa.

To our servant Eddippili Kankanange Don Juan Appoo the sum of Five Hundred Rupees.

To Pilanagamage Denis also our servant Two hundred and Fifty Rupees.



II. Revocation

It hereby revokes all of any wills, testaments or bequests which we may have heretofore jointly or severally made (except a certain last will made jointly by me the Testator and my first wife) and especially our joint will and testament dated the eighteenth day of October one thousand eight hundred and seventy two and attested by John William Vandergrafen of Colorado Notary Public.

II. Disposition upon the death of either of us

We desire that our Executors hereinafter named shall pay to the Trustees of all Saint's Church at Manitou in Colorado, the sum of five hundred dollars and see that the same shall be laid in the purchase of one or two tickets for the Communion Table; to the Colorado Friend-in-need Society the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, and to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in Foreign Parts the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars.

III. In the event of the Testator dying first

We give and bequeath the following legacies

on conditions.

To James Brown Lewis the sum of two thousand and five hundred dollars to be invested by our Executors in the purchase of landed property and by them conveyed to him and his heirs as the executors of our estate, under the condition that he shall not mortgage or alienate the same in any manner whatsoever but shall only have a life interest therein.

To our trusty servant Miss Margaret Garcia the sum of five hundred dollars to be invested by our Executors in any manner whatsoever.

To the sum of five hundred dollars.

To our servant Miss Margaret Garcia the sum of five hundred dollars.

And the sum of fifty dollars.

To all our other Singalese male servants who shall be in our service at the time of my (the testator's) death the sum of Two hundred and fifty Rupees, to be divided amongst them as the survivor thinks just.

To our maid servant - Mango Two Hundred and Fifty Rupees.

We desire that our two sons James Henry and Edwin Robert, shall have the choice of all the books, English and Oriental out of my (Testator's) General Library with book cases, and also all presentation copies of books amongst which are the presents of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, Sir William Gregory and many a distinguished Savan of Europe, and further my grandfather's Gold medals and my parent's swords.

IV. Literary.

" It is my (the Testator's) will and desire that either of my said sons shall publish my " History of Ceylon " which already exists in the shape of three volumes of proof sheets. If they or either of them lack the courage or the ability to undertake the work, our Executors are hereby authorised to lay out a reasonable sum of money for the employment of an Editor and for its publication, which has been already authorised to be made at the Government Printing Press by the Hon'ble A. N. Birck, Colonial Secretary. It was my (the Testator's) wish and hope to continue the history to the present time and to include in it a long Chapter on the administration of Sir William Gregory's Government. But for the accomplishment of the desire, labouring as I am under severe illness, I have at present, little or no chance. In its imperfect state, the work ~~was~~ inscribed by gracious permission to His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales. The dedication will be found among my papers." *[see the word "proof"]*

The second edition of my Sidat Sangara is now ready, and this is also a work which should be published. The manuscript, together with a few notes on the proposed plan of the work, I have handed to Mr. Lee of the Ceylon Civil Service, who has kindly undertaken the editing of the work at Government Printing Office. If he fails in that promise, it is my wish that the work shall be proceeded with by my Executors after securing the best talent that is necessary to carry it into completion.

My publication of the Pali Attanagaluwansa with its Singalese translation is nearly complete, there being only the lastsheet still to be corrected and printed. A short preface, Title page and Inscription will be found amongst my papers. No one will be more competent to bring this work into a conclusion satisfactorily, than my friend Mr. William Perera Ranasinghe, Proctor, to whom I beg to tender my most sincere thanks for the assistance he has already rendered in carrying the publication

To Mr. Abraham de Alwis. my (the Testator's) single side board and the round table which is now being expressly made for him at Kalutara.

To Mr. Louis de Alwis - two (a pair) Dining room carved side boards.

To Mr. Peter de Saram Mudaliar - a reading Couch.

To Jane Maria - wife of Mr. J.G.A. Perera and my god-daughter to whom I held out a promisesome time ago a Calamender Almirah to be selected by my Executors out of those remaining after the above gifts.

To Anne Inoy Alais - my (the Testator's) small Alais in two pieces (which she has already selected) a carved settee, a side table, a carved sofa and two old chairs.

To Mr. Abraham de Alais - my (the Testator's) single side board and the round table which is now being expressly made for him at Bataavia.

To Mr. Louis de Alais - two (a pair) dining room carved side boards.

To Mr. Peter de Saram Muelhys - a reading table and my son-in-law's Alais - wife of Mr. J. B. A. Verkerke and my son-in-law's Alais - when I hold out a promise to him and a Galamander to be given by my executors out of those remaining.

All my other Calamander and ebony, jakwood Indian Nandoon, Satinwood Tamarind Ratberaliya furniture, statutory pictures, glass, plates crockery jewellery subject to the provision herein-after contained are to be and remain the property of my said wife and at her disposal to give or sell. In case of sale the proceeds are to form a part of the funds to be raised for the purpose hereinafter indicated.

VI. Ad interim provision for children.

Whereas I the Testator, leave the said James Henry by my first wife and the said Helen Florence Edwin Robbert, Ezline Maria and Annie Lucy by my present wife and it is my wish and desire not to mark any invidious distinction between any of them except to mark my sense of the necessity for providing for the said James Henry from whose mother and under the provisions of the will, made jointly with me I received a large amount of property; and also to make provision for each of them according to peculiar circumstances and divers circumstances which move me regarding my station in life and the position which I desire each of my children should occupy maintain and uphold hereafter, it is the will and desire of both of us that :- The said James Henry shall upon his attaining his twenty fifth year or on his marriage receive the sum of Fifteen thousand Rupees in cash, An undivided half share of Puwakwatte situate in Velliveriya in Siyane Corle and undivided half share of two other allotments of land since added thereto by purchase from Government; and undivided half share of Embulgamawatte situate at or near the eighteenth mile post on the road to Hanwella with its appurtences and the garden and house at Hendala adjoining the Leper Hospital.

As Helen Florence has already received Jewellery, a sum of Fifteen thousand Rupees in cash and Kossamulle Estate situate in Alloctcoor Corle equal in value to the above bequests and devise to James Henry upon a Marriage Settlement and a Trust deed, we desire that upon the death of me the Testator the said trust shall cease and that the said moneys and property shall vest in the said Helen Florence according to the terms of the said deeds.

To Edwin Robert, upon his attaining his twenty fifth year or on his marriage the sum of Fifteen thousand Rupees in cash and Palliyewatte situate at Velleveriya aforesaid and Malwatte situate at Horagolle in Siyano Corle.

To Ezline Maria upon her attaining her twenty fifth year or on her marriage the sum of Fifteen thousand Rupees in cash and Alawatte situate near the Railway Station at Pallalagedera.

shall upon his attaining his twenty fifth year or on his marriage

trust shall cease and that the said money and property shall vest
in the said Helen Florence according to the terms of the said
deed.

To Edwin Robert, upon his attaining his twenty fifth
year or on his marriage the sum of fifteen thousand pounds in
cash and Wallingford estate at Wallingford aforesaid and
estate situate at Hants in the County of Hampshire.

To Maria Lucia upon her attaining her twenty fifth year
or on her marriage the sum of fifteen thousand pounds in cash
and estate situate near the railway situate at Wallingford
and estate upon her attaining her twenty fifth year
on her marriage the sum of fifteen thousand pounds in cash
and estate situate at Hants in the County of Hampshire.

Upon the marriage of Elzine Maria and Annie Lucy respectively it is our wish that the survivor should give at her discretion jewels proportionate to the value of the jewellery settled on eldest daughter Helen Florence.

We desire that our Executors shall sell as they may deem fit and necessary or as opportunities present themselves not otherwise the above lands and premises from number seventeen (Hendala Grass Land) to number forty (the Snuggacry) both inclusive and that until such sale or sales the revenues income and profits of the said deveral premises shall be collected and paid to me, the Testatrix. And when any sales or sales shall be made the moneys realised thereby shall be funded together with other incomings until all the legacies hereby bequeathed could be paid. Our Executors shall not sell or otherwise alienate the First Sixteen lands and premises hereinbefore mentioned nor shall I the Testatrix have the power to sell or otherwise alienate the same or any of them, but I shall have a life interest therein.

From moneys to be raised as above directed and cash I the Testatrix leave behind, we desire that each of our daughters shall, as soon as the said moneys are realized or sooner if practicable receive a sum of Ten thousand Rupees for the purchase of a house each, the right to which shall be vested in each of our said daughters.

VIII - Inheritance upon the death of both of us.

We direct that upon the death of the survivor of us the Nawella Estate be divided into two lots; the new District Road Committees road which intersects the land at present right across from the direction of Jayellato Devalapitiya being the intersecting boundary; the portion with the buildings whatever.
